

FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME


Organized under the aegis of IQAC

10 days Faculty Development Programme was organized by all the departments under the guidance of IQAC. It was a very fruitful programme which was designed by the faculty themselves keeping in view their holistic development. All the departments at their individual level conducted sessions every day. The major areas of discussion were related to their respective field and an overview on digital learning tools and Research aptitude. The program consisted of inter and intra-departmental sessions.

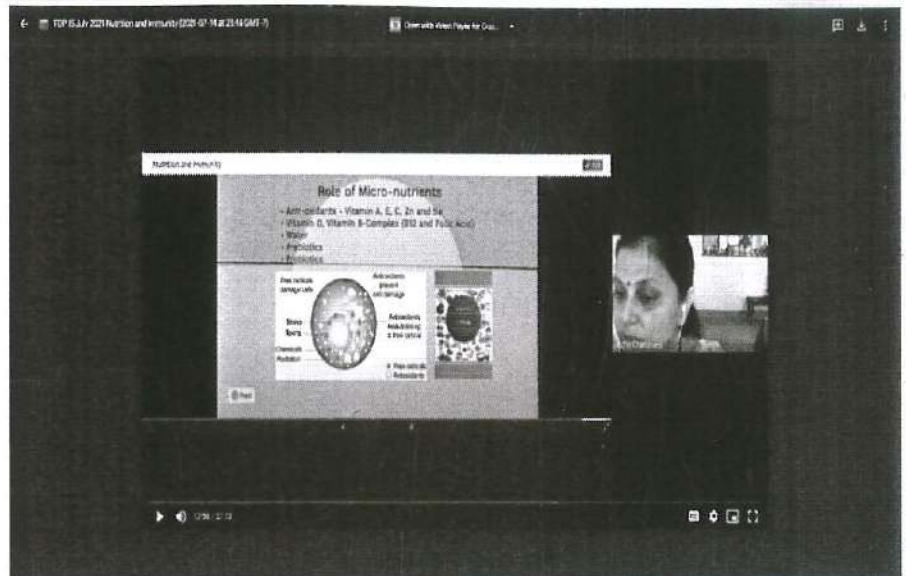
In the Department of English, the sessions dealt with numerous topics ranging from nuances of academic research writing to intricacies of voice and accent. The program started on 8th of July. First session was organized by the Departments of History, Drawing & Painting, and Music & Philosophy on the topic 'How to Write a Research Paper'. The resource person for the day was Dr. Neekee Chaturvedi an Associate Professor with the Dept. Of History, University of Rajasthan explained the smaller details of writing a research paper. She revisited the basics of research writing as well as explained the developments in academic writing. Her session proved extremely helpful for the Dept. of English and saw participation of the entire department. The session for 9th of July was 'Film & Literature'. It was an intra-departmental session. The resource person for the day was Ms. Ankita Sharma. She discussed the relationship shared by cinema and literature. The discussion expanded to films as adaptations, films as translations, the flimsy boundaries between adaptations and translations, and the scope of cinema within the gamut of literature. The third session held on 10th of July was on 'History of English Literature'. Dr. Swatti Dhanwni was the resource person. She discussed the major epochs in the history of English Literature. In the session, Dr. Dhanwni highlighted the important characteristics of works in different periods of history. This proved to be extremely helpful to members of the department as it helped revise the history which forms the basis of study of literature. On the fourth day of the FDP i.e., 12th of July the department held a movie review session. A short movie titled 'Ahalya' was screened for the members. The movie screening paved way for an interesting discussion on topics such as reversal of myth, relevance of mythology in present times, and stories under the lens of critical theory such as feminism. Day 5 i.e., 13th of July was devoted to the discussion of 'Horror & Fantasy'. The discussion started with the screening of another short movie titled 'Chutney'. The movie was an interesting take on the evil and horrifying elements present in the human society. It propelled the discussion towards the tropes of supernatural, horror, paranormal, and fantasy in literature and in reality. The members of the department revisited fairy tales, dreams, and fantastical stories which make up a large part of literature.



