A Legacy of Empowerment: Kanoria PG Mahila Mahavidyalaya

On July 19, 1965, a visionary initiative was taken in Rajasthan. Philanthropist Seth Bhagirath Kanoria, along with Shri B.M. Singhi, educationists Ms. Krishna Terway and Ms. Hemlata Prabhu, founded Kanoria Mahila Mahavidyalaya in Jaipur to provide women with quality higher education. In its early days, Ms. Terway and Ms. Prabhu tirelessly campaigned, urging families to educate their daughters. With a modest beginning in the building of Poddar School for the Deaf and Dumb, the college has taken a long stride in the last six decades. Kanoria College boasts of state of art infrastructure, like wifi campus, auditorium, sports complex, swimming pool, cafeteria, two hostels, rich library and ICT enabled classrooms that cater to diverse undergraduate and postgraduate programs.

Besides the academics, the founders sought holistic growth, shaping women to forge their own paths and contribute meaningfully to society. This ethos made Kanoria a beacon of empowerment, with students and faculty, under leaders like Dr. Renuka Pamecha and Dr. Rashmi Chaturvedi, championing social justice in cases like Roop Kanwar (1987), Bhanwari Devi (1992), Nirbhaya (2012), RG Kar Case (2024) and other issues. Contribution of the College towards the Vishakha Guidelines (1997), RTI Act (Rajasthan) (2001), Domestic Violence Act (2005) and Criminal Law Amendment Act (2013) underscores this legacy. The College has led by example to initiate the value of social activism and its concerns.

Under the dynamic leadership of Director Dr. Rashmi Chaturvedi and current Principal Dr. Seema Agrawal, the college broadened its scope by implementing NEP 2020 and establishing Research Centers, Incubation Center, Intellectual Property Rights Cell, Institution Innovation Council, and similar initiatives.

Kanoria pulses with cultural vibrancy, hosting the city's beloved Annual Play, Dance Drama, "Kasturi" Youth Festival, CAMFEST, Digital Ideathon, Kanoria Fiesta, Management Fest, SAGA: English Literature Fest, Techshitij and many more. Its robust sports culture sees students excelling in national tournaments. Notable alumni, like Kathak maestro Smt. Prerna Shrimali, Commonwealth gold medalist Padma Shri Dr. Krishna Poonia, bureaucrats like Ms. Pragya Paliwal Gaur, Shivangi Swarnkar and Devangi Swarnkar, Garima Bhatnagar, Sapna Tiwari and Mamta Kochar embody the spirit of college. The Alumni Association of the college comprises a galaxy of remarkable achievers in all walks of life.

Each year, Kanoria welcomes students from diverse backgrounds, with inclusive admission policies and scholarships ensuring access for deserving candidates. NEP 2020 Guidelines Undergraduate Programme Framework as implemented by the University of Rajasthan

- **3 Year UG Degree:** Students will be awarded a UG Degree after successful completion of three years securing 150 credits, provided they complete one internship of 4 credits during summer vacation of the III year.
- **4 Year UG Degree (Honours):** A Four year honours degree in the MAJOR discipline will be awarded to those who complete a four-year Degree with 200 credits .
- **4 Year UG Degree (Honours with research):** Students who have secured 75% marks and above in first six semesters and wish to undergo research at UG level can choose research stream in the FOURTH year . The students who secure 200 credits including 12 credits from research project/dissertation will be awarded UG Degree (Honours with Research)

- In I & II year the student can earn maximum 52 credits & in the III year the student can earn 46 credits.
- To earn credits for each paper a student has to secure 40% marks separately in Cumulative Assessment (CA i.e. Mid Term Exam) as well as End of Semester Exam (EOSE). As per University of Rajasthan NEP 2020 guidelines a student will be allowed to appear in End of Semester Exam ONLY if the student secures 40% in Mid Term Exam.
- To be PROMOTED from I year to II year or II year to III Year – 52 Credits out of 52 Credits are required
- BACK PROMOTED from I year to II year or II year to III Year – 26 Credits required out of 52 Credits Out of which **18 Credits should be from 3 Core Subjects (Subject 1, Subject 2 & Subject 3) Otherwise the Student will be ‘NOT PROMOTED’ and will have to REPEAT the YEAR and will appear only in the due papers of that Year(Semester I /II /III/ IV)**
- **Maximum period to complete the FIRST YEAR is 3 Years time .**
- **Student will be promoted to III year (Semester V) ONLY if the students has earned all the credits of I year (Semester I/II) OTHERWISE she will have to take Academic leave (gap of one year) to clear the remaining due papers of I Year (Semester I/II).**



