PARENT - TEACHER MEET

Kanoria PG Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Jaipur successfully conducted Virtual Parent Teacher Meet, in spite of Covid-19 pandemic situation. In previous years, college has been conducting face to face Parents-Teacher meet to interact with the parents/ guardians for their feedback and suggestions about their wards and college as well. College received a total of 1004 feedback out of which 912 were received from the parents of undergraduate courses and 92 from post-graduate students. डांडिया महोत्सव





DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTANCY & BUSINESS STATISTICS

The session 2020-21 began with Virtual Interaction with students of B. Com Part II and Part III. A special lecture on 'How to Attend Online Classes via Google Classroom' was delivered on 20 July 2020. Various tools of Google Classroom and the importance of technology in this era was explained to the students. Around 220 students attended the session. On 23 September 2020, the department conducted a virtual group discussion on 'Impact of Covid-19 on the life of students' for Postgraduate students. Around 8 students presented their views on the topic and discussed the pros and cons of Online Teaching. On 31 October 2020, a

webinar on 'Effective Study Skills in Current Scenario' was conducted by Ms. Vandana Kabra, Faculty & Counsellor at Amity University, Jaipur. She discussed teaching- learning scenarios in the post pandemic period. She emphasized on stress free learning for students and suggested application of Time Management technique in day to day life. The students were motivated to focus on studies rather than pandemic aftereffects. The webinar was attended by around 100 students. On 4 December, a webinar on Investor Awareness Program was conducted for the students via Google Meet to understand the securities market. Around 80 students learned the importance



of the securities market and benefitted from the session. On 8 December 2020, a virtual Oral Paper Presentation session was organised for the PG students on 'Investment Avenues in 2020'. Sisina Thomas, Riya Panwar and Pooja Singh presented papers on the challenges and opportunities associated with the topic. On 11 December 2020, an online session on 'Digital Banking' was conducted for UG students. This session was conducted by in-house faculty Dr. Bharti Godhwani, Assistant Professor, Department of EAFM. Around 100 students actively participated in the session and learned the basics of Banking through digital platforms. An Inter College National Accounting Quiz 2020 was organised virtually by the department on 14 December 2020. Around 350 students registered for the Quiz from different colleges of different states. The aim of the Quiz was to enhance the knowledge of students in the field of Accountancy & Statistics. The departmental activities also motivated and guided them for participation in various workshops and enrichment programs related to GST, Tally etc. Overall, the students benefited from this new mode of learning and appreciated the sessions conducted for them.

DEPARTMENT OF BIOTECHNOLOGY

Biotechnology is a wide discipline that studies the harnessing of cellular and biomolecular processes to develop technologies that help in improving health. Keeping this in mind, the department organised various activities for students to provide a practical perspective of the subject.

Two days' introductory classes were conducted, giving students a virtual tour of the Biotech laboratory, explaining various instruments and their working principles. This helped them to get familiar with the department. An online quiz 'Biotechniquiz' was organised online on 4 December 2020 for the students to gear up their minds and check their knowledge. 49 students actively participated in the quiz and performed well. All participants securing 70% or above marks were given certificates.

An online Poster Competition titled 'Role of Biotechnology in Human Welfare' was organised on 11 December 2020, in which all the students participated actively. The students made posters on various topics related to the title. E-certificates were given to



all 55 participants. Top three positions were secured by Aditi Jhawar, Prachi Panwar and Benika Sony. This activity helped students in understanding the subject and express their knowledge in a creative way.

On 18 December 2020, an online Extension Lecture on 'Skill Enhancement For Self Sustenance Through Organic Farming, Terrace Gardening and Hydroponics' by Dr. Manica Tomar, Senior Plant Pathologist, Dr Y.S. Parmar University, Solan, H.P. was conducted by the department. She gave a talk on utilizing the traditional methods of gardening and cultivating plants. The students learnt about various key techniques like organic farming, terrace gardening & hydroponics. They were also informed of various types of traditional manures like Neemastra and Brahmastra that can be easily prepared and used in homes. Dr. Tomar enlightened the students and encouraged them to be an entrepreneur.

Seminar presentations were given virtually by third year students from 4 to 6 January, 2021 and second year students from 11 to 13 January, 2021. This activity enhanced the research aptitude and developed interactive skills of the students. The presentations were judged by the faculty and feedback was given to students for their improvement.

On 4 February, 2021, a learning with fun activity 'Biozest' was organised in which various activities like Rangoli Making, Face Painting, Dumb Charades, Extempore and Best Out of Waste etc. were performed by the 24 students. In the Rangoli Competition, Khushi (Part-III) and Rashmi Saraswat (Part-II) were awarded I and II prize, respectively. In Face Painting Competition Riya Vijay and Venus Sahu grabbed I and II positions respectively. For 'Best Out of Waste' Shivani Sinha and Mahima Jangir were given I & II prize. The event gave the students an opportunity to showcase their hidden talents and facilitated bonding between students. The activities organised by the department widened the vision of the students and helped them to perceive Biotechnology beyond the syllabus.

