## D. Highlight Facilities, Infrastructure of Pre-Incubation & Incubation kind and Student bodies/clubs engaged in promotion of Innovation and Entrepreneurship in the campus

### Incubation Centre – NARIKA Incubation Centre

The college has Incubation Centre ‘NARIKA’ to support and promote women led innovative start-ups. The Incubation centre helps in developing a conducive start-up ecosystem to promote entrepreneurial activities among the women in Rajasthan. NARIKA Incubation Centre is an endeavour of the college to provide platform to aspiring women entrepreneurs. The Centre was formally registered on 16 December, 2021. The Centre launched its first cohort ‘Navodhyma -1’ with 12 budding entrepreneurs. Keeping the aim in mind, every year, a Digital Ideathon is conducted to invite innovative ideas from women entrepreneurs. The Centre launched its second cohort ‘Navodhyma-2’ with 13 budding entrepreneurs during the session 2023-24. In the session 2024-25, 21 new start-ups have been enrolled in NARIKA. These entrepreneurs were continuously

mentored for starting an enterprise, developing entrepreneurial mindset, branding, costing and marketing basics. The startups were provided a platform in the college campus called 'Wednesday Mela' where they exhibited and sold their products. The enterprises vary in nature and products varying from art and craft, bakery, food delivery service, sketching, hobby classes, organic beauty products to garment production such as sanganeri print jackets, bags and fashion jewellery. This initiative provides them hands-on experience in cost management, marketing, consumer engagement, and business operations in their entrepreneurial journey and develops business skills and confidence in students to pursue independent ventures.

## **Objectives**

- To support and promote women led innovative startups and inculcate them at our incubation centre.
- Extend business development support and consultancy to incubated startups to help them build sustainable businesses.
- Conduct knowledge building sessions for incubate as well as non-incubate startups to help them develop core knowledge to conduct business activities.
- To develop a conducive startup ecosystem to promote entrepreneurial activities among women in Rajasthan

## **Infrastructure/Facilities in College**

The college campus is fully Wi-Fi and has state of art Infrastructure facilities and amenities for the students. The spirit of learning depends on the atmosphere built up around the campus, the zeal carried by the competent teachers and imparted through facilities like Smart Classrooms, Library – rich in quality books, well maintained Laboratories, excellent Equipment, spacious Seminar Rooms, Auditorium, Study Halls, Sports Grounds, Creativity Zones etc. The college houses a Computer Centre equipped with 300 computers featuring I-5 configuration, complemented by ORELL Software, facilitating advanced computing capabilities for academic and practical use. The college has Lease Line (UTM/ Firewall +Wi-Fi Connection) with a speed of 100 MBPS for providing internet facility.

### **• Entrepreneurship Club**

Entrepreneurship Club drives to nurture seeds of entrepreneurship and self-employment among its students. This club inculcates core business skills and enables students to convert hobby and innovative ideas into business ideas. It gives them exposure to the world of business through interaction with successful business persons. The Club includes activities which equip students with the knowledge, skill, techniques, and confidence to act as torch bearers of the enterprise for the generation.

### **• Sukriti – Art & Craft Club**

Sukriti Club emphasizes that art is not just a handicraft, it is the transmission of feelings that artists have experienced. Craft is passionately creating something with your hands. Club aims to develop and enhance the creativity and imagination of the students. It discovers students' hobbies as a profession by polishing their artistic skills and providing them a platform to exhibit their talent. The club aims at learn and earn. This is a club of students, by the students and for the students.

- **Centre for Entrepreneurship Development**

The centre aims at establishing an ecosystem for aspiring women entrepreneurs. It is a connecting bridge linking the large untapped pool of talent and ideas to the formal mentoring process of NARIKA incubation centre. Every year start up proposals are invited through Digital Ideathon. The expert group of mentors’ vets these proposals and identifies the commercially viable ideas. These selected proposals are then forwarded to Incubation Centre, where they are developed into self-sustaining enterprises.

- **IPR-TT Cell**

IPR-TT Cell plays a pivotal role in fostering a culture of innovation and research. The Cell actively supports faculty and students in securing patents and transferring technology, ensuring their creative work reaches practical and commercial success. The cell also helps innovators in boosting their readiness for the market and enhancing the sustainability and reputation of the institution.


