

Report on 4th International Conference of ELT@I Rajasthan: Jaipur Chapter

Jaipur was the centre of attraction of the English Teaching fraternity yet again. Since the chapter came into being in 2009, this was the fifth International Conference being organized by us-four chapter conferences and we have had the proud privilege to host the ELTAI INDIA conference in 2014.Our call for papers for this conference on Teaching English in Multicultural Classrooms: Perspectives, Possibilities and Challenges sent across during June evoked huge response. We were flooded with Abstracts and the eventual participation of professionals from India and abroad. Kanoria Mahila Mahavidyalaya as co-hosts provided us the perfect ambience to host this academic fiesta. We had a thought provoking keynote address by Prof Shreesh Choudhari who highlighted upon the need to develop short modules and reach out to young learners.
