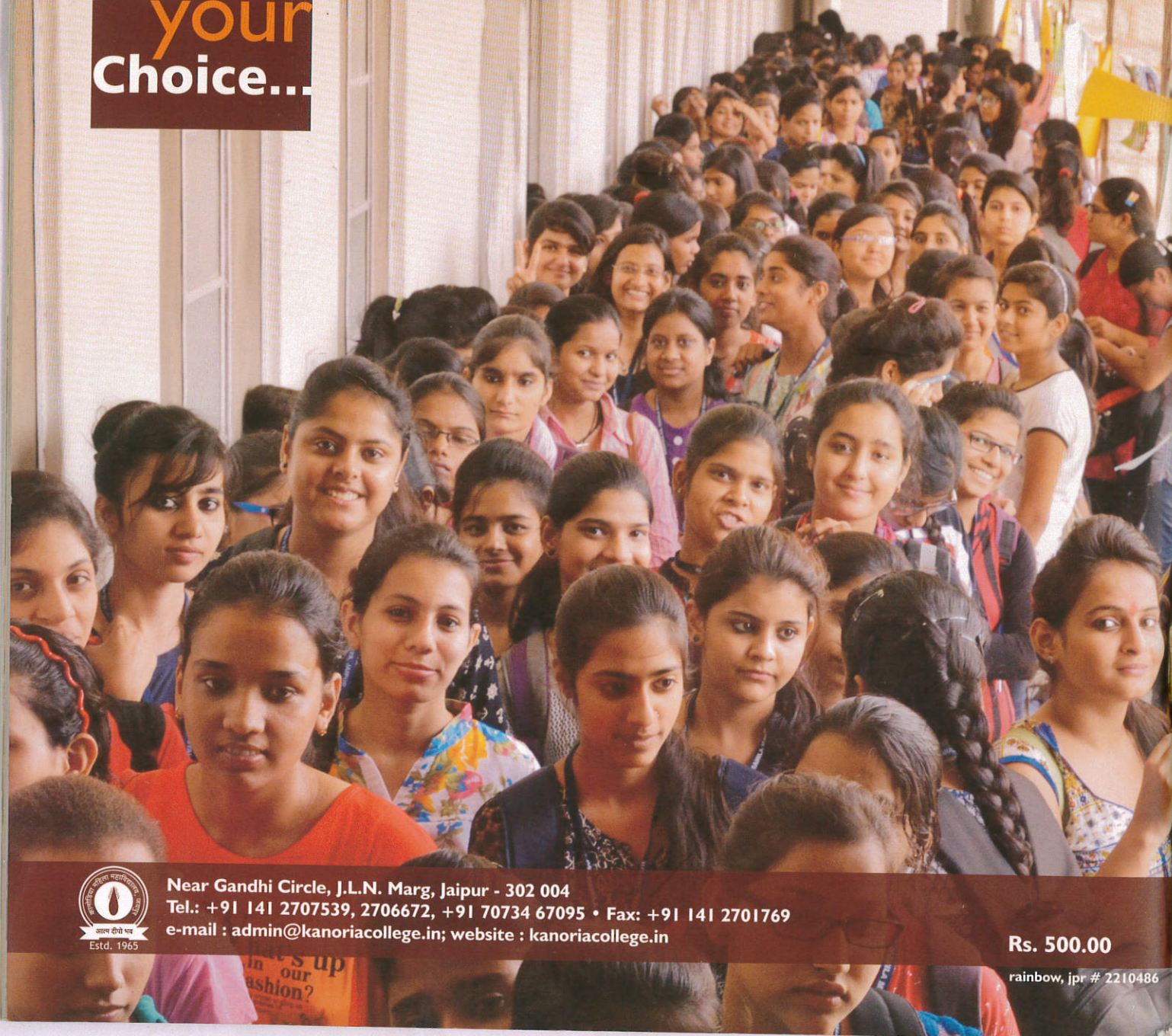

