- Must be an original piece crafted for the competition.
- Isolation, fear, mystery, or melancholy should be the central theme.
- Characters and settings should align with the Gothic style.

- The participants will have to describe their book cover in 50-100 words on stage.
- Participants have to bring their stationery and an Az size sheet.
- The cover must be an original work of the participant.
- The decision of the jury will be final.
