- Seats are allotted on the basis of merit.

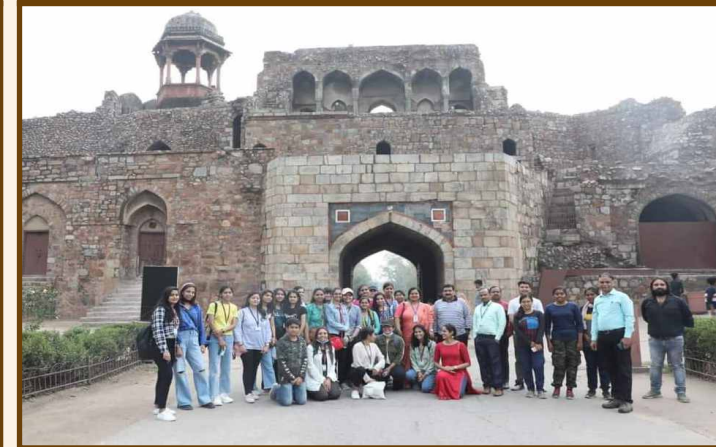

The library has a rich collection of more than 73,000 books with an excellent reading ambience and scalable infrastructure. The library offers 13 daily Newspapers in Hindi and English and 117 National and International Journals/Magazines along with 18 SAGE Journals which can be accessed online and in hard copy also. 271 CD's, 17 Maps, 09 'subject specific charts' and 1743 Project Reports/Dissertations are also available in the library. There is a Reference Room, Cyber Room (20 Computer Systems), 5 Web Cameras, Not to be Issued section and a separate section where Old Question Papers are available.

- **User Orientation Programme:** A User Orientation Programme is conducted every year for First year students in the month of August to create an awareness of the facilities provided by the library.
- **Library Management Software:** It is executed via barcode system which is helpful in creating and maintaining student databases, book inventory and cataloging.
- **OPAC :** This software facilitates direct access to Library catalogue and makes it convenient for the faculty and students to search for the desired texts.
- **E-Resource:** Library is a member of E-Shodh Sindhu (N-List) program from UGC INFLIBNIT. Faculty members and students can access more than 6000+ e-journals and 1,99,500+ e-books under N-list and 6,00,000+ e-books through NDL. SAGE also provides digital access to its resources to the college. The Library has an institutional membership for the National Digital Library (NDL), through which thousands of e-resources can be accessed.
- **Book Bank:** The college, in its effort to support underprivileged students provides books on yearly basis through the book bank consisting of 9835 books, managed by the college library. Forms are available in the library for students who would like to avail this facility. Apart from this, the library also maintains a catalogue of 3523 gifted books.
- **Book Lending System:** Books can be borrowed for 15 days. A penalty system exists for those students who do not abide by the rules of book lending. Students should check the book for any torn or missing pages and seek an endorsement on the book prior to its issue.

- **Photocopy Facility:** There is a facility of photocopy available in Library. Faculty members as well as Students can get the study material by photocopy of important reference books available in the college library. There is a facility for printing of documents for the students.

4. लोगों को सामाजिक बुराइयों के प्रति जागरूक करने के लिए बेंटी बचाओ तथा अंग दान जैसे विषयों पर परिचर्चा, नुक्कड़ नाटक एवं प्रेरक फिल्म आदि का प्रदर्शन।
5. भारत सरकार के निर्देशानुसार प्रांतीय, राष्ट्रीय तथा अन्तरराष्ट्रीय कार्यक्रमों का आयोजन।
6. प्रान्तीय एवं राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर आयोजित कार्यशालाओं, शिविरों तथा युवा सप्ताह में सहभागिता।
7. विद्यार्थियों के प्रारंभिक जीवन से ही उनके व्यक्तित्व को निखारते हुए उनमें नेतृत्व-क्षमता, संयोजन व प्रबंधन कौशल विकसित करना राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना का उद्देश्य है। राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना के प्रमाण-पत्र से उच्च शिक्षा में प्रवेश के समय 2% से 5% तक अतिरिक्त अंक जोड़े जाते हैं। इसका कार्यानुभव स्वरोजगार के लिए भी महत्वपूर्ण है।