DEPARTMENT OF BOTANY

During the session 2020-21, along with online teaching, several co-curricular activities were conducted. In the month of October, a quiz, poster and power-point presentations were organised for the students, from 3 to 8 October, 2020 on the occasion of Wildlife Week, in which about 260 students of B.Sc and M.Sc participated.

Power-point presentations were organised for students of M.Sc from 15 to 17 December 2020 to enhance their presentation skills. Students gave presentations on various topics like DNA damage & repair, enzymes, ATP, auxins, taxonomic literature, translocation of food in plants, DNA replication, electrophoresis, protein sorting, cytokinins and many more. It was a wonderful experience for students to deliver presentations. The first prize was awarded to Manisha Bai & Mansi Chawla, second prize to



Poornima Mohanan & Anshu and third prize to Arti Tyagi & Mahima Janu. In total, 48 students actively participated.

For enhancement of practical knowledge, an online three-day workshop on 'Molecular Biology Techniques' for young researchers was organised by the Department from 28 to 30 January 2021. On the first day of the workshop Dr Naseem Ahmad from Dept of Botany, AMU, Aligarh demonstrated the process of DNA isolation & purification followed by DNA quantification and Amplification on the second day of workshop. He also explained the working of instruments like thermocycler [PCR], Nano-photometer and UV visible spectrophotometer used in the process. He also gave emphasis on taking necessary precautions during the experiment as instruments are expensive and some chemicals are carcinogenic.

On 28 January 2021, the session of Dr Naseem Ahmad was followed by a session of ELISA by Dr Aparna B Rathore and a session on Blotting Technique on 29 January 2021 by Dr Reema Srivastava.

On 30 January 2021, the session on RAPD was illustrated by Dr Sumita Kachhawa, Associate Prof, Dept of Botany, UOR, Jaipur. She also explained other topics like Molecular Markers, SPOT Markers and Dendograms.


The workshop was appreciated by the students of M.Sc Sem I & III. About 68 students enthusiastically participated in the workshop and gained a lot of knowledge from it.

DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

The year 2020 brought a different perspective to learning and teaching for not only students but also to faculty members. The department left no stone unturned by organizing various activities, interactive sessions, and webinars to keep students engaged. The session began with a departmental activity on 'Coordination in Organization' on 2nd Aug 2020 imparting the

importance of coordination in which around 50 students participated and understood the practical implication of coordination. On 4 Aug 2020, a virtual PPT competition on 'School of Management Thought' was organised. Around 35 students participated in this competition.

In the series of activities, a webinar on 'Professional and Personal Effectiveness- Time Management' by Professor Girish Chandran Pillai was organised on 27 August 2020. He threw light on the importance of effective time management. An online quiz related to "HRM" was



organised the next day on 28 August 2020. Students actively participated in another live Quiz organised by the department on 31 August 2020.

On 26 and 27 October, powerpoint presentations were presented by students on 'Success Stories of Indian Entrepreneurs' through which students got to know various adversities, hardships, creativity and innovations that entrepreneurs bring to the society. Around 90 students submitted and 70 students gave presentations. A group discussion on 'Pros and Cons of Online Teaching' was also held on 4 November 2020 to know what students felt about online studies. Around 45 students participated.

On 16 December, an extension lecture was organised via google meet on 'Motivation for Excellence'. The resource person, Professor Dr. Ashok Sharma, University of Rajasthan, motivated students to stay focussed on their goals and try to achieve excellence. He encouraged the habit of aiming for perfection in every endeavor. Around 100 students participated with great zeal.

Lastly, a two day workshop was conducted virtually by the department on 'Communication Skills (verbal and written)' by the soft skills trainer Ms. Shrandhanjali from Amity University Rajasthan on



23 and 24 December. It helped students in improving their speaking and writing skills in a professional arena. Over 100 students from BBA and B.Com participated enthusiastically in this workshop. With this workshop the session came to a wrap for the department. The department always strives for excellence and works towards the holistic development of students.

DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

The department organised numerous activities during the session 2020-21 to enhance the skills amongst the students. 


47 students who participated. The focal point of this workshop was to enhance the painting skills of the students.

If proper care and nutrition is not provided to pregnant women and in first two years of child than far reaching consequences can happen. Dr. Prachi Avinash, Faculty Food science & Nutrition, CCAS, MPUAT, Udaipur, gave an overview on Efficient & effective use of available area for growing vegetable and fruits, so that multiple malnutrition problems can be resolved money can be saved, chemical free fruits & vegetables can be consumed. She provided valuable information related to site selection, plant selection and useful tips for Nutri-garden.

Two day online National workshop on 'Do-it-yourself' Lifestyle' Accessory designing was organised on 10 and 11 November 2020. Prof. Khanna is a well known experimentalist in the field of Electronics and Communication. He explained the basics of microwave and X-Bench in a very lucid way. 10 faculty members of the department were benefited by this session.

Covid-19 pandemic has changed education dramatically, with the distinctive rise of e-learning, whereby



The celebration consisted of a series of activities like Intra College Poster Making Competition, All India Poster Making Competition, Students presentations and deliberation of chief guest on 'How Much Safe We are with Microwave Radiations?'

