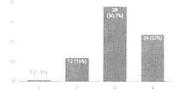

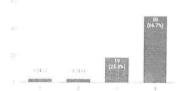


3. Is the Syllabus justifying the connectivity between theory and practicals / applications :



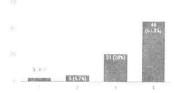

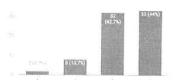

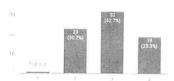
