

ANNUAL REPORT OF TLC FOR THE SESSION 2021-22

The aim of the TLC of Kanoria PG Mahila Mahavidyalaya, is to enable and support faculty to learn and implement evidence-based, learner-centered and inclusive teaching practices. The TLC seeks to promote faculty, staff and administration in cultivating an institutional climate that encourages and rewards teaching excellence.

To attain these objectives, TLC began the session of 2021-22 by organizing a 10- day Departmental FDP in the college from 9-20 July, 2021. In this FDP sessions, on “Selecting an appropriate Journal for article publication and Research Metrics” and “ Voice and Accent Training” were conducted jointly for all the faculty members on 17 July and 20 July 2021 respectively, whereas rest of the sessions were conducted department-wise as per the new updations in the respective subjects. All the faculty members attended the FDP.

The month of October begun with a Virtual Orientation Program for the students on 1st October 2021, in which the new students were introduced to all the different Clubs, Associations, Committees and all the other whereabouts of the college. 250 students attended the session Live on Google Meet platform, whereas a large number of students enjoyed it on college’s YouTube channel.

On 29th and 30th November 2021, a Two-day FDP on the topic “Happiness. Mindfulness and Effective Teaching” was organized by the center in which Dr. Prabhat Pankaj, Director, ICFAI University, Jaipur delivered the lectures on the topic “Value and importance of Happiness and Mindfulness” on 29th November and “How to make teaching Effective for students” on 30th November. The session was attended offline by all the faculty members.

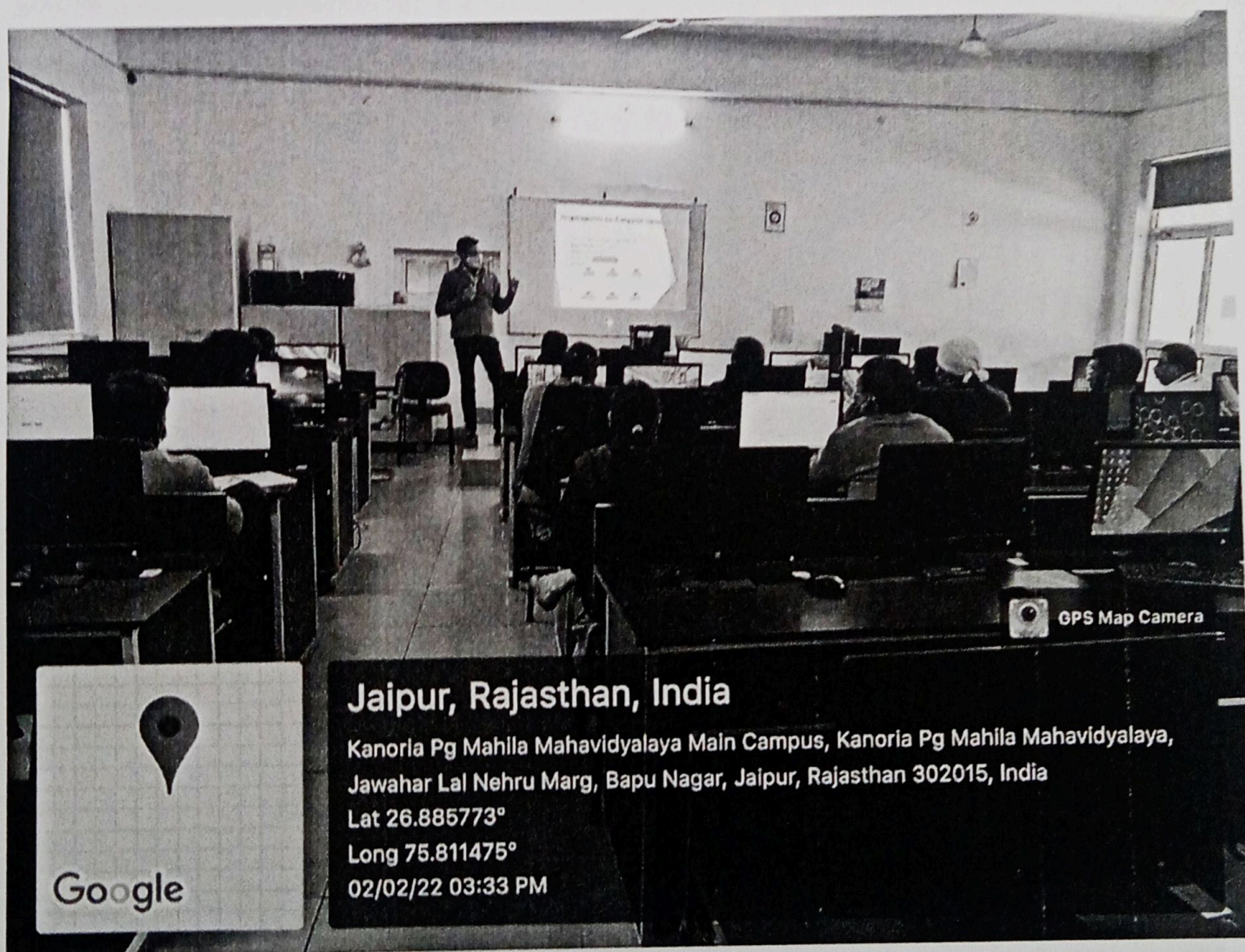

The aim of the faculty exchange program was to seek advice and suggestions on establishing new research labs and how to increase the employability of students through teaching learning.