Principal Dr. Seema Agrawal virtually inaugurated the event and welcomed chief guest Prof. Deepak Bhatnagar and all the participants. Having Prof. Deepak Bhatnagar, Former Member, Syndicate and Senate, Former Head, department of Physics, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur as the chief guest, was a resounding success with enthusiastic students from various age groups and streams collaborating and competing in a wonderful display of All India Poster Making Competition.

The enthusiasm of the students was revealed in the celebration of Dr. Kalam's birthday. They expressed their feelings through speeches and poems describing not only his life history but also his achievements in the betterment of the Nation.

An All India Poster Making Competition on 'Virtual Replacing Real?' was organised to explore and encourage creativity in students and offer them a platform to showcase their skills. The creativity and ideas to resolve the particular topic related to the present scenario of life were artistically presented through and captured in posters. The posters were assessed on the basis of rubrics such as relevance to theme, design and creativity. These creative masterpieces of participants were presented in a poster slide show.



There was an air of excitement and enthusiasm during the poster slideshow amongst 62 students as eager and committed participants from all over India toiled to create masterpieces. It was a splendid show of masterstrokes by our young and talented students. The aim of this competition was not merely to see the creative aspect but also to trigger the thought process of the

students and sensitize them towards these burning & serious issues. The final judgment was made by two honourable judges Prof. Deepak Bhatnagar and Dr. Charu Goyal, Head, Department of English. Three best entries were given a cash prize of Rupees 500/- as Shrashti Kumawat from Kanoria College, Shrishti Ravishankar from Vidyapeeth Institute of Technology, Surat and Bhawana Bisht from Banasthali Vidyapeeth.

Dr. Deepti Chauhan thanked the participants for sharing knowledge and innovative ideas and utilizing their valuable time during the pandemic Covid-19. She also thanked our esteemed chief guest and Principal Madam who graced the occasion by their presence all the time during the event.

Powerpoint presentations by PG students on 1 and 2 December 2020 were organised virtually with the objective as presentation is a channel for students not only to share with others what they have learned but also to learn how to express themselves. It provides them a chance to challenge and expand on their understanding of the topic by having others ask questions. With this object, different topics were allotted to the groups of total 38 PG SEM-III students. The presentations of students were highly appreciable and encouraging.



Every group was bombarded with questions after the presentations which were handled quite tactfully by the students. Prior to the announcement of winners, the HOD, Dr. Usha Bhatia gave her comments and words of wisdom to the students so as to further improve their presentations and take it to a higher level. It was very motivating to hear her. Overall it was a great learning experience for everyone. The best three group presentations and individual presentations were awarded. According to the students' feedback, they felt an incredible increment in their confidence.

Online Survey in the form of a quiz was organised for UG Part- I students through which some serious questions related to post Covid-19 life were framed in a very interesting manner in order to teach them lessons to live life to the fullest. Total 63 students explained their opinion with full confidence and integrity. A few videos depicting important laws of Physics were also shown to them and they were asked to co-relate the results with their life.

Two series of extension lectures were organised by the department of Physics for PG students during this session. First series of lectures was conducted on Hydrogen Energy from 6 to 9 January, 2021. Dr. Rini Singh from Graduate School of Advanced Science & Engineering, Hiroshima University, Japan, was presided over as a guest speaker. In introduction Dr. Rini briefly reflected on the basics of Hydrogen energy i.e. why we need hydrogen energy and what are the uses of it? Dr. Rini Singh delved deep into the topic of production of hydrogen energy, hydrogen as a fuel cell, use of hydrogen in automobile industries and safety issues with hydrogen energy. At the end of the series Dr. Rini briefly touched upon the important points mentioned by her during the lecture series and resolved the queries of the students. Overall the lecture series was very informative and 35 students benefited from it.

Second series of lectures was conducted on 'Introduction to Advanced Quantum Mechanics' from 21 to 23 December 2020 by Dr. Dinesh Kumar from University of Rajasthan. He is an eminent scholar with his doctorate degree in Theoretical High Energy Physics from Indian Institute of Technology, Bombay, India and has accredited more than 15 research papers in various national and international journals. Starting with a brief review on Quantum Mechanics, he covered almost the whole of Advanced Quantum Mechanics. Total 36 PG students attended this series of lectures.

Like every year, this year also the National Graduate Physics examination was conducted for UG students on 24 January, 2021. Total 5 UG students appeared in this examination. Peer-learning sessions are a regular feature of the department where faculty members give presentations on particular topics and interact with each other in order to enhance their learning. The department plays a major role as a mentor to understand and solve students' professional and even personal issues. During this online session, students were encouraged more and more to interact with the faculty through messages and phone calls.

DEPARTMENT OF POLITICAL SCIENCE

The academic session 2020-21 was challenging yet a unique session in many ways. Keeping up with the worldwide trend of organising online academic activities, the department also followed the suit.



