Admission Procedure

- 1. For hostel admission a separate online hostel 3. 70% marks and 85% classroom attendance form has to be filled.
- Hard copy of duly filled form must be submitted in the Hostel Office with registration fee slip of Rs. 200/-.
- 3. Hostel forms should be filled completely. Incomplete form is subject to rejection.
- 4. Admission in the hostel is purely on merit basis.
- Admission to the college does not ensure admission to the hostel
- 6. Admission to the hostel is for one academic session only, you will have to seek fresh admission every year.

Re-Admission

- 1. Re-admission to the hostel cannot be considered a matter of right and will depend on whether you have observed all the rules or not.
- Students need to apply within 15 days of

- declaration of their result for re-admission in the hostel in Part II and Part III.
- are necessary for readmission in the hostel.
- The students overall conduct will be assessed for re-admission.

Once the student is admitted in hostel, following documents have to be submitted (every year)

- 1. Fees once deposited will not be refunded under any circumstance. Only the caution money is refundable.
- 1st installment at the time of admission.
- Second installment will be due on 1st November 2024. Last date of submitting the 2nd installment is 10th November 2024. With a late fee of Rs.50/- per day the last date is 20th November 2024

- cleared, the student will have to vacate the room by 30th November 2024 till 5:00pm.
- 5. Caution money will be refunded to the student only after adjusting excess charges of electricity and repair, maintenance etc.
- Cost of repairs/ white washing charges for spoiling the walls of the room/ almirah etc. will be recovered from the occupants of the room from their caution money.
- **4.** After 20th November 2024 if dues are not 7. Coolers can be installed by the inmates at their

- own cost and no additional payment for electricity consumption.
- Fine of Rs. 500/- will be levied on keeping any additional electric gadget - iron, induction, water
- heating rods, electric kettle etc.
- 9. Any change in room type will be allowed within 15 days from the date of admission in the hostel.

Rules & Regulations

- college will be eligible for admission to the hostel.

- 3. Ragging in the hostel premises is prohibited. Any inmate involved in ragging is liable to be expelled from the hostel/college.
- 4. Hostellers will be responsible for the safety of their personal belongings and articles issued to them. The college/hostel will not be responsible for any loss or damage of the
- 5. The admission of a student to hostel can be canceled if she is found guilty of:
 - a. Violation of any of the hostel rules, including non-payment of dues.
 - b. An act of indiscipline in or outside the hostel.
 - c. Possessing/taking drugs, liquor and other intoxicants.
 - d. Misbehavior, using abusive language, manhandling of hostel employees/inmates.
 - e. Suffering from such physical/mental ailments which may cause disturbance/infection to other inmates.
 - f. Suppression or misrepresentation of any fact about other girls.
 - g. Sharing room with others without the permission of the Warden.
- 6. No personal electrical gadgets like heater, tape recorder, iron, rod, kettle etc can be used in the 2. hostel rooms. Disciplinary action will be taken in case of chronic defaulters. (*Coolers & laptops are allowed)
- Students should vacate the room within three days of the last paper of university examinations. Students cannot claim to stay in the hostel during the vacations.
- Students should behave in such a manner that the atmosphere in the Hostel remains calm and conducive for studies.

- 1. Only those students who are admitted to Kanoria 9. It is compulsory for all the students to maintain a register while going out and coming into the hostel.
- 2. All inmates are expected to maintain discipline 10. Hostel employees are not allowed to do personal work for the inmates.
 - 11. No misuse of electricity and water is allowed and leaving the room without switching off the lights will invite a penalty.
 - 12. Hostel premises are meant for communal living, residence and study, so no friends, unauthorized guests, or relatives are permitted to live with hostellers. Entry of male/boy, friends and day scholars is strictly prohibited.
 - 13. Local outings with the Warden's permission are allowed, and prior consent of parents, for bonafide reasons. The permitted time is to be strictly adhered to.
 - 14. Use of table lamps is recommended after 10 p.m. to avoid inconvenience to other roommates.
 - 15. Cooking food in the rooms is not allowed.
 - 16. Meals will be served in the Dining Hall at fixed
 - 17. Hostel remains closed for 10 days during Deepawali Vacations.

Leave Rules

- 1. Written permission by fax/email/ text message /WhatsApp message from parents is required to reach the college office well in time for an outstation leave of the hosteller.
- Leave of more than 7 days will be granted only in emergency situations on proper intimation by parents/guardians.
- 3. Any extension in leave should be informed. before the completion of the granted leaves by parents to the warden through fax/email/ text message/WhatsApp message
- Hostel gates open at 6:00 am in morning and close at 7:00pm in evening. No student will be allowed to enter or leave premises before 6:00 am and after 7:00pm.

^{**}If stay in the hostel required after 30th April, charges will be - Rs. 6000/- per month for Non-AC rooms and Rs. 7800/- for AC rooms.

- 2. A student can have local guardians. Photos of local guardians certified by the parents have to be submitted at the time of admission.
- 3. Night stay with the local guardian will be allowed only with the prior written permission of the parents.
- 4. Only those people who have their names listed as local guardians would be permitted to meet the students. Visitors will be allowed only Sunday during the visiting hours and for a duration not exceeding one hour. Local guardians and parents are allowed to visit their ward on producing a visit authorization card.
- 5. In case of violation of the time allowed for outing the students will have to face disciplinary action and the outing may be cancelled along with imposition of a fine of Rs. 100/-
- 6. It is mandatory to bring the visitor's card, issued at time of hostel admission, to meet your ward.

Mess Rules

- 1. Mess cuts will not be given at all.
- 2. A mess committee of hostel inmates will be formed to decide the menu and mess requirements.
- 3. Food served will be PURE VEGETARIAN.
- 4. No food will be served after mess timing is over.

Attendance Rules

- 1. As a rule, all the inmates have to be present for attendance at 7 pm in the hostel.
- Attendance for the hostel students in the classes should be at least 85% during each academic session.

Infrastructure and other facilities

- 1. Rooms are double/triple/four-, six- and eight-seater with proper light and ventilation.
- 2. Solar water-heating system and geysers
- 3. 24-hour water and electricity supply.
- Fire extinguishers on floors, in the kitchen and mess.
- 5. Swimming pool, garden gymnasium, spacious playground
- Provision of recreation room with television and indoor games.
- 7. Provision of the reading room.
- Water coolers with purifiers in mess and alternate floors.
- 9. Laundry (on payment)
- 10. Provision of pest control service every month for making hostels insect and rodent-free.
- 11. Properly maintained personal records, as well as, outing records of the hostellers.
- 12. CCTV facility for enhanced safety of the hostellers.
- 13. Facility of daily local and national newspapers.
- 14. Participation of student representatives in planning nutritious diet for the hostel inmates and maintaining discipline and cleanliness in the hostel. Planning and provision of a different menu on each day of the week, with a special meal on Sunday.
