लोगों के बीच मेंटल हेल्थ पर बात चलाने का काम की जाती है। पेशे में ऑनलाइन प्रोफेशनल के पद पर कार्यरत मानवी ने बताया कि जब मुझे पता चला कि साइकोलॉजिस्ट डिप्रेसिड में गिर रही हूँ तो समझ आया कि इस पर बात होने की जरूरत है। मैं 16 वर्ष की थी जब मुझे मेरी मानसिक बीमारी के बारे में पता चला। डिप्रेशन में भी रहने। समाज में जब मानसिक स्वास्थ्य के प्रति सोशल मीडिया के माध्यम से लोगों बात करने लगे तब मेरे दिमाग में अपने अनुभवों को साझा करने का विचार आया। मैं अपने पॉडकास्ट में कविताओं के जरिए मेंटल हेल्थ पर चर्चा करती हूँ और अपने जीवन के अनुभवों को साझा करती हूँ। मैं अपनी पुस्तक को कविताएं जो मैंने डिप्रेशन एक मानसिक के दौर में लिखी हैं, पढ़ती हूँ।

किस्से, कोरोना ने भाई छीना, उसकी यादों को पॉडकास्ट पर आवाज दे रहे हैं अंशुमान

अंशुमान शर्मा ने बताया कि मेरे छोटे भाई ईशान शर्मा को मेरा पॉडकास्ट समर्पित है। 22 की उम्र में कोरोना से हमने उन्हें खोया। ईशान को क्रिकेट का बहुत शौक था। वहीं मैं नेट काउंटी में काउंटी क्रिकेट खेलता था। यहां खेलते हुए मेरे कई दोस्त बने। कुछ समय बाद हमें विचार आया कि ईशान को समर्पित करते हुए हम एक पॉडकास्ट शुरू करना चाहिए। महोत्सव के 1 से 2 एपिसोड आते हैं जहां क्रिकेट और क्रिकेट से जुड़ी बातों पर हम चर्चा करते हैं। जिसमें हाल ही में हो रही क्रिकेट में जुड़ी गतिविधियां और उन पर हमारी प्रतिक्रिया हम देते हैं। क्रिकेट देखने और खेलने में अंतर होता है तो दोनों नजरिए हम लिमनर्स को देते हैं, ताकि सभी को जानकारी पूरी मिल सके। 40 से 60 मिनट के एपिसोड में हम किस्से कहानियां भी साझा करते हैं।

Her kathak Guru was Shri Kundanlal Gangani of the Jaipur Gharana. After graduating from Kanoria college, she joined Kathak Kendra, Delhi on scholarship for 3 years which was extended further for 2 years. In Delhi she started her classical dance career.

She has been dancing since the age of 5 years starting from the Ravindra Manch, Jaipur and has won first prize in Rajasthan at the age of just 7 years. Since then, she has been unstoppable and has performed at famous international and national festivals and art centers. The rip off has always been prestigious laurels. She has also served at various platforms (selection committee-Ministry of Culture, NCERT and ICCR panel, Rajasthan Sangeet Natak Akademi, Kathak Kendra Jaipur etc. It is here that she pursued her passion for preserving and promoting art, culture and Kathak. Not necessarily in that order.



She incorporates various elements of classical, medieval and contemporary poetry in her performances such as poetry of Kalidas, Meera, Kabir, Ghalib as well as the French poet Yves Bonnefoy. 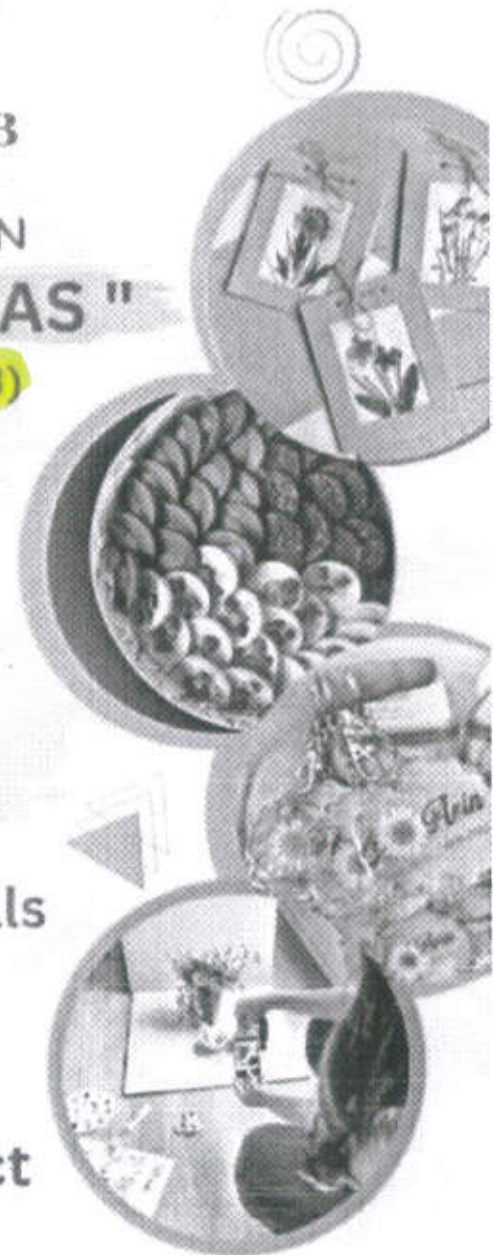