DEPARTMENT OF ZOOLOGY



With a view to motivate young participants to look for their future prospects in the field of nuclear spectroscopy, a two-day National Workshop entitled 'Perspectives and Advanced Techniques in Nuclear Spectroscopy' was organised by the Department of Physics on 14 and 15

February 2020. Participants were exposed to the recent theoretical studies and about the latest techniques in nuclear spectroscopy with live demonstrations and also through videos. A total of 176 participants from various educational institutes registered themselves in this workshop. Prof. P.M. Udani, President, Vivekananda Global University, Jaipur inaugurated the workshop as the chief guest. Prof. Udani felicitated the participants with his energetic words. Prof. Y.K. Vijay, Former President, VGU, Retd. Prof., Department of Physics, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur graced the inaugural programme as the guest of honour.

The first technical session of the workshop was chaired by Prof. B.K. Sharma, Prof. (Retd.) & Former Dean, Faculty of Science, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur. There were two invited talks in this technical session. The first speaker of this technical session, Prof. Y.K. Vijay, spoke on 'Alpha ray Spectrometry: Procedure and Applications' with live demonstration of the experiment.

Second speaker of the session, Shri Rakesh Kumar Fogat, Scientific Officer-F, Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research (AMD). Jaipur delivered his talk on 'Gamma Ray spectrometry of Naturally Occurring Radioactive Materials'. He explored the applications of gamma ray spectroscopy in uranium exploration, as the detection of nuclear and radiological materials is one facet of a multilayered defence against nuclear security threats, which also requires robust prevention.

Second technical session of the workshop was chaired by Prof Y.K. Vijay. Dr. Narendra Jakhar, Assistant Professor, Department of Physics, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur, elaborated about the positron annihilation spectroscopy and characterization of AmBe based neutron time of fight system discussing the pulse shape discrimination (PSD) techniques as the speaker of the session.

An exhibition by Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research (AMD) was also held which displayed posters and geological samples like columbite, tantalite, davidite, secondary uranium material, fossil wood etc.

Second day of the workshop began with the third technical session which was chaired by Dr. Minal Bafna, Head, Department of Physics, Agarwal PG College, Jaipur. This session consisted of three talks. Dr. Dalpat Meena, Assistant Professor, Department of Physics, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur, the first speaker of the session talked about the nuclear radiation detector and gamma spectroscopy. He talked about the various types of detectors which are used to detect the gamma rays like scintillation counters, which could be further classified into organic and inorganic scintillation detectors and could be used as per the need of the detection of respective radiation. Next talk of this session was delivered by Prof. S.C. Tripathi, Ex. Scientist BARC, Associate Director Research, GLA University. He highlighted the principles of gamma spectroscopy and its importance in nuclear technology.

The last technical session of this two day workshop was headed by Prof. S.C. Tripathi and the invited speaker was Dr. Rajni Verma, Assistant Professor, Department of Radiological Physics, S.M.S. Medical College & Hospital, Jaipur. Dr. Rajni very well explained the applications of spectroscopy in the various fields of medical science like diagnostic radiology (X-Ray, MRI, PET etc.) and to test the composition and purity of drugs. She motivated the participants to make their career in this emerging field due to its wide range of application in multidisciplinary areas. The chief guest for the valedictory ceremony was Prof. A.K. Nagawat, Director, Skill Education, Rajasthan ILD Skills University & Former Professor of Physics, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur. Prof. Nagawat declared this workshop a grand success due to the seminal talks delivered by speakers.

The workshop highlighted the perception of nuclear spectroscopy from fundamental aspects to applications in wide ranging interdisciplinary areas, followed by imparting a rigorous insight on the proficient use of various spectroscopy techniques.

ONE WEEK FDP ON 'KNOW-HOW OF VIRTUAL LEARNING'

Online learning is an evolving paradigm with multimodal literacies for the classroom. In these tough situation it is a saviour. One such practice is enriching the faculty with technical skills for online teaching and learning. Owing to this, the college conducted

an online faculty development programme from 22 to 26 May 2020 on 'Know-How of Virtual Learning'. The six-day online programme was an introductory course on some of the pertinent online platforms and pedagogical related topics. This faculty development program was a combination of theoretical exercises and practical assignments via virtual instructions with flexibility to learn anytime. The programme was an attempt for fellow academicians to gather the requisite skills and to be able to plan, design and deliver their courses online. It included sessions on Google classroom, Google doc, Google form, Google slides, e-Draw, Live am chart, Renderforest, Google sites, Screen-castify, Open Shot, Licensing and Plagiarism. Each session included videos, quiz,



assignments and feedback. To testify the knowledge gained, the final test was conducted on 27 May 2020 in which the participants' scores were commendable. Certificate of participation was issued to all the participants on completion of the programme.

This programme helped educators to develop a working understanding of online teaching strategies to apply in their practice and also guided them through their journey of learning the online techniques that can enhance their teaching skills. The resource persons were Dr. Ranjana Agrawal, Dr. Mohita Chaturvedi Sharma, Dr. Preeti Sharma, Dr. Reema Srivastava, Dr. Anita Gajraj, Dr. Chetna Sharma and Dr. Richa Chaturvedi. FDP was technically assisted by Ms. Rekha Sharma and Mr. Dilip Karol. Further, hands-on session for virtual teaching was also conducted from 6 to 17 July 2020 for all the faculty members.

