IQAC Report Session 2021-22

Internal quality and assessment cell of the college always aims at making a significant and a meaningful contribution towards academic excellence and to enhance the quality parameters of the institution. The IQAC of the college works under the guidance of Principal Dr. Seema Agrawal and Coordinator Dr Ranjana Agrawal.

With the idea to brainstorm the minds of its faculty members a 10 days Faculty Development Programme was organized between 8-20 July 2021 by all the departments of the college under the guidance of IQAC. It was a very fruitful programme which was designed by the faculty themselves keeping in view their holistic development. The major areas of discussion were related to their respective field and an overview on digital learning tools and Research aptitude. This series of FDP aimed at polishing the skills of every faculty member and also to improve their interaction amongst the faculties of other departments. The idea of giving task to every department to plan the FDP also helped in enhancing their leadership qualities and intrapersonal communication. During the same phase the academic calendar of the session was also framed by the committee members.

IQAC of the college, other than creating a learner centric environment also took some initiatives to fulfill its social commitments by organizing Free COVID vaccination camp twice in the campus in collaboration with SMS medical College on 4th September and 27 October 2021, which benefitted the students, faculty members and the society. In which More than 400 people were vaccinated.

To usher in quality another two day FDP was organized by IQAC, Kanoria PG Mahila Mahavidyalaya in collaboration with Jaipuria Institute of Management,

Jaipur on 29th and 30th November 2021. The speaker of the FDP was Dr Prabhat Pankaj, Director, Jaipuria Institute of Management, Jaipur. In the first session of the FDP held on 29th November 2021 Dr Prabhat Pankaj proceeded with an interactive session on Happiness & Mindfulness for effectiveness at the workplace –"Lessons from Happiness". This session focused on increasing reading, research & meeting people as these are good sources of knowledge. He set an example from the book of Jim Collins - "Good to Great". In the second session of FDP on "Effective Teaching" held on 30th November 2021 Dr Prabhat Pankaj focused on Campus Orientation which involves Happy Learning Mandalas – Green, Aesthetic, Intellectual & Ethical aspects of the college which needs to be enhanced. He focused on that a college should have their own 'Code of conduct'. He explained that education imparted should have both instrumental and intrinsic values.

Under the industry academia collaboration with BOSCH, training for students was organized during 13-17 December 2021 keeping in view igniting the moral values of the students, in this training 30 students and 1 faculty member of the college participated under the leadership of IQAC Coordinator Dr. Ranjana Agrawal. To benefit the institution in the accredition phase, the IQAC of the college also organized a Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on NAAC SSR and Peer Team Visit on 23rd and 24th December 2021 in Association with Teaching Learning Center of the College. Prof Agarwal discussed in detail all the criterion of NAAC evaluation, focusing on Research and Publications, Teaching pedagogy, Innovation in teaching, blended learning, Evaluation Process both at UG and PG level. He also mentioned that college needs to highlight and give prime importance to Administrative Audit report, Academic Audit report and Feedback system. The Day two of the Faculty Development Programme was scheduled to have an insight about the Peer Team visit. Prof

Agarwal shared his first-hand knowledge with the faculty, he also guided the learners about do's and don'ts while writing the report.

With regard to fulfill its social commitments and take initiatives to reach to the community a webinar on E-waste management to create environment sustainability in collaboration with Karo Sambhav organization was organized on 17 January 2021. IQAC of the college also took initiatives to collaborate with industries to enrich its faculty and students. With this objective various MOU's were signed like with Global Talent Tracker, Pune (under CSR barckleys London), which includes training and placement both. Another academic collaboration with the aim to give practical exposure to the students was signed with the B.Lal institute of Biotechnology. In collaboration with B.Lal institute various student oriented activities were organized like essay competition Hindi Diwas and the best Meme activity. To enhance computer skills of our non teaching staff, 7 days Computer training programme was organized in collaboration with teaching learning centre of the college in which staff was divided as per the need in two groups basic and advanced in which they were trained about the use of computer, an exam was also conducted to check about their learning and certificate was also provided.

This year another important initiative was taken to get national institute ranking through National institutional ranking framework, Ministry of Education, Government of India.