Dr. Preeti Sharma was the resource person for the sixth day, i.e. 14th of July. Her session was on 'Phonetics, Stress, and Intonation'. She discussed the major phonetic sounds in language, proper stress, and the role of intonation in speech. Day 7 of the FDP, i.e. 15th of July was devoted to the ever elusive 'Stream of Consciousness'. Dr. Parna Vanjani was the resource person for the day. Day 9, i.e. 17th of July was devoted to Indian poetics with Dr. Charu Goyal as the resource person for the day. Dr. Goyal, Head of Department for Department of English, explained Natyashastra and its huge impact on contemporary literature. Department of Home science conducted session on OBS, Open Shot, Nutrition and Immunity which were very well delivered by Dr. Richa Chaturvedi, HOD


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Department of Home Science. Department of Sociology along with the Department of Home Science and Psychology organized sessions useful for each of the disciplines. Followed by a presentation on "*Michel Foucault: Works and contributions*" on 9th July by Dr. Mohita Chaturvedi Sharma, she discussed how the concepts put forward by Foucault are still relevant in contemporary times. The session was followed by another Hands-on session to acquaint the members with software which are helpful in creating animated presentations and videos. Dr. Mohita Chaturvedi Sharma explained the art of creating animated presentations through the "*Renderforest*" application. This Application not only helps in creating but also sharing of presentations by linking it to the mail account of the user. Dr. Sweety Mathur took a session on "*Scientific study of Social phenomenon*" where she emphasized upon how social phenomena can be scientifically studied to enhance their validity and reliability.



Department of Psychology conducted a session with the aim to promote peer learning in the FDP on the topic "*Qualitative Research*", on 10th July. Dr. Himanshi Rastogi was the resource person for the session which focused upon the tools and techniques that can be used when conducting social research. This was followed by a session on "*Importance of Emotional Intelligence in Education*" by Ms. Bindhya Sharma which highlighted the relevance of emotional intelligence in student life.

Department of Geography conducted session keeping in mind the requirement of digital tools in teaching methodology. Dr. Neelam Bageshwari: Doubt Sessions, Screencastify, Discussion sessions, Renderforest etc. Dr. Jayanti Goyal, Head, Department of Computer Science



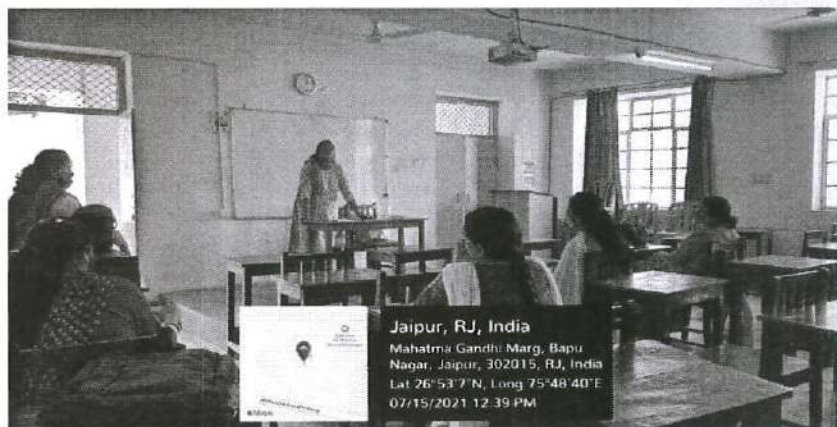
stressed upon Blended Learning, Peer learning, encouraging usage of national digital library (NDL). Ms. Ankita Gupta took a session on White Board, Jam Board.

Ms. Rekha Sharma: Sticky Notes, e-book, pdf (edited), reference book, SWAYAM portal. Ms. Neelam Sunda: Interaction, fun learning, guidance for research etc. Ms. Anamika Singh delivered a lecture Google Earth, Kinaesthetic learning, mind maps etc. Dr. Neelam Bageshwari also delivered a session on instrumental survey. Instrumental study of two equipment was conducted on Dumpy Level and Abney Level. A session on Documentation and Management of Record was conducted on the day six of the FDP (15/07/2021). The intra-departmental session was done along with the lab assistant and lab bearer. The topics encompassed in the session were safeguarding information, better management and improved accessibility of the relevant records.