FDP ON 'KNOW-HOW OF VIRTUAL LEARNING PART 2.0'

One week Faculty Development Programme on 'Know-How of Virtual Learning Part 2.0' was organised from 10 to 17 August

2020. The FDP aimed to provide opportunities to members of faculty to enrich and expand their knowledge for online classes. In this FDP, primary focus was laid on pedagogies that would help faculty members in inculcating learning values in students and at the same time monitor their progress. FDP was attended by 82



faculty members (all streams) of Kanoria College wherein the resource persons were in-house faculty members from the disciplines of Arts, Commerce and Science.

These tools are quintessential to virtual teaching. Recorded video study material for various sessions were also made available each day so that the participants could refer them as per their convenience. All sessions were accompanied by a feedback form to evaluate the content, audit the work and delivery, in a systematic way.

In this series, with an aim to enrich the faculty members with the various subject specific tools to be used for learning of students at the virtual platform, a one day Faculty Development Program (FDP) on 'Softwares for Academic Endeavour' was organised on January 5, 2021 in the college campus. The FDP was conducted in IV groups comprising specific subject faculty members. The program consisted of live sessions through Google Meet. The resource persons for the FDP were in-house faculty from the college. Faculty members learnt to make use of various open source softwares and websites available for taking live classes for creating video lectures. This would help in keeping the students involved in the classrooms through a variety of ways and also assess them through interactive quizzes. The feedback link was sent to all the participants at the end of the program.

COLLEGE IQAC – CATALYST TO EXCELLENCE

The establishment of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) by accredited institutions is a major step in pushing long-term quality standards. IQAC in any institution is a significant administrative body that is responsible for all quality matters. It is the prime responsibility of IQAC to initiate, plan and supervise various activities that are necessary to increase the quality of the education imparted in an institution or college. Keeping this in view the college IQAC organised four activities in this session.

On 29 October 2020 a virtual talk on Ethics in Teaching Pedagogy was delivered by Dr. Tanjul Saxena, Consultant – META AIDE. Commenting on today's pedagogy, she said that teachers are encouraged to adopt new practices that acknowledge both the art and science of learning. They grasp that their most important role is to get to know each student as an individual in order to comprehend his or her unique needs, learning style, social and cultural background, interests, and abilities. Dr Saxena further observed that many teachers also spend time researching various questions of educational effectiveness that expand the understanding of the dynamics of learning. Dr. Saxena viewed that reinventing the role of teachers inside and outside the classroom can result in significantly better colleges and better-educated students. Though the roots of such improvement are taking hold in



today's educational institutions, they need continued nurturing to grow and truly transform India's learning landscape.

Sports helps your brain grow and makes it work better. From a social standpoint, sports are a powerful tool that brings people together and creates a sense of community. They develop connections that bond together people from all walks of life. Keeping this in mind one-week virtual workshop was conducted from 4 to 9 January 2021 on Fitness and Wellness: Emphasizing the Relevance of Sports for Youth. Both practical and interactive sessions were incorporated for effective understanding of participants. Important components related to sports – Yoga for Flexibility, Diet and Nutrition, Exercise: Strengthening and Toning, Sports Injury and Rehabilitation, Career in Sports, were made part of the activity. Dr. Gurneet Monga, Dr. Aparna, Ms. Abhilasha Sharma, Ms. Richa Gaur, Dr. Vishal Saxena and Sandeep Singh were the resource persons of the workshop.

NEP 2020, visualises that education is fundamental for achieving full human potential, developing an equitable and just society, and promoting national development. Providing universal access to quality education is the key to India's continued ascent, and leadership on the global stage in terms of economic growth, social justice and equality, scientific advancement, national integration, and cultural preservation. India will have the highest population of young people in the world over the next decade, and our ability to provide high-quality educational opportunities to them will determine the future of our country. Our aim to achieve SDGs will require the entire education system to be reconfigured to support and foster learning, so that all of the critical targets and goals (SDGs) of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development can be achieved. With various dramatic scientific and technological advances, such as the rise of big data, machine learning, and artificial intelligence, many unskilled jobs worldwide may be taken over by machines, while the need for a skilled workforce, particularly involving Mathematics, Computer Science, and Data Science, in conjunction with multidisciplinary abilities across the Sciences, Social Sciences, and Humanities, will be increasingly in greater demand.

To discuss the various dimensions of changing scenario of education world over and India's new education policy that is the first education policy of the 21st century, IQAC of the college organised a webinar with its own faculty members as resource persons—Dr. Ratna Saxena, Seema Agrawal, Dr. Sarla Sharma and Dr. Deeptima Shukla on 15 January 2021. The aim of the webinar—National Education Policy, 2020, was to enlighten the faculty members and to understand the gap between the current state of learning outcomes and what is required in NEP 2020 must be bridged through undertaking major reforms that can bring the highest quality, equity, and integrity into the system, from early childhood care and education through higher education. The webinar focused on how essential it is for India to have an education system by 2040 that is second to none, with equitable access to the highest-quality education for all learners regardless of social or economic background. Comparative study of the education system of developed countries and countries like India was made in the webinar to give insight into our lacunas and areas we need improvement as regards our education system. Webinar was attended by the faculty members of the college who also gave their views regarding the provisions made in NEP 2020.