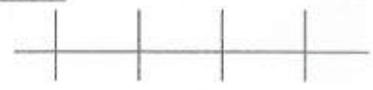

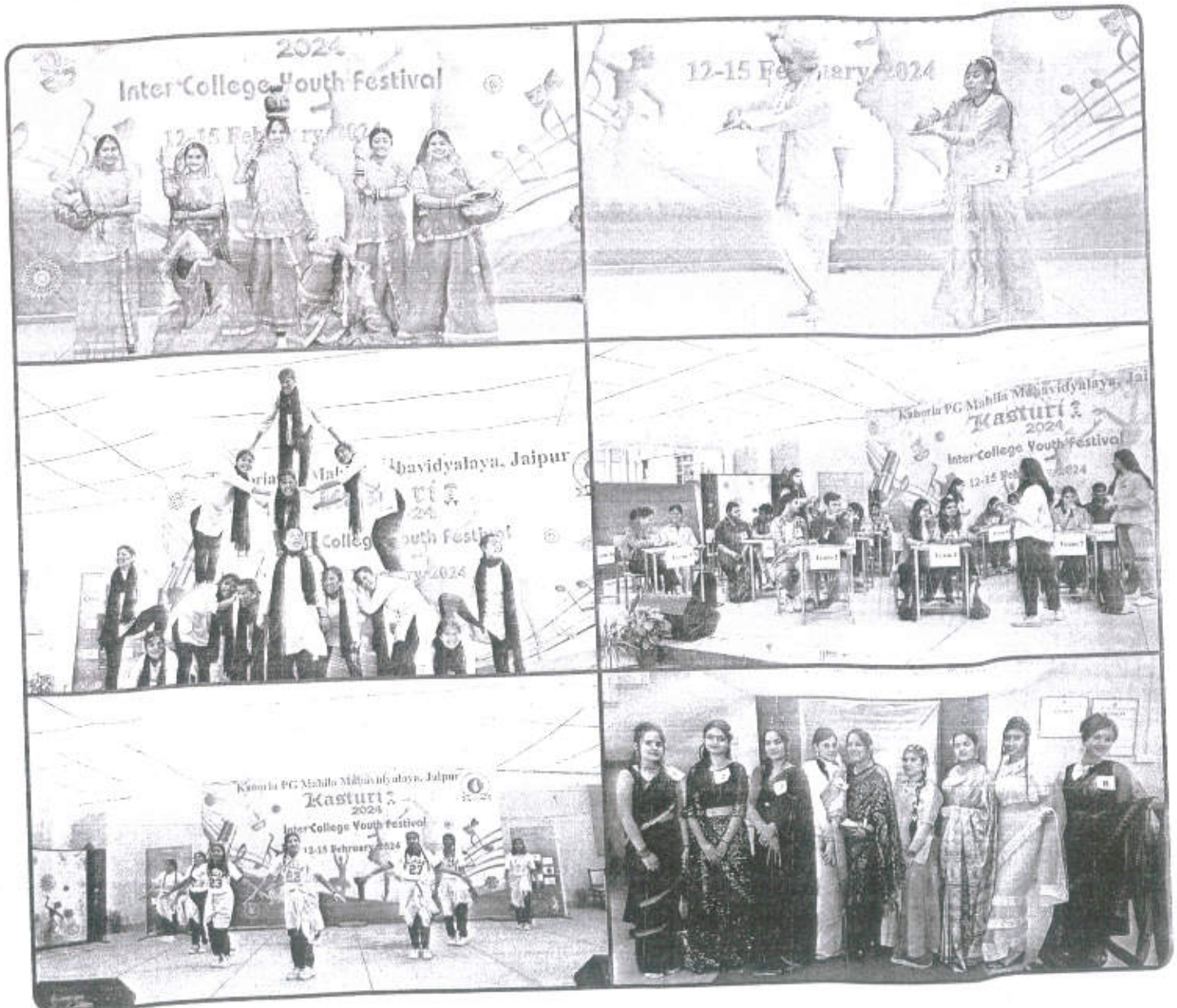
INTER COLLEGE YOUTH FESTIVAL

