

DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHOLOGY

The Department had many achievements to be proud of and various activities involving both staff and students. Workshop on 'Development Disorders and Their Treatments' was organized on 15th -16th September 2018 with expert Dr. Shivani Purnima, Clinical Psychologist from AIIMS, Delhi. Students of psychology from all over the city participated and were informed about the updated classifications and symptomatology of the disorders.

Two separate experiential workshops were organized on the topic 'Leadership in Mundane Self' by Ms. Sheetal Johar for Part-I and II students. An exposure workshop on 'Careers in Counselling' with school counsellors from renowned schools of Jaipur- Ms. Sakhi from Rukmani Birla School, Ms. Ashna Jain from Neerja Modi School, Ms. Yashwardhini from Sanskar School and Ms. Priyanka from The Palace School were invited on 17th November. Counsellors shared their personal journeys and the kind of cases they get while working with schools.

Another workshop was organized by SAKSHAM, a non-profit organization from Ahmedabad on 3rd December. Dr. Tarun Monga explained the cases that they handle in their clinic related to youth.

University of Rajasthan had invited Department faculty members and students to participate in the activities for Mental Health Day. Students participated in Shanti March, Painting Competition etc.

As part of hands-on learning and experience, students of Part-I and II visited Rajasthan University Women Association (Rehabilitation Cell and Family Cell). This helped the students to observe, report and document the cases. Movies such as Shrek, Loving Vincent, Shakespeare in Love, Secret Superstar were showcased. The academic year ended with remedial classes for students.