In this series a National Level webinar was also organised by the IQAC of the college as a joint venture with Bhartiya Shikshan Mandal, Jaipur Prant under the aegis of Niti Aayog, Government of India on 11 February 2021. The Webinar discussed the Role of Teachers in National Education Policy, 2020: Awareness, Orientation, Challenges and Responses. Chief Guest and main speaker of the webinar Professor Girishwar Misra, Former Vice Chancellor, Mahatma Gandhi Antarrashtriya Hindi Vishwavidyalaya, Warda, Maharashtra in his deliberation pointed out the changing role of teachers as per NEP 2020 and how the teachers should get prepared for this transformation. He suggested that the role of teacher has now changed from educator to a change maker and now it is the duty of a teacher to make efforts to bring about relevant changes not only in students and make them competent enough to enter the functional landscape of life and careers but also in society as a whole. Prof. Misra highlighted that teaching will have to change dramatically to increase participation in the classroom and promote 'inquiry-based, discussion-based

methods' envisaged by NEP and teachers will have to prepare themselves for this change. Second resource person and speaker of the webinar, Dr. Sudhir Singh, Department of Political Science, Dayal Singh College, University of Delhi was of opinion that in new education policy pedagogy is expected to evolve to make education more experiential, holistic, integrated, inquiry-driven, discovery-oriented, learner-centred, discussion-based, flexible, and, of course, enjoyable. Dr. Singh opined that NEP aims to build character, enable learners to be ethical, rational, compassionate, and caring, while at the same time prepare them for gainful, fulfilling employment and thus teachers will have to put together their efforts in realization of this shift.

The programmes organised by IQAC of the college proved beneficial both for teachers as well as students.

They wrote about various subjects such as women's health, the pandemic and its after effects, social issues, philosophy, etc. Dr. Arora discussed these articles on Day 2. He evaluated the assignments critically and pointed out the errors which further helped the teachers understand their shortcomings. The interaction also allowed the faculty members to overcome their inhibitions and hesitations about expressing themselves. The two day online FDP concluded on a hopeful note of novel initiations in the world of technology.

WORKSHOP ON INTERVIEWING SKILLS

"ज़िन्दगी में कुछ बदलाव चाहते हो, तो बदलाव की शुरूआत पहले अपने से करो, अपने हौसलों को ये खबर करते रहो, ज़िन्दगी मंज़िल नहीं सफ़र है, चलते रहो! चलते रहो!"

A virtual workshop on 'Interviewing Skills' was organised by the department of History on 3 February 2021. This workshop aimed to polish interview skills of the students essential for applying and securing employment in their near future. The resource person, Ms. Shivani Jain- life coach, freelancer, soft skills trainer and facilitator gave demonstrations to students about how to gain confidence, how to answer the questions in an interview and how to prepare themselves professionally.

Prior to the workshop, a virtual survey was conducted amongst the students of the college on 1 February, 2021 to understand their aspirations from the session. Ms. Shivani Jain shared the analysis of a questionnaire where 72% of students were interested in working after graduation and 10% wanted to be self-employed. In recent times the Interview has become more of a 'rejection process', according to an OECD, more than 30% of India's youth is unemployed, which has increased competition for jobs. She simplified the process by dividing it in three phases: pre-interview preparations, during interview and post interview preparations.

She discussed the beforehand research about the position applied, firm profile, resume, grooming, personal hygiene and dressing sense, presentation, reaching the place of interview before time, greeting everyone, and body language. Recently due to the pandemic, new questions have come up like how to take care of your stress and mental health, where hobbies play an important role. She also shared that our body language forms 60% and communication forms 40% of our total evaluation in a span of 30 seconds and plays a significant role in judging if a person is suitable for the vacant position. 189 students participated in the workshop and learnt the best practices required for jobs.

WORKSHOP ON SETUP OF MUSEUMS IN HERITAGE BUILDINGS: A PRACTICAL STUDY OF AJMER MUSEUM

A one day workshop on 'Setup of Museums in Heritage Buildings: A Practical Study of Ajmer Museum' was organised by the Department of History, Kanoria P.G Mahila Mahavidyalaya in collaboration with the Department of Archaeology and Museums,

Government of Rajasthan at Ajmer on 13 February 2020. The workshop aimed to discuss contemporary re-use of historical buildings as museums for conservation of heritage and culture of the country.

Nineteen students of M.A. Semester II and IV of the department and two faculty members participated in this workshop.

Dr. Suman Dhanaka narrated a brief introduction of Ajmer city. The chief spokesperson of the workshop Mr. Neeraj Kumar Tripathi, Superintendent, Ajmer Circle, Department of Archaeology and Museums, explained to students how museums act as storage house of knowledge encompassing objects of artistic, cultural, historical, tradition and of scientific interests. He also threw light on categorisation of museums into archaeological and historical museums, science and technology museums, speciality museums, general museums, fine arts museums and so on.



