Bachelor of Science in Home-Science is one of the most applied subjects which directly influence an individuals' perspective of dealing with day to day problems of life. The subject matter involves managment of time, energy and money, nutrition at various stages of life and in various desease conditions, understanding stages of human development and human psychology, intricacies of textile and fabric to stitching and extension of complex messages in simple form to the masses. #### **Admission Procedure for New Students**

- Merit lists will be posted on website and is updated from time to time. Kindly check the lists and pay the fees before the due date failing which your application shall not be considered under any condition.
- Admission to the desired/applied faculty and subject depends on the availability of seats.
- Kindly consult the Admission Committee for guidance telephonically in choosing subject combination and any queries related to admission.
- Provisional admission in Part-I to students with a supplementary in the Senior Secondary Examination is permissible.
- Students should enroll themselves in their respective subject classes within 15 days of paying their fees, failing which their admission will stand cancelled.
- If a student seeks change in faculty or subject, it will be permissible on payment of Rs. 100/- only if seats are available in the desired faculty or subject. Stream change is possible only from:
  - o Science Faculty to Arts and Commerce.
  - o Arts to Commerce.
  - o Commerce to Arts.
- Inter transfer from one college to another college within the city is not allowed.

#### **Re-Admission for Current Students**

- 1. Admission procedure to UG Part II and III and PG (Final Year) is also online.
