CAT Course

Summary Report

2016-17

Certificate in Accounting Technician (CAT) course is designed by the Institute of Cost Accounts in India to bridge the gap between the skills possessed by the youth and the skills expected by the industry. 30 students were enrolled in the CAT course during the session 2016-17 and gained knowledge about accounting techniques including filing of income tax return.

2017-18

CAT course is a short term employment oriented course including theoretical concepts, computer training and industry internship.15 students were enrolled in the CAT course during the session 2017-18. The first level exam was conducted on 6 January, 2018 and all the students cleared it.

2018-19

15 students were enrolled in the CAT course during the session 2018-19 and gained knowledge about accounting techniques. The students after qualifying become eligible to give intermediate exam attempt for becoming Cost and Management Accountant.

2019-20

13 students were enrolled in the CAT course during the session 2019-20. Many students who pursued this course in past years are placed in different banks, industries and some are working in Chartered Accountant firms.

2020-21

Due to Covid-19 pandemic, no student enrolled in the course.

Course Outcome

The students learn basic accountancy works needed in the industry. The course is useful in seeking employment in accounts and finance related jobs.

Certificate Course in Organic Farming

Course Outcome:

The student, after certification got to know following aspects of the Organic Farming

- 1. Understanding of Basic Principles of Organic Farming
- 2. Organic Manure, Organic Pesticides & Vermicompost manufacturing Techniques
- 3. Understanding Organic Farming Practices: Farm Design, Seeding, Plantation, Livestock Management, Water Management, Crop Rotation etc.
- 4. Internal Quality Control for Organic Produce: Quality control, documentation, monitoring
- 5. Certification of Organic Farming Produce: Quality Systems, documentation, Inspections, Procedure
- 6. Business Plan for Organic Produce Marketing: Costs & Benefits analysis, Governmental Schemes, Financial Assistance, Marketing Channels & Functions
- 7. Practical Knowledge through Field Visits

The above aspects prepare the students for self-employment as producer of organic produce, certification professional, consulting job in organic produce field and also for development of kitchen garden as hobby & self-consumption. In addition it helps in understanding of benefits of organic food vis-à-vis chemical intensive food products.

Yearly Course Summary of Last 5 Years

- 2019-20: Total enrolments during the year were 51, out of which 3 were not the student of the college. Certificate could not be distributed due to COVID Pandemic.
- II. 2018-19: Total enrolments during the year were 36. During field visit of the farm as well as processing facility students showed keen interest. General Manager of Morarka Foundation Sh Bapana also addressed the students.
- III. 2017-18: Total enrolments during the year were 25. During field visit of the farm as well as processing facility students were addressed by the Executive Director of Morarka Foundation Sh Mukesh Gupta.
- IV. 2016-17: Total enrolments during the year were 32 with 3 non collegiate enrolments. Field visit to the textile & food processing units of Morarka Foundation was organised, during which Executive Director of Morarka Foundation Sh Mukesh Gupta enlightened about the prospects of organic farming.

Functional English Report 2016-17

English as a language has been embraced as a universal language. It has become an important part of our education system as well. English is now not just a mere language but a tool of evaluation of one's personality. Kanoria P.G Mahila Mahavidyalaya has always paid attention to the need of the hour and designed its curriculum in the necessary manner.

The institution has numerous add on courses which intends at developing a student's skills and works on her over all personality improvement. One such course is "Functional English". It is a free of cost course which helps in improving a student's English language communication skills. Command on English is required in the present times for interviews, competitive exams, personality development etc. Other than offering English as a subject the college also offers an add on course for those students who are keen to learn and communicate in English.

In this year's session twelve students enrolled into this course and benefitted themselves. The course focused on grammar, pronunciation, overcoming the hesitation of speaking in English and personality development. Beginning with an introductory session the course proceeded with the objective of building confident individuals. Various activities were conducted in order to break the monotony of the classroom teaching and to create a pleasurable atmosphere for the students. It was noted that the students were getting rid of their hitch and were now becoming confident with communicating in English. Activities such as extempore, group discussion, games etc. was really helpful for the class.

In January an exam was conducted for the students to check their improvement and the students performed exceptionally well.