Mr. Neeraj also discussed at length about problems and ethics involved in the enhancement of galleries, issues and planning implemented in Ajmer fort during restoration work under his supervision since 2017. Presently it has been restored to the Divisional Level Museum displaying an elegant collection of the most beautiful stone sculptures, pottery, ancient and medieval armoury, coins, decorative art objects, excavated remains, stone inscriptions, copper plate inscriptions, miniature paintings etc. Dr. Poonam Pandey, President of Prithviraj Foundation, an N.G.O of Ajmer also shared her knowledge. The students visited the fort museum and were amazed at seeing the historical events displayed through mannequins of Mansingh and Akbar, Prithviraj Chauhan and Chandra Bardai, Thomas Roe and Jahangir.

Mr Deepak Sharma, senior photographer, Hindustan Times showcased the beautiful pictures clicked by him of Ajmer city and its monuments. The workshop successfully evaluated the concept of setting up museums in heritage buildings which is the need of the present time to preserve and conserve the rich heritage and culture of India.

WEBINAR ON EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION




This one hour Webinar was attended by 168 participants. Dr. Godhwani talked about the 6 C's i.e confidence, communication,

The session 2020-21 was welcomed by the Life Science Association with its first online activity 'Know Your Surroundings' on 6 October 2020. It was held during Wildlife Week (2-8 October) for B.Sc. and M.Sc. students of Botany, Zoology and Chemistry, in which 18 students participated. The students prepared and presented factsheets on various plants and animals like squirrel, Kingfisher, Javan Myna, rockdove, Terminalia tomentosa, Acacia nilotica, Oriental white eye, spider, frog, lion and peacock. The first prize was awarded to Manisha; second prize to Poornima and third prize to Pooja Singh.

On 5 December 2020, an online training on 'Art of Bonsai' was conducted by Shaili Choudhary, Bonsai Practitioner of Avadh Bonsai Association, Lucknow. 98 students from B.Sc. and M.Sc. participated in the lecture. Initially the online bonsai



gallery visit was made by expert, in which she exhibited various Bonsai plants of Zade, Bargad, Pipal, Bougainvillea, Duranta etc. with various styles of bonsai like umbrella, slanting, wind-swift etc. made by her. She also gave some valuable inputs at the end of the session. All the students enthusiastically participated and took advantage of such a practical method of bonsai making.

A virtual guest lecture on 'Information Literacy and Critical Thinking' was delivered by Ms. Garima Shree Kapoor, FactShala Trainer in collaboration with Data leads, google.org and Google News Initiative on 18 December 2020. Her lecture focussed on the information overload on the internet, sharing and utilization of the correct information. She interacted with 98 students regarding sources of news and information. She also described various types of false information and gave the students a practical demonstration of the Google tools. Her lecture was very informative and very relevant in today's scenario where we are using the information from the internet without verifying whether it is true or not and forwarding to others which may lead to some social misconduct.

In spite of online mode, all the activities witnessed active and overwhelming participation of the students. The aim of inculcating scientific temper and knowledge beyond classroom was met with great success and zest.

MATERIAL SCIENCE ASSOCIATION

The Material Science Association of the college conducted various competitions to explore the creativity of the students. In this series, a Poster Making Competition was organised virtually in which students covered various topics like Wave Nature, Newton's Law, Wind and Solar Energy etc. and prepared beautiful posters. 10 students participated in this activity. 'Inventions by Indian Mathematics' by Soumya Maheshwari of B.Sc. Part-I bagged the First Prize, Second Prize was bagged by Kritika Sharma of B.Sc.

Part-I for 'Coulomb's Law' and Divyanshi Daslaniya of B.Sc. Part-I stood third for 'Newton's Law of Motion'.

Association also organised an online quiz competition on 24 December 2020 for the students. Ms. Shruti Tyagi, Ms. Anshika Sapra and Ms. Shreya Agarwal grabbed I,



II & III positions respectively. Certificates were awarded to the winners. 115 students participated in this activity with full enthusiasm.

On 4 February 2021, an online lecture was delivered on 'Degradation of Dyes by Using Innovative Photo Catalytic Reactor' by Dr. Kalawati Saini, Miranda House, University of Delhi. They gained knowledge on the upcoming prospects of current research. 82 students of science stream participated in this informative session with great zeal.

MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION

Market Challenges and its Impact on Business' on 22 October 2020 which let students brainstorm the current market challenges affecting the business environment and how they are going to impact the scenario. A total of 44 students participated actively in the discussion.

The long-awaited fest of the Students i.e. Management Fest was also organised virtually for three days from 25 to 27 November 2020 that included various activities like Quiz, PPT competition and Debate. Around 100 students participated very enthusiastically in all the activities. On the last day of the fest, a webinar on 'Learning Online: Strategies for overcoming challenges and Improving Outcomes' was organised. The resource person for the webinar, Dr. Prabhat Pankaj threw light on the new normal and the online platform of learning and teaching and how it is creating stress in the students. He also explained in detail the various ways to overcome the challenges posed by the new normal. The last day of the fest saw a virtual PTM held for the students of BBA where many parents enthusiastically gave feedback about online teaching.