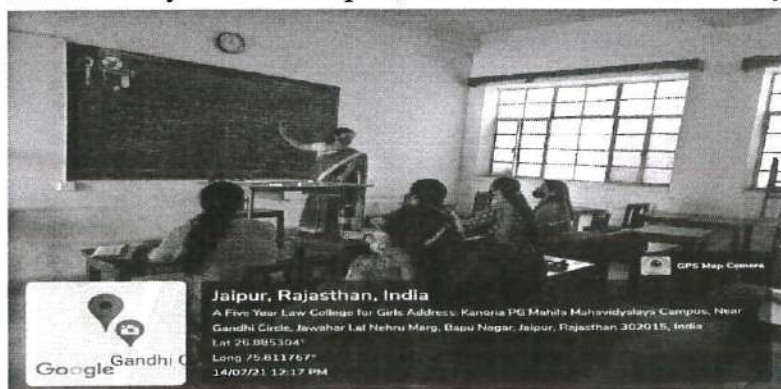

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A hands-on session was conducted on Digitization of Toposheet using Q-GIS as an interactive departmental activity of the geography department. Dr. Sarika Kaul, Associate Professor, Department of Drawing and Painting of the College delivered a lecture on the topic - Art of Teaching- Learning: Understanding & Analyzing Art Work. She explained about what is Art & Art Work, salient features involved in analyzing, understanding and appreciating Art Work. She also dealt upon the life and works of renowned artists - Vincent Gough, Tyeb Mehta, Ram Gopal Vijayvargiya, Asavari Ragini, marvelous Ajanta Cave Paintings, beautiful sculptures of Gandhara and Mathura School, of Art. Dr. Prabha Bajaj, Associate Professor, Department of Music delivered a lecture on the topic - "Origin of Music". She explained that song, instruments and dance collectively constitute music. Music has origin since prehistoric times and has evolved gradually with time. She also talked about various types of ragas and bandishes in music and music therapy. Dr. Meenakshi Srivastava, Assistant Professor, Department of Philosophy, gave a lecture on the topic - "Philosophy: Indian & Western Concept". She explained in detail the meaning, origin and scope of Philosophy. She also differentiated between Indian and Western Philosophy in terms of metaphysics, epistemology, axiology, ethics and aesthetics. Satyam, Shivam Sundaram is the essence of Indian Philosophy. Dr. Shraddha Saxena, Assistant Professor, Department of History gave a lecture on the topic - What is History: A Brief Survey of Historical Periods. She discussed the evolution of History through different phases of time namely prehistory, protohistory and history. She also dealt with the division of history into ancient, medieval and modern periods. She elaborated the relationship between history and human beings.

Under the Faculty Development Programme, Department of Commerce initiated with a very relevant topic 'Communication' by an external guest Ms. Shweta Ahluwalia. She discussed about perception management and ladders of success. This session was organized by Department of Business Administration and attended by faculties of Department of ABST as well.



Group Discussion on 'Improvement of Writing Skills' organized and attended by all faculty members of ABST department. Department of Business Administration organized two sessions on 'Research Publication' and 'Cognitive Biases in Decision Making' taken by Ms. Damyanti Sodha and Dr. Preeti Agarwal respectively. This was followed by Intra-department session on 'What efforts are we doing to keep ourselves updated in the field of ABST' taken by Dr. Manjari Bhardwaj. She discussed various options through which subject knowledge can be enhanced. On 10th July'21, a session on Report Writing was taken by Dr. Priyanka Khurana discussing the basics of the topic. On day 4 of the FDP, a session on 'Financial Support Schemes of Govt. for aspiring Entrepreneurs' was conducted by External Expert, Mr. K.C. Meena followed by an interactive session on 'How to make



classroom teaching more effective' by ABST faculty Dr. Sakshi Sharma. On 13th July, Dr. Vishnu Priya Temani discussed about 'Zotero- A managing tool for References'. This was Inter-departmental session wherein a new tool for references in Research papers was discussed including its relevance in today's research scenario. An interesting session on 'Taxation: An Overview' was conducted by Dr.