Functional English Report 2017-18

Kanoria P.G Mahila Mahavidyalaya has been known for providing more than the regular courses. The institution believes in developing a student's over all personality so that, the student is well prepared for the outer world. There are multiple add on courses available in the college out of which one is "Functional English". This is a free of cost course which primarily aims at building a student's English language foundation. In today's scenario English communication skills are an indispensable part of one's personality. It is crucial for career advancement and also for numerous competitive exams.

The Functional English course has been curated in similar fashion in order to cater all these needs of a student. The course pays special attention to basics of English grammar, pronunciation, communication skills such as writing, speaking, reading and listening and personality development.

This year 20 students from different streams actively took part into the course. All the students were taught from the basic level irrespective of their previous knowledge of the language. First few classes were dedicated to break the ice and to know what was making learning and speaking in English difficult for them. Students were encouraged to speak in English in order to get rid of any sort of hesitance. Initially the aim was to make them comfortable in the class and make them believe that they were not being judged for poor fluency. The students worked on their fluency, vocabulary and gradually developed confidence.

Various class activities such as games, quizzes, storytelling, group discussion etc. were held to create a fun atmosphere for the students which resulted in great participation. In the month of January an exam was conducted in order to test their growth. All the students performed splendidly.

Functional English Report 2018-19

Functional English is an add on or a certificate course which is offered to every student of Kanoria P.G Mahila Mahavidyalaya for the development of the student's English communicational skills along with personality development. The course pays special attention to learning of basic grammar and soft skills such as communication skills which includes, Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing skills. The curriculum of the course has been designed in accordance to the requirement of the students so that, students can highly benefit from it.

Every year many students enroll into the Functional English course from different streams with the objective of developing command over English language and personality development in order to be a confident candidate in the competitive world. This year a total of eighteen students enrolled into the course. The students were from different streams and years. Irrespective of their year or subject everyone was taught from square one that is basics.

The course duration was of 6 months and the fees was five hundred rupees. The session began with a general introduction in order to break the ice and get know their short comings with the language. Along with grammar lessons simultaneous attention was given upon personality development. Majority of the students were hesitant to talk in English language even after having a decent knowledge of English. So, numerous fun activities were conducted in order to remove the hitch and make them comfortable around each other and with the language also. Such as Extempore, Group Discussions, Games, Story Telling etc.

Language lab of Kanoria P.G Mahila Mahavidyalaya took the course to a next level. It had quizzes, video and audio lectures which instantly caught the student's attention and thus improved their skills. It considerably helped them with pronunciations. Gradually the students acquired confidence and became comfortable with the language and got over their hitch. Their grammar along with vocabulary improved. On 28th January 2019 an exam was conducted to test their learning.

All the students performed really well and scored brilliantly. Moreover, by the end of the course the students were confident and trained individuals.

Functional English Report 2019-20

Kanoria P.G Mahila Mahavidyalaya offers numerous certificate courses in order to enrich the students with some essential and educative skills. Other than the course curriculum the institution believes in offering many add on courses in order to prepare the students for the outer world.

One such certificate course is "Functional English". It is a six months course with a minimum fee of five hundred rupees. The course aims at developing a student's English communication skills along with personality development. Many students every year grabs this opportunity and learns new skills. English soft skills and confident personality are some features which have become crucial for excelling in career.

The course curriculum includes basic knowledge of grammar, English speaking and writing skills, personality development etc. Every student is trained from the very basic level. They are motivated to speak in English and get over any sort of hesitance. Fun activities such as games, discussions, storytelling, extempore etc. are held in order to involve them and make them participate in class overcoming their hitch. This way they learn communication skills as well as it helps in their personality development.

We make sure to use our language lab to the utmost. Students gets a chance to learn correct pronunciation, they take grammar quizzes and learn from audio and video lectures. This year students from Kanoria P.G Mahila Mahavidyalaya and Rajasthan School of Law for Women enrolled into the course.

On 12th February an exam was conducted in order to analyze the student's progress. The exam was based on grammar, vocabulary and writing skills.