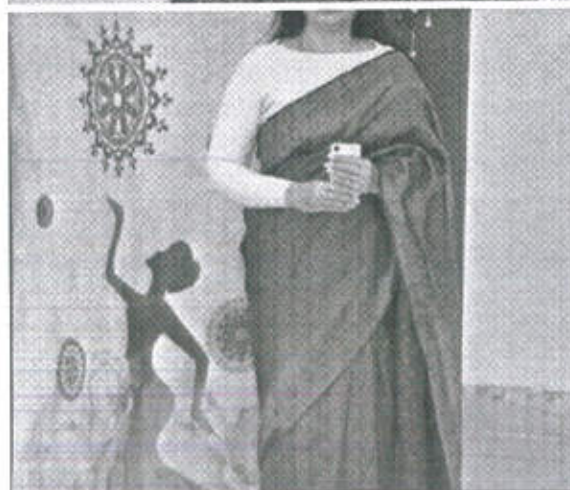

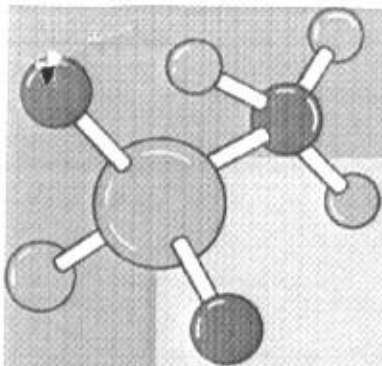

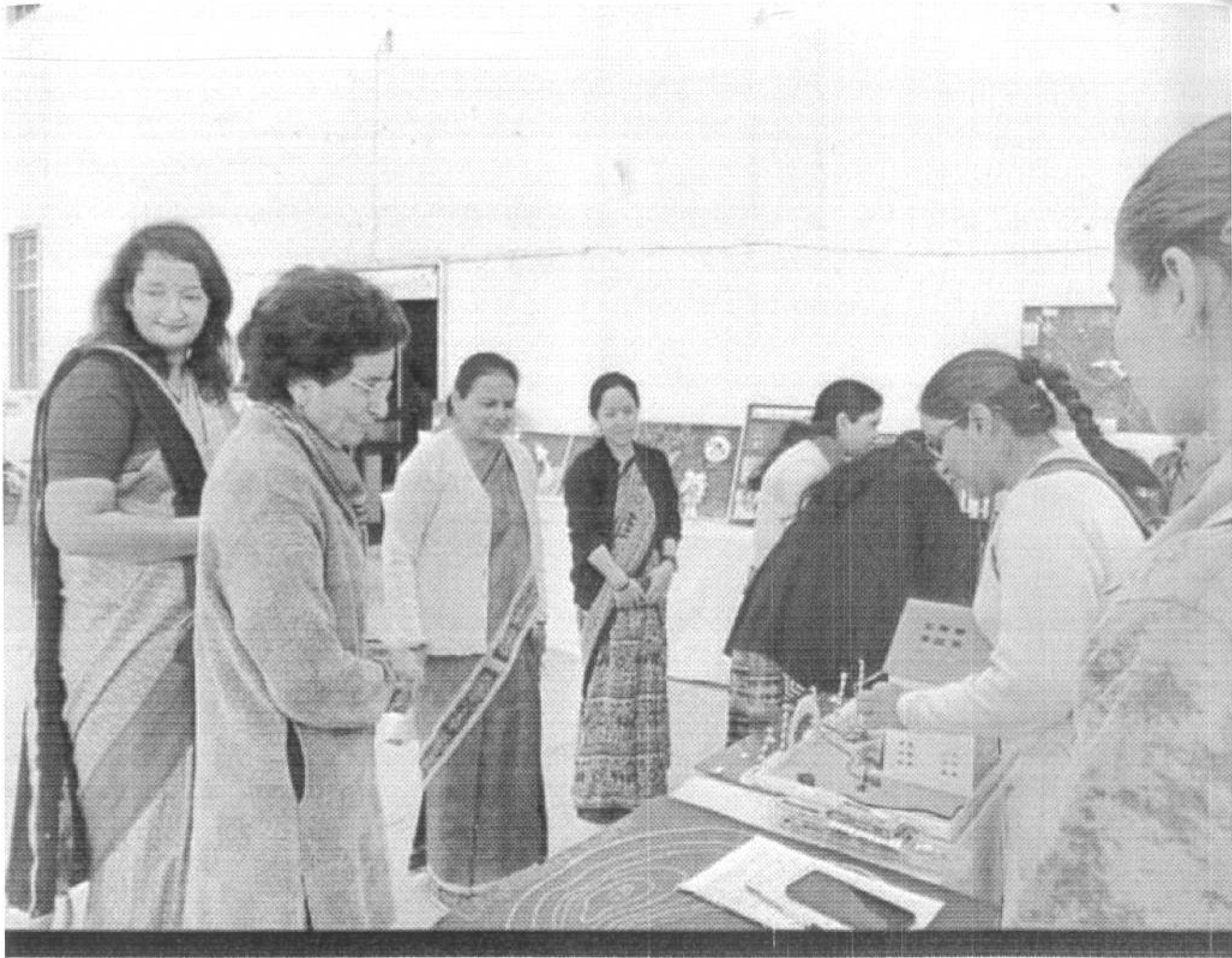