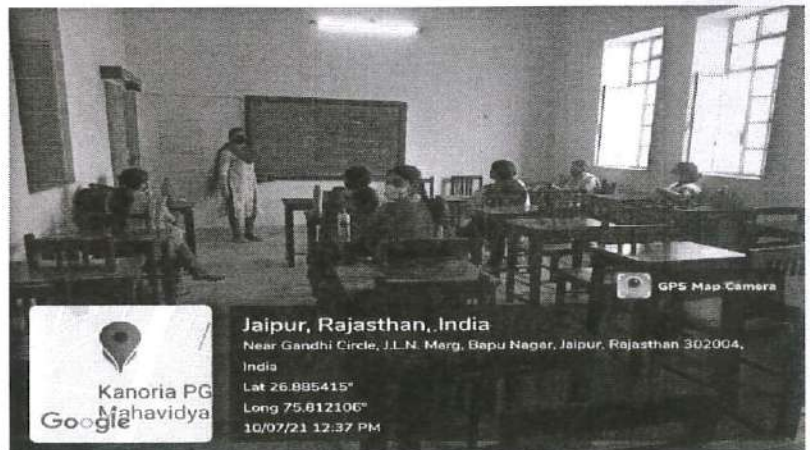
Seema Agrawal, Principal, KMM and Head, Department of ABST on 14th July 2021. She discussed about basics of Income Tax and also mentioned the concept of new tax regime. On the next day of

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FDP, a session on Dissertation was conducted by in-house faculty Dr. Mrinali Kankar. She discussed about the standard format to be followed by the students of Dissertation. Last two days of FDP included Intra- departmental session on 'How to motivate students to join M. Com ABST course by Dr. Ranjula Jain, Dean Infrastructure.

Overall, during these 10 days, various new techniques and concepts were discussed which not only enhanced the subject knowledge of the faculties but also provided opportunity to them to show-case and share their knowledge to peer-groups. Dr. Sunita Mathur, HOD, Department of EAFM, spoke on Challenges of Gig Economy. She highlighted on major aspects of the ongoing trend of temporary placement of manpower on contract basis. This concept is beneficial for the Employer but on the contrary, it is very much volatile in terms of Employee. As employee has job insecurity, no future safety, retention ratio is diminishing. More challenging to survive in the competitive market for manpower who are semi-skilled. Vijay Laxmi Gupta, HOD, Dept. of Economics, of our own college. She explained about Housing Bubble and Digital Currency. She also focuses on digital currency that is currency in electronic or digital. Many popular cryptocurrencies were also explained like Bitcoin, Dogecoin, Ethereum, Litecoin etc. Basic difference between digital currency and cryptocurrency were also included. Dr. Ragini Sharma discussed on Relevance of Kautalaya Arthshastra, in Ancient times." She highlighted on major aspects of the Kautalaya Arthshastra by various stories She gave introduction about Kautalaya, Arthashastra and Chanakya niti, origin of economics. Dr. Neeta Agarwal delivered a lecture on Relevance of Kautalaya, Arthshastra, in present scenario." She highlighted on major aspects of the Kautalaya Arthshastra and its various Policies, regarding Economic Development of the Nation, policies which are still relevant in present day includes Taxation policy, Foreign Policy, Wealth, Labor, Population & Good Governance, determination of price, and policy on National security etc. She also explained the impact of these policies have on current state of affairs. Dr. Surbhi Mathur discussed on Digital India Quiz & National Mission on Education using ICT. She focused on Digital India Quiz and NMEICT. Digital India Quiz is an initiative by GOI under the visionary leadership of Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi with a vision to transform India into a digitally empowered society & knowledge economy. She also told how to play quiz and get e- certificate. In the lecture she discussed on some specific initiatives i.e. Shodh Shudhi (PDS), VIDWAN, E- Shodh Sindhu, Shodhganga, e-PG Pathshala, Swayam Prabha, Swayam etc., highlighted on how we as a teacher explore ourself by NMEICT initiative. Dr. Bharti Godhwani talked about Learning from pandemic with reference to management of Personal finances and Banking. In this, she discussed how investment should be done so it can be useful during such times and she clarify the need of health insurance, term insurance and other insurance plans. She also highlighted necessity of nomination, and updation of all documents in financial matters. Dr. Bharti Godhwani & Dr. Surabhi Mathur of EAFM department demonstrated the how to make poster and hands on session on technical aspects used during this new normal era of online classes like organizing mail box, creation of e certificate.