French and German Language Certificate/Diploma Course

Report and Learning Outcome

Language course helps students in multidimensional ways, along with studying in classrooms students get opportunity to explore the subject out of classroom too. Kanoria P.G. Mahila Mahavidyalaya is offering its students with Certificate courses in French and German language from the session 2017-18. These courses provide students with an opportunity to learn a global language and become a multilingual speaker. The courses were designed to offer skills of reading, writing, listening and speaking as well as learning grammar and building vocabulary. College has not only focused on regular certificate course in foreign language but has also initiated Diploma Course in German to build a new choice for the students in the field of career as well as for learning purpose. Diploma course in German began for the students in 2019 to learn the language more exorbitantly. The duration of the course when we began in 2017 was 80 hours but now it has been reframed to 100 hours looking into the need of the hour.

In the initial months, students are taught about the greetings, alphabets, numbers, sentence formation, sounds, adjectives and articles followed by verbs, conjugations and tenses. Lastly students were taught more practical usage of the languages as making purchases, describing a place, filling forms, giving directions, etc. The courses also comprised of various activities like listening and singing French or German music, celebrating their respective cultural festivals like 'Joyeux Noel', and watching live clips and videos of France and Germany. The teachers also took students for interactive and learning sessions of language like 'German Days'(A national seminar for german teachers and learners), a seminar for 'Opportunities in French Language'. A musical fest in which a German music band 'RAGGABUND' performed was also attended by the students. The first batch of the students rendered a beautiful hindi song 'Kolaveri Di' translated by them in German and French during the Youth Festival of the college.

In due course of the session faculties keep updating the students about the career opportunities with foreign languages as a language trainer, tour guide, translator for Government Organizations and MNCs, as well as a interpreter for corporate and Government Organizations. Dr. Preeti Sharma and Ms. Hina Nahta with this perspective organized a visit of two French Universities 'Rennes Business School' and 'IESEG, Paris' on 15th January 2019. The representatives from both the Universities Ms. Maud Le Bars and Mr. Nithin Joseph accompanied by Mr. Romain Camus, French Institute Representative in India and Ms. Sanjana Sarkar, Manager, Campus France interacted with the

students and guided them with academic prospects available in France. Both the courses in this academic session also were a huge learning source for the students and opened doors of new opportunities in their career. On 24th October 2019, there was a visit to Rajasthan University guest house where students got the golden opportunity to meet the former Humboldt fellow and Professor of German, IIT Mandi -Prof. Dr. B. Subramaniam for discussion. On 28th and 29th November 2019, college invited Professor Elke Liebs for a lecture in simple German.

The trainers for French are Ms. Hina Nahta and Dr. Manali Agarwal and for German is Ms. Harshita Jangid. Both the courses are coordinated by Dr. Preeti Sharma.

Learning Outcome

With completion of this course, students are able to Communicate effectively in the foreign language in a variety of speaking situations and also become proficient in writing. The students who regularly attended the classes demonstrated notable command over language. This opens lot of avenues for them in career like Content writers, Translators, Tour Escorts, Embassy jobs, Corporate trainers and alike.

English Communication Skills Certificate Course

Report and Learning Outcome

Department of English was pleased to have The Fulbright-Nehru English Teaching Assistant Azelle Bahadory for the session 2019-20. Ms. Bahadory very meticulously organised sessions on English Communication Skills Certificate course which concluded with exceptional success. The course began on 5th August, 2019 and continued until 24th December, 2019. The course consisted of 2-3 hours per day of lessons. The lessons included some lecture; however, they were primarily designed to facilitate full active participation among all students in attendance. This objective was achieved through the facilitation of activities centered around developing the following skills and comprehensions: Confidence and proficiency in the use of spoken English, public speaking, interpersonal communication, self-reflection, self-expression, critical thinking, conflict resolution, decision-making, variations in types and styles of communication, overcoming barriers to communication, and job interview strategies. Lessons were adaptive and tailored to student needs based on intermittent class surveys. The findings of these surveys showed that the highest demand was on confidence in English speaking, public speaking, and overcoming grammar mistakes

Learning Outcome

All students who were in attendance for over 80% of the course demonstrated notable improvement in all of the above proficiencies through practical application. A written exam covering theory has been administered to the students who have achieved the benchmark of 80% or higher attendance. All feedback from the students who took part has been overwhelmingly positive.