In the wake of upcoming NAAC Review of the college, a Two-day FDP was organized for the faculty members on the topics, “NAAC SSR” and “NAAC Peer Team visit” on 23rd and 24th December, 2021 respectively in which Dr. Suresh Kumar Agarwal, Dean, Maharaja Ganga Singh University, Bikaner, elaborated on the steps to be followed and the preparations

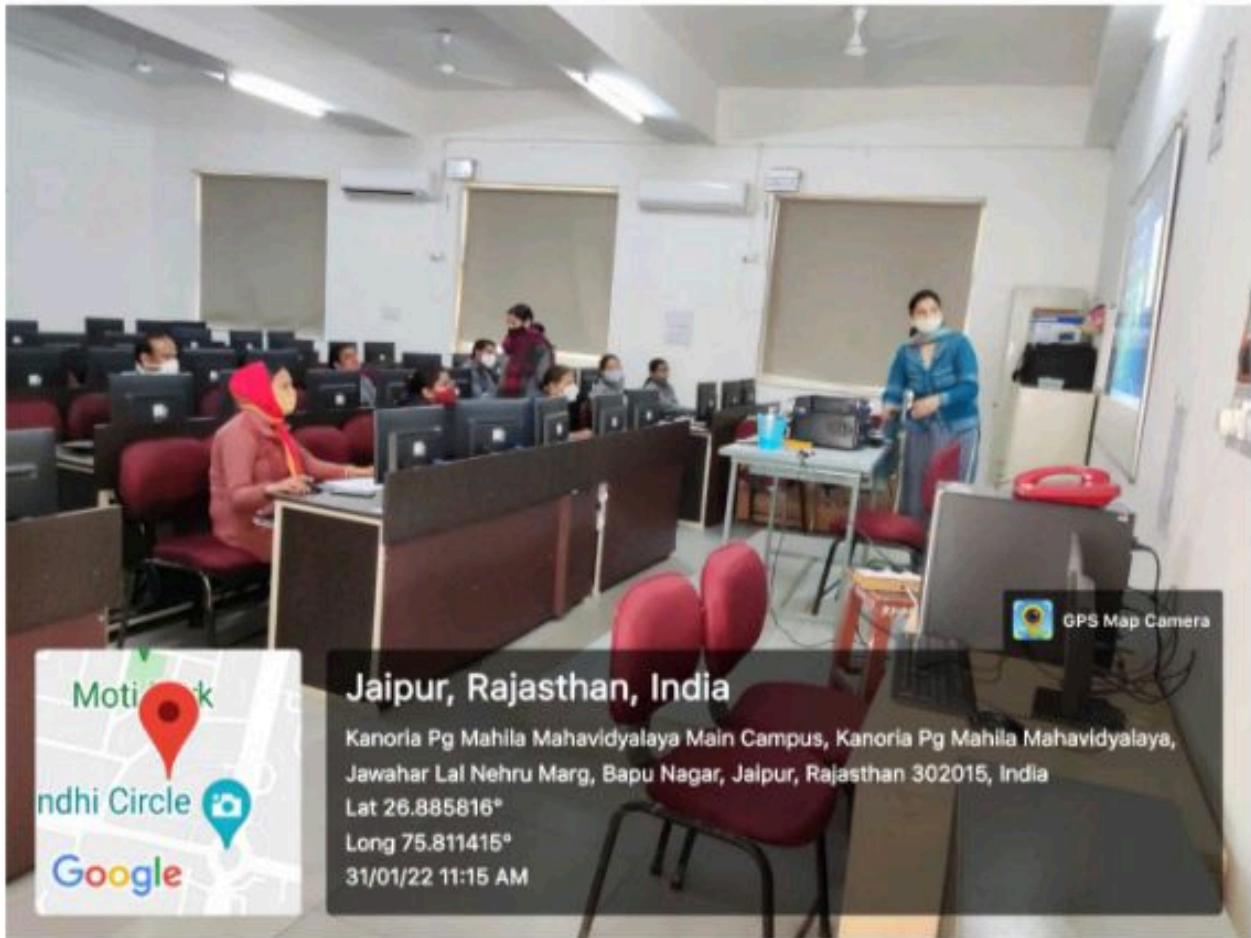
to be made for filing SSR and for the peer team visit. The faculty members also resolved their queries regarding NAAC paper filing work.

Different levels of computer operations as per the requirement of the staff were taught to them to enhance their computer literacy and to increase their professional skills. On the last day of the program i.e, on 7th February a test was also conducted to check the increased understanding and knowledge of the staff members, which all the staff members passed successfully.