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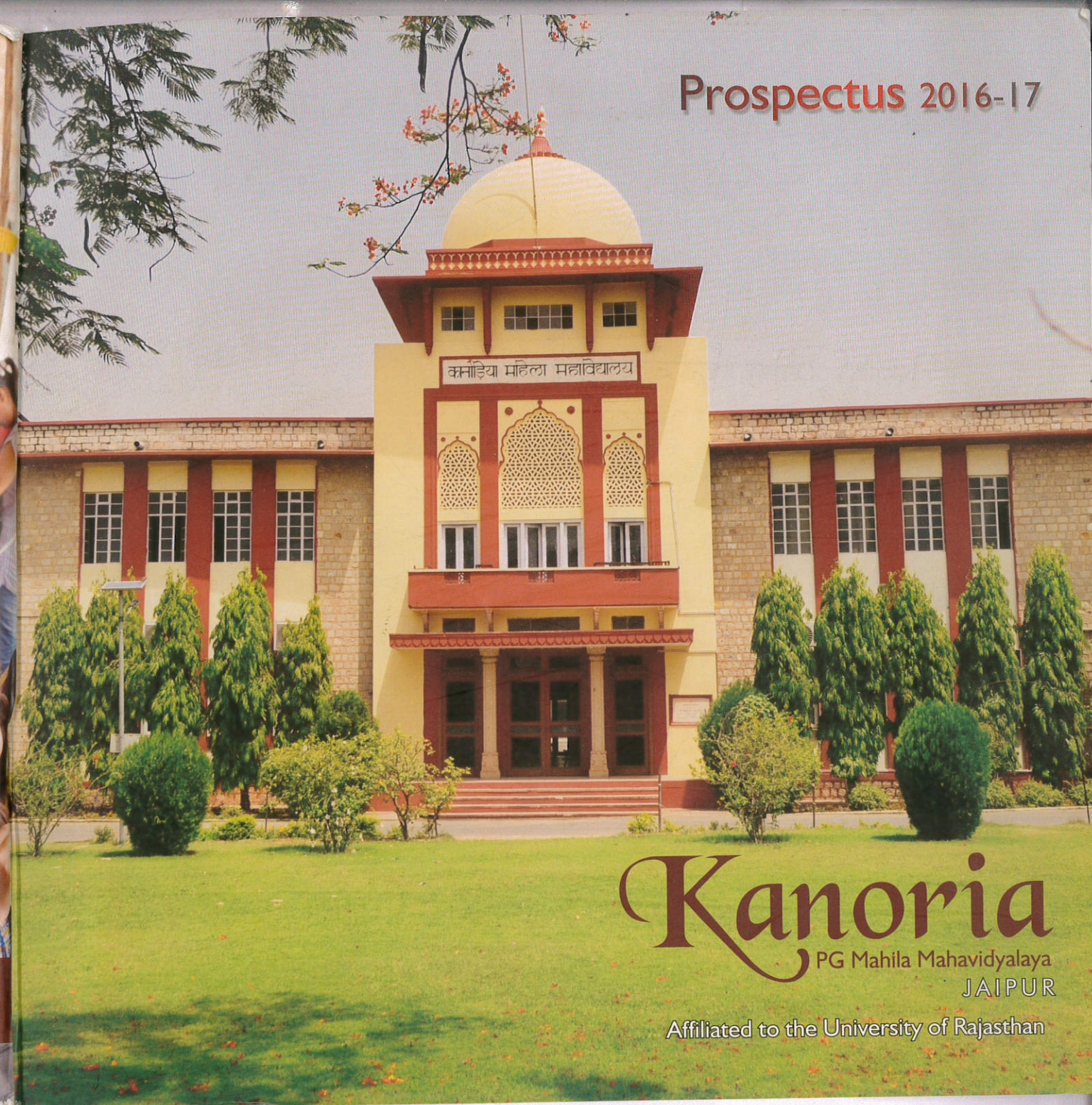