Library

The Library has a rich collection of more than 76,500 books including reference books 4200 (227 Rare Books, 75 written by Faculties), with an excellent reading ambience and scalable infrastructure. The Library offers 15 daily Newspapers in Hindi and English including 1 Bilingual and 117 National and International Journals/Magazines along with 19 SAGE Journals which can be accessed online and in hard copy also. We have 275 CD's, 26 Maps, 09 Subjective Charts and 1927 Project Reports/Dissertations are also available in the Library. It also consists of a Reference Room, Computer Center/Cyber Room with 30 Computer Systems and 5 Web Cam and Not to be Issued section, along with a separate section where 5 Years Old Question Papers are available.

- **User Orientation Programme:** A User Orientation Programme is conducted every year for First year students in the month of August to create an awareness of the facilities provided by the library.
- **Campus ERP:** Library management software is executed via a barcode system.
- **User friendly software:** OPAC (user software) facilitates direct access to Library catalogue. It makes it convenient for the faculty and students to search for the desired texts.
- **E-Resource:** Library is a member of E-Shodh Sindhu (N-List) program from UGC INFLIBNIT. Faculty members and students can access more than 6000+ e-journals and 1,99,500+ e-books under N-list and 6,00,000+ e-books through NDL. SAGE also provides digital access to its resources to the college. The Library has an institutional membership for the National Digital Library (NDL), through which thousands of e-resources can be accessed.
- **Book Bank:** The College, in its effort to support underprivileged students provides for books on yearly basis through the book bank consisting of 10102 books, managed by the college Library.

पुस्तकालय में 76,500 से अधिक पुस्तकों का समृद्ध संग्रह है, जिसमें 4200 संदर्भ पुस्तकें (227 दुर्लभ पुस्तकें, 75 संकायों द्वारा लिखित) शामिल हैं, तथा पढ़ने के लिए उत्कृष्ट वातावरण और व्यापक बुनियादी ढांचा उपलब्ध है। हिन्दी व अंग्रेजी के 15 समाचार पत्रों के साथ राष्ट्रीय-अन्तरराष्ट्रीय स्तर के 117 शोधपत्र (जर्नल) व पत्रिकाएँ उपलब्ध हैं, साथ ही सेज (SAGE) के 19 शोधपत्र (जर्नल) भी छात्राएँ, हार्ड कॉपी तथा ऑनलाइन भी पढ़ सकती है। पुस्तकालय में 275 सीडी, 26 मानचित्र तथा 9 विषयों के चार्ट तथा 1927 परियोजना रिपोर्ट उपलब्ध है। एक संदर्भ कक्ष तथा एक साइबर कक्ष है, जिसमें 30 कम्प्यूटर व 5 वेब कैमरे हैं। 'नॉट टू बी इश्यू' प्रकोष्ठ में 5 वर्ष के प्रश्नपत्र उपलब्ध हैं।

National Service Scheme

Popularly known as NSS, the forum is an extension of higher education system to orient the student engagement towards community service under the aegis of Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India. It promotes social awareness and creates a sense of responsibility and discipline among students. Through regular activities and special camps, it provides them with a unique opportunity for teamwork and constant interaction with the community. Some of the major initiatives taken by NSS are:

1. Celebrating special days and events like Literacy Day, International Yoga Day, Human Rights Day, NSS Day, International Women's Day, World AIDS Day, Unity Week etc.
2. Spreading awareness about health and hygiene through various activities under Swachh Bharat Campaign and health camps like – Eye Check-up Camp, Dental Check-up Camp and Blood Donation Camp.
3. Foster community service spirit among young students through visits to adopted slums and villages to undertake literacy, computer education and gender equality campaigns.
4. Creating awareness amongst people about social evils with 'Daughters are Precious' and 'Organ Donation Awareness' campaign by organizing rallies, film shows, talks and street plays etc.
5. Organize State, National and International level programmes as per the directions of the Government of India. Participation in State and National level camps, workshops, competitions and youth festivals.