In the same que, Department of Computer Science organized a series of meaningful sessions - Ms. Neelam Sunda (Asst. Professor, Computer Science Department) delivered a talk on "Do's and Don'ts for Manuscript acceptance & Plagiarism Tools". Ms. Rekha Sharma (Asst. Professor, Computer Science Department) delivered a session on "Numerical Analysis of NA problem in C". She took a mathematical example to explain the concept of Bisection method and Rank of the Matrix and then implemented the same problem using C Programming Language. Resource Person Ms. Swati Sharma (Asst. Professor, Computer Science Department) delivered her talk on "Canva". Canva is a

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graphic design platform, used to create social media graphics, presentations, posters, documents, and other visual content. Resource Person Ms. Rekha Sharma (Asst. Professor, Computer Science Department) delivered a talk on "Online coding in Python using Google Colab". Colab is a Python development environment that runs in the browser using Google Cloud. She demonstrated the execution of python code with data set using google colab. Ms. Neelam Sunda (Asst. Professor, Computer Science Department) delivered her talk on "Google Classroom Attendance Management". Another session on an interesting topic 'Selecting an Appropriate Journal for article publication & research metrics was conducted by Dr. Ranjana Agrawal, Associate Professor, Department of Zoology and IQAC Coordinator, KMM. She mentioned the criteria for selecting appropriate journal and mentioned the importance of selecting good journal for the research paper.

The ten- day program concluded on 20th of July with the 'Voice and Accent' session conducted jointly by English and Hindi departments. The session was based on the numerous errors in usage of language in everyday life. The resource person on behalf of the Hindi department was Dr. Sheetabh. Dr. Charu Goyal, Dr. Preeti Sharma, and Dr. Swatti Dhanwni represented the English Department. The resource persons discussed the intricacies of Hindi and English languages helping the faculty members in understanding the importance of correct pronunciation. Minute details of words, which can make a huge difference in their meaning, were highlighted. The differences between British, American, and Indian versions of the English language were discussed along with stress, intonation, common pronunciation errors, and Indianized form of language.

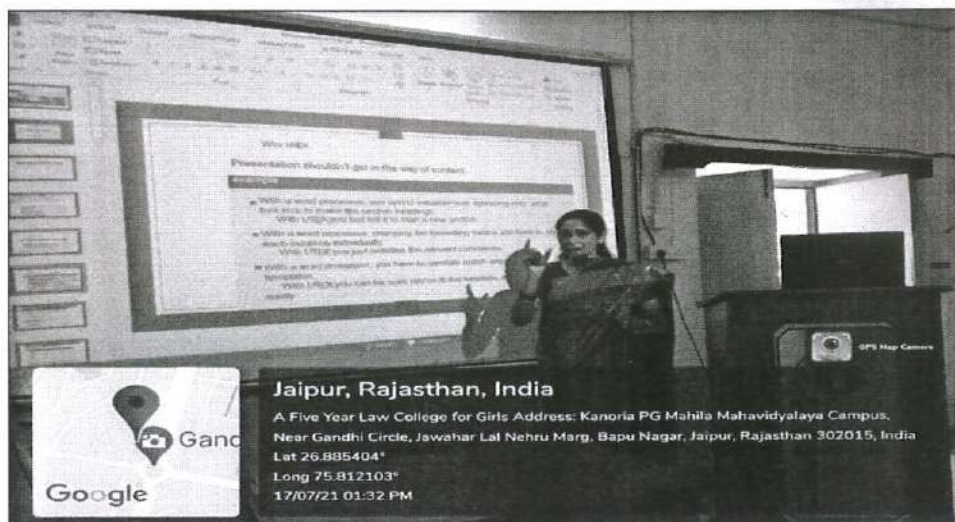


Department of Chemistry organized a 10-day FDP from 9th July to 22nd July 2021. Dr. Neeru Razdan, Head of the Department inaugurated the session and discussed the head motivation behind such programs. The resource person for the day was Dr. Arti Mishra. She discussed every aspect of stress management in our day to day lives. She emphasized on how to maintain a balance between our mind and work pressure. Dr. Pragati Natani from department of Statistics was the resource person and she gave an insight on the 'Introduction to Statistics'. She explained how we as a chemist can apply statistical analysis in our data and sample studies. Dr. Naveen Sharma from University of Rajasthan enlightened us as the resource person on the topic of 'Leadership building and communication skills.' He suggested how we can improve on our communication skills for the betterment of teacher student relationship.

