The college did not halt its functioning instead all stake holders tirelessly worked hard towards its vision and mission of imparting education to the students. Though the list cannot be equated with the past smooth running academic sessions, college tried to strive its best to attain the same cadre or level of achievements this year also. Keeping in mind that 'learning cannot be locked down' students and teachers both excelled to the best of their capabilities to add novel feathers in the hat of the college in this academic session too along with fighting against all odds posed by COVID-19 pandemic.

The major achievements during the Pandemic was the establishment of the **Teaching-Learning Centre** of the college that conducted online Teacher-Training Programmes within the college but also acted as a facilitator of Teacher-Training for Government colleges across the state.

Faculty initiative 'Gyandoot'- Under the Gyandoot programme initiated by the Directorate, College Education, Rajasthan, Jaipur, 14 faculty members of the college voluntarily conducted live sessions and uploaded videos related to their respected subjects for the students of the government colleges across Rajasthan.

It's a matter of great honour that our Kanoria PG Mahila Mahavidyalaya has been designated as Nodal Centre of 'Virtual Labs' by Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) under the National Mission of Education under ICT and will work in collaboration with IIT, Delhi.

College has received financial assistance for the project titled 'Consolidate of University Research for Innovation and Excellence **CURIE**' core grant for Women PG Colleges from the Department of Science and Technology, Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India.

To provide a structural platform for budding women entrepreneurs of the college, 'NARIKA' the Incubation Centre has been registered under section 8 of Companies Act, 2013 in December, 2021 as 1st Women Specific Startup Incubator in Jaipur

and 2nd in Rajasthan. NARIKA stands for 'New Avenues in Research, Innovation and Knowledge Acceleration'. This centre was formally inaugurated on 6<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 by Honourable Minister of Industry, Government of Rajasthan, Smt. Shakuntala Rawat.

Principal Kanoria PG Mahila Mahavidyalaya JLN Marg, Jaipur- 302015 I wish to highlight the contribution of all the staff members of Kanoria College family who helped in achieving the moto 'learning cannot be locked down', for this all the departments of the college developed and uploaded e-content for Undergraduate and Postgraduate courses. Link for the content was shared on Website and this was informed to all students through bulk messaging facility. Online classes were conducted for UG and PG courses through Google Classroom. The faculty, students and even support staff quickly adapted to the changing needs and requirements, thus added nuance to the teaching learning methodology.

For the academic session 2021-22, total 5930 students were enrolled for 11 undergraduate courses run in the college. 724 students were admitted in 14 post graduate courses. College got affiliation for a new subject- Garment Production and Export Management (GPEM) in B.A. and B.Com. programme.

Excellence in academics is the hall-mark of a good institution and the results of our students in the university examinations have made us proud. Even such a stressful time, the result of our students has been commendable. For UG classes it is 99% and for PG classes, the average result is 100% for the examinations 2021. Ms. Chitra Soni, student of B.Sc. Biotechnology (Session 2019-20) received Gold Medal in 31st convocation of the University of Rajasthan held on 8<sup>th</sup> January, 2022.

I am trying to highlight in brief the activities conducted for the development of the students and achievements of the students. The extensive report is in your hands in form of the Chronicles of Kanoria 2021-22.

First time, the college filled 'NIRF' on 25-01-2022. This framework outlines a methodology to rank institutions across the country started from the year 2015. The result of the ranking is awaited.