Shaping the student's personality by inculcating leadership, planning and management skills in them at an early stage is the aim of NSS. The NSS certificate provides a weightage of 2% to 5% marks at the time of admission in higher studies. The work experience helps them find avenues for self-employment.

Note :- As per NEP 2020 NSS is offered as VAC for continuous Sem.-I, II,III, IV with 2 credits in each semester. whoever is interested in taking NSS as VAC are required to attend all the events scheduled by NSS in the college.

The college has been allotted 4 fully financed NSS units by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports

राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना

भारत सरकार के खेल एवं युवा मामलों के मंत्रालय की ओर से उच्च शिक्षा में अध्ययनरत विद्यार्थियों को समाज सेवा से जोड़ने की दिशा में राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना एक बहुआयामी योजना है।

यह विद्यार्थियों में सामाजिक चेतना, उत्तरदायित्व की भावना एवं अनुशासन को बढ़ावा देने का कार्य करती है तथा नियमित गतिविधियों एवं सेवा शिविरों के माध्यम से यह विद्यार्थियों को मिलजुल कर कार्य करने और समाज से निरन्तर जुड़े रहने के अवसर प्रदान करती है। इस योजना के अंतर्गत किये जाने वाले प्रमुख कार्य निम्न प्रकार हैं –

1. विभिन्न गतिविधियों एवं दिवसों का आयोजन किया जाता है, यथा – साक्षरता दिवस, अन्तरराष्ट्रीय योग दिवस, मानवाधिकार दिवस, एन.एस.एस. दिवस, अन्तरराष्ट्रीय महिला दिवस, विश्व एड्स दिवस, एकता सप्ताह आदि।
2. स्वच्छ भारत अभियान के अंतर्गत स्वास्थ्य एवं स्वच्छता के प्रति जागरूकता के लिए दंत एवं नेत्र जाँच तथा रक्तदान शिविर आदि का आयोजन।
3. गोद ली गयी ग्रामीण व कच्ची बस्तियों में साक्षरता, कम्प्यूटर-प्रशिक्षण एवं लिंग समानता आदि विषयों के प्रति लोगों को जागरूक कर छात्राओं को समाज सेवा के लिए प्रेरित करना।
4. लोगों को सामाजिक बुराइयों के प्रति जागरूक करने के लिए 'बेटी बचाओ' तथा 'अंगदान' जैसे विषयों पर परिचर्चा, नुक्कड़ नाटक एवं प्रेरक फिल्म आदि का प्रदर्शन।
5. भारत सरकार के निर्देशानुसार प्रांतीय, राष्ट्रीय तथा अन्तरराष्ट्रीय कार्यक्रमों का आयोजन। प्रांतीय एवं राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर आयोजित कार्यशालाओं, शिविरों तथा युवा सप्ताह में सहभागिता। विद्यार्थियों के प्रारंभिक जीवन से ही उनके व्यक्तित्व को निखारते करते हुए उनमें सेवा भाव, नेतृत्व-क्षमता, संयोजन व प्रबंधन कौशल विकसित करना योजना का उद्देश्य है।

*इसके प्रमाण-पत्र से उच्च शिक्षा में प्रवेश के समय दो से पाँच प्रतिशत तक अतिरिक्त अंक जोड़े जाते हैं। इसका कार्यानुभव स्वरोज़गार के लिए भी महत्वपूर्ण है।

नोट :- एनईपी 2020 के अनुसार एनएसएस को प्रत्येक सेमेस्टर में 2 क्रेडिट के साथ निरंतर सेमेस्टर- I, II, III, IV के लिए के VAC के रूप में पेश किया जाता है। जो भी एनएसएस को VAC के रूप में लेने में रुचि रखते हैं, उन्हें कॉलेज द्वारा निर्धारित एनएसएस के सभी कार्यक्रमों में भाग लेना आवश्यक है।