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Ms. Nisha Saini as the resource person discussed a very useful software 'ChemSketch'. This software can help in drawing, designing and studying various chemical structures mechanisms and models. Dr. Nidhi Gupta as the resource person shared with us the importance of 'blended learning'. This is a new mode of learning, where both offline and online modes of learning are available to the students as well teachers. Dr. Nidhi Agnihotri as the resource person shared her expertise in the field of 'Nanotechnology and applications of graphene'. She shed light on the vast usage of graphene-based nanotechnology and its research benefits in today's scenario. Dr. Kumud Tanwar as the

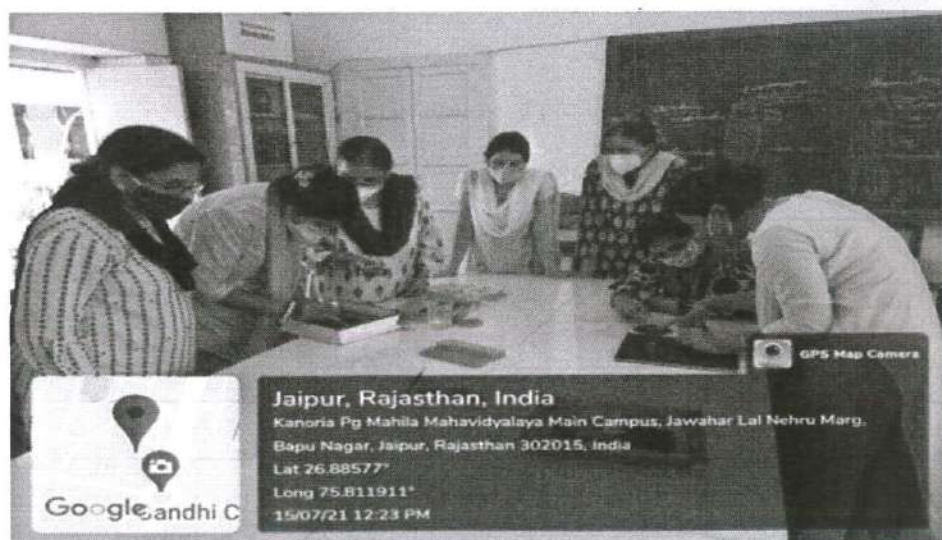
resource person introduced us to the new format of 'writing in latex'. She explained how we can use latex form in writing power research papers making presentations and preparing documents with greater ease. Ms. Priyanka Jangid as the speaker of the day discussed the importance of research ethics. She focused on



various type of scientific misconduct that happens and should be avoided for a healthy working research environment. Dr. Jyoti Kapil which is widely used in immunological studies. She also explained its importance and clinical significance.

A variety of instrument and techniques are used in biological studies and knowledge of these instruments is necessary to make optimal use of them. Thus, second day of FDP i.e. 9th July was utilized to provide hands-on experience on two commonly used techniques in Zoology i.e. Spectrophotometer, widely used in Biochemistry and Micrometry used for Cytological studies. Dr. Ranjana Agrawal explained working principle of both the techniques along with its practical demonstration to further strengthen the knowledge of faculty members. Two important techniques which are Immuno-electrophoresis and Gel Electrophoresis. Dr. Jyoti Kapil briefly described about the procedure followed by its practical demonstration in Biotechnology lab. All the faculty members also had hands-on experience of the same. Drifting apart from the subject expertise and to make FDP more interesting and captivating all faculty members attended an online FDP session on

'Leadership Building and Communication Skills'. The motivational talk was delivered by Dr. Naveen Sharma of Department of Chemistry, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur organized by Department of Chemistry on 12th July. Dr. Naveen Sharma highlighted on the need of communication to enhance the teaching-learning environment and also emphasized that