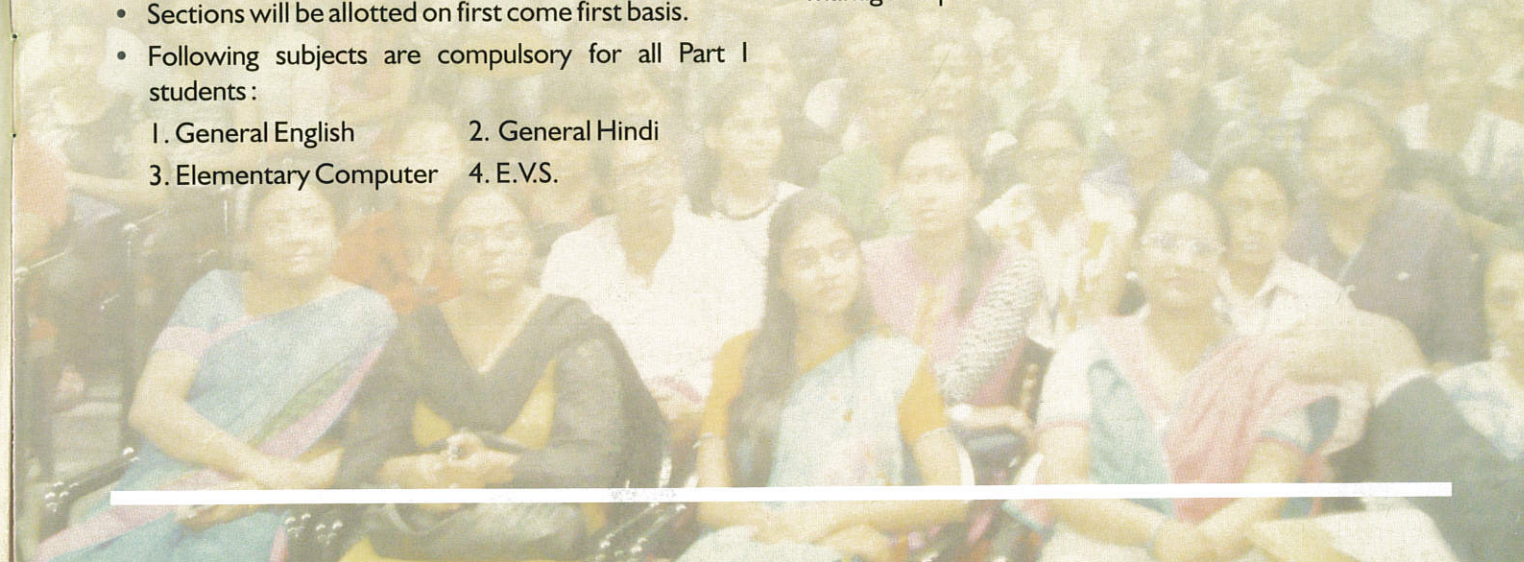

NEW STUDENTS

- Fixed number of seats in every faculty.
- Admission lists will be put up on the website. Kindly check the lists and pay the fees before the due date failing which your application shall not be considered under any condition.
- Admission to the desired/applied faculty and subject depends on the availability of seats.
- Kindly consult the Admission Committee for guidance in choosing subject combination and any queries related to admission.
- Provisional admission in Part-I to students with a supplementary in the Senior Secondary Examination is permissible.
- Students should enroll themselves in their respective subject classes within 15 days of paying their fees, failing which their admission will stand cancelled.
- If a student seeks change in the faculty/subject, it will be permissible only on payment of Rs. 100/- and if seats are available in the subject combination being offered. Faculty change is possible only from :
 - Science Faculty to Arts and Commerce.
 - Arts to Commerce.
 - Commerce to Arts.
- The college will not be responsible for any lapse on the part of the student.
- Inter transfer from one college to another college within the city is not allowed.**

OLD STUDENTS

- Students of Part-II, Part-III, Hons. and M.A. Final should seek admission and deposit their fees without waiting for the declaration of their examination results. Fees will be refunded in case the student fails in the examination.
- Students are required to submit their mark sheet in the office within 15 days of the declaration of the result.

Participation in cultural activity at National Level will be given special weightage in admission.

Concession and Exemptions :

- Winners in National Level Sports will be given total fees (college fees) exemption after trials.
- Renewal of exemption will be subject to performance appraisal.
- Fee exemption between 50 to 100% will be given to national level achievers in sports, NCC, NSS, Scout and position holders from any board of examination.
- Fee concession will be given to meritorious students with 85% and above in Arts and 90% and above in Commerce and Science.** Quantum of concession will be decided by the committee.

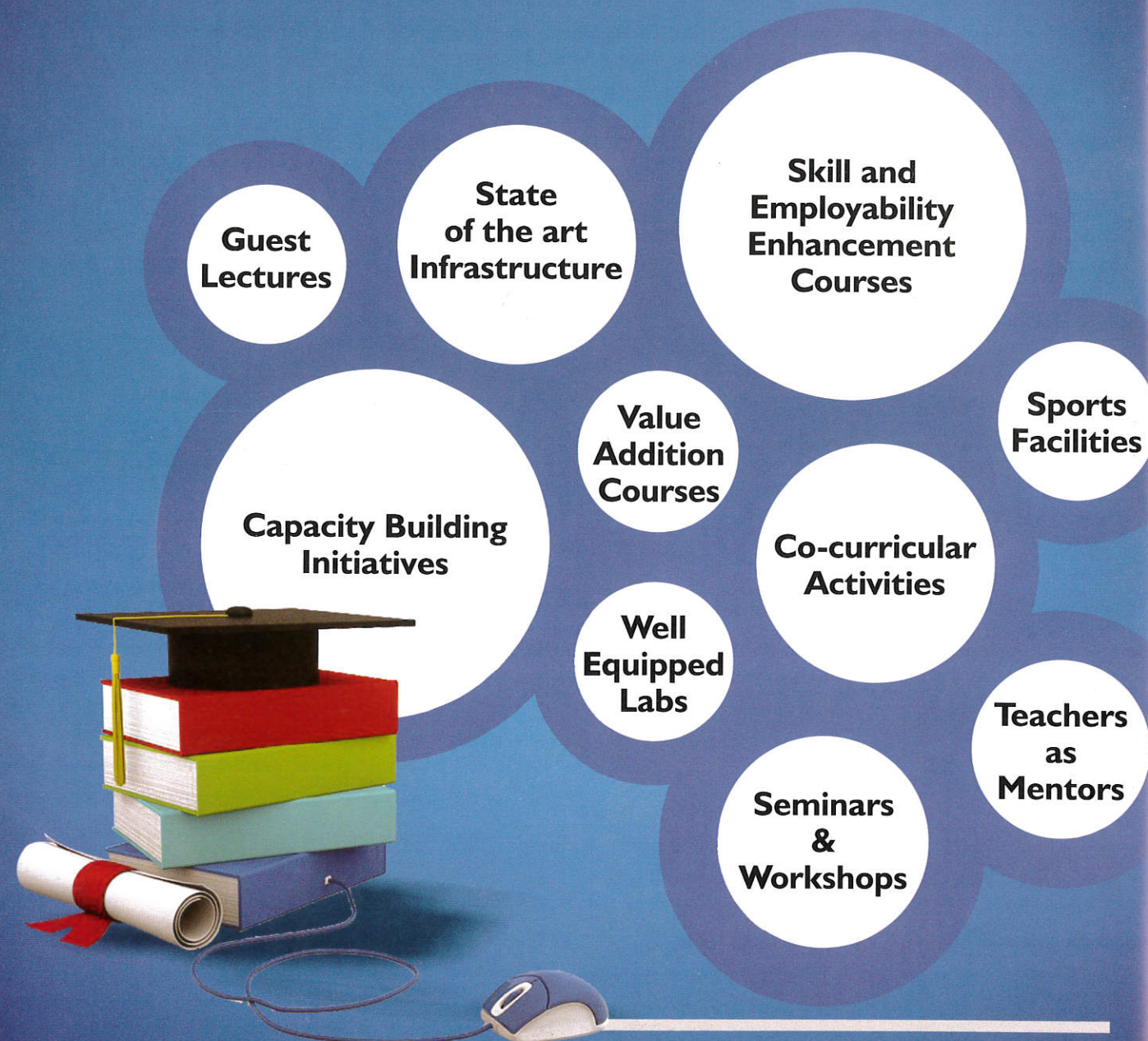