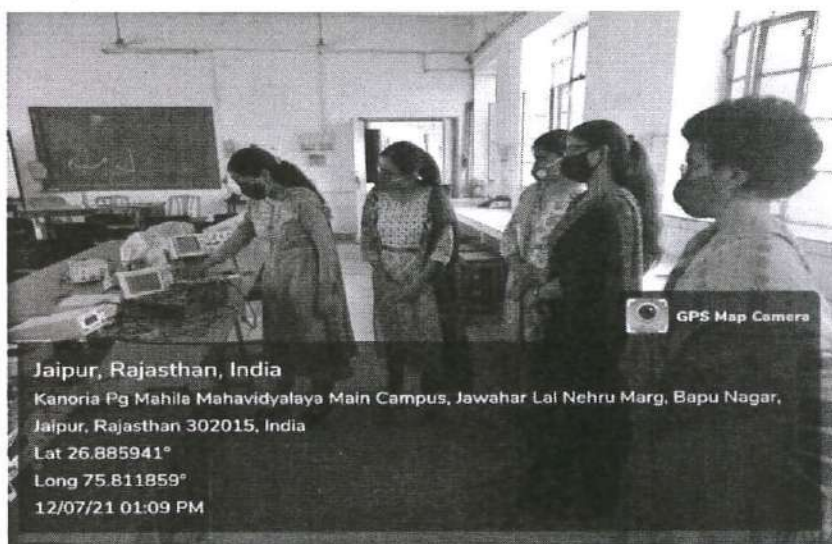


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communication is at the core of effective leadership. Microtomy technique is an integral part of Zoology at postgraduate level, therefore, the 5th day (13th July) of FDP was solely used to learn the various technical aspects of this technique.

Dr. Ratna Saxena and Dr. Anita Gajraj first theoretically explained the various steps of Microtomy followed by working demonstration of microtome, the mechanical instrument which is used in this technique. All the faculty members had hands-on experience for better understanding of the working of microtome. On 14th July the FDP session focused on Virtual Lab, which is one of the most important e-learning tools. Dr. Sunita Shekhawat and Dr. Chetna Sharma first explained the advantages of Virtual Lab for both teachers and students. With Virtual Lab, teachers don't have to go to the lab at certain time and prepare the experiment this save plenty of efforts and time, one of the most important goals of e-learning. Students can also conduct many experiments without any constraints to place or time. However Virtual Lab cannot replace hands-on experience of experiments carried out in laboratory environment. Dr. Chetna Sharma also demonstrated two experiments on VALUE@Amrita which is an initiative of

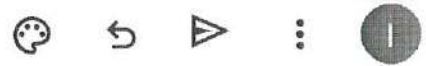
Ministry of Human Resource Department under National Mission on Education through ICT. Dissection is an integral part of Zoology and there is no substitute for the hands-on experience of dissection as it allows to see, touch and explore various systems of the animals. Therefore, on the 7th day (15th July) of FDP dissections of Leech (Reproductive System and Nervous System) and Starfish (Aristotle's lantern) were carried out by Dr. Shipra Goyal and Dr. Anita Gajraj respectively along



with diagram demonstrations. All the faculties took very keen interest in learning. The practical hands-on approach continued on the last day of FDP i.e. 17th July. The nervous system of Sepia was exposed and demonstrated by Dr. Anita Gajraj to all the faculty members. By the end of the 8th day (17th July) of FDP all faculty members of Zoology and Biotechnology developed skills to carry out a range of experiments ranging from use of various important instruments to dissections to e-learning i.e., Virtual Lab. The objective of FDP was fulfilled as it provided both hands-on experiences along with strengthening of academics. It also promoted the inculcation of competencies in teaching fraternity with in-depth knowledge and insight into the subject with its various core areas. Department of physics also conducted various sessions on important areas Electronics Lab. Experiments, Microwave Lab. Experiments, Spectroscopy Lab. Experiments, Hallmark Spectra Analyser etc.

This series of FDP aimed at polishing the skills of every faculty member and also to improve their interaction amongst the faculties of other departments. The idea of giving task to every department to plan the FDP also helped in enhancing their leadership qualities and intrapersonal communication. Overall, it was a very fruitful programme. All the departments exchanged their ideas and different software which will help in innovative digital teaching in future.

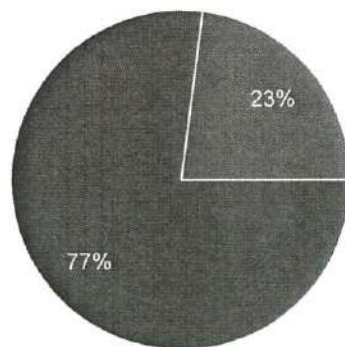