The session ended with virtual edition of 'CAMFEST – Fest for the Best' organised in collaboration with the Commerce Association and Management Association on 29 and 30 January 2021. It witnessed a variety of inter and intra college activities like Slogan and Poster Making, Extempore, Debate, Quiz Competition organised for the students virtually. Many colleges from the city took part in the inter college activities like Quiz and Extempore and around 100 students took part in various activities. The Management Association worked to enhance value based practical as well as theoretical knowledge in students and boost their confidence.

CENTRE FOR CAREER GUIDANCE, TRAINING AND PLACEMENT

The Centre for Career Guidance, Training and Placement is an integral part of college. It is exclusively designed for providing multifarious career and placement guidance services for students at all levels. The centre organised various activities round the year to enhance the career skills of the students. The centre started off the session 2020 - 21 with an online training session on 'Resume Making' on 7 November 2020 in which 90 students participated. The resource person was Dr. Swati S. Sultania.

On 9 November 2020 an online interactive session was organised on 'Making a Career Choice in New Age Environment: Challenges & Opportunities' by Mr. Vinay Modi, expert in Career Guidance. He guided all the students towards a stable and right career choice and also discussed how to crack different competitive exams like IAS, RAS, SSC, and banking. 94 students attended the interactive session.

On 12 December 2020, an online interactive session was organised on 'Study in Abroad' by Mr. Pramod Jangir, Research Scholar at University of Melbourne, Australia. He talked about

different study programs in foreign universities. Around 85 students participated in this interactive session.



A five day virtual workshop on 'Career Development Skills and Future Opportunities' was organised from 19 to 24 December 2020. A total of 100 students from different streams participated in each session. In this workshop various aspects related to career development skills like Non-verbal communication, Interview skills & Group discussion were discussed. Mrs. Shikha Nag, founder and Director of the Indian Academy of Public Speaking addressed the students on the topic 'Image Development'. Mr.

Vaibahav Mediratta, Management Consultant & Corporate Trainer at Impact Training & Consulting talked about the 'Post Covid Job Opportunities' and also explained the role of various job profiles in career development.

Internshala (a Collaborative Partner of AICTE) a technology company which provides internships,



online training and various other opportunities to students, is registered with the college to improve skills and employability of students. TEACHING-LEARNING CENTRE

Henry Hartman says "Success always comes when preparation meets opportunity."

Kanoria Teaching Learning Centre was founded in May 2020 with a vision to enable the teachers to enhance, generate, exchange and disseminate the education through technology in the unexpected challenging circumstances of Pandemic Covid-19 and empower the students to cope up with this new teaching methodology.

With this inventiveness Kanoria Teaching Learning Centre witnessed various activities throughout the year. The first activity was marked with a week long Faculty Development Program from 22 to 26 May 2020 on 'Know-how of Virtual Learning' for inhouse faculties. This faculty development program was a combination of theoretical exercises and practical assignments via virtual instructions with flexibility to learn anytime. FDP included sessions on Google classroom, Google doc, Google form, Google slides, eDraw, Live am chart, Renderforest, Google sites, Screen-castify, Open shot, Licensing and Plagiarism. Each session consisted of videos, quiz, assignments and feedback. The whole FDP was focussed on virtual ICT based teaching and learning. On the last day of the FDP, a final test was conducted to testify the knowledge gained of the participants. The scores of



From 6 to 11 July 2020 a hands-on workshop was conducted for college faculty to give them practical knowledge about various software used for online teaching learning. The aim was to help them reach their full potential and attain the proficiency to conduct virtual classes during pandemic.

After the successful completion of the FDP, a virtual orientation program was conducted in the month of July, 2020 wherein two videos were posted on the college website that became a key for students to reach their virtual classrooms for regular conduction of the classes.



Further to provide opportunities to learned faculty members and to enrich and expand their knowledge for online/virtual classes, the second part of the Faculty Development Program on 'Know-How of Virtual Learning Part 2.0' was organised from 10 to 17 August 2020. FDP was attended by 82 faculty members (all streams) of Kanoria College. This helped in developing insights into the learning curve.

Centre not only worked for the advancement of faculties of the college but with the broad vision to cater the knowledge to other faculties

of the state, three-day State level Faculty Development Program (FDP) on 'Know-How of Virtual Learning' was organised from 2 to 4 September, 2020 in collaboration with Commissionerate of College Education, Rajasthan, Jaipur. 100 faculty members of different state government colleges were benefited with this program.

Teaching Learning Centre of Kanoria PG Mahila Mahavidyalaya organised a two-day online workshop on blogging under the Faculty Development Program, 2020. The workshop was conducted on 17 and 24 December 2020 by Dr. Sanjay Arora, Head, Department of English, Central University of Rajasthan. Dr. Arora is an experienced blog writer who has been managing a blog for over ten years. Faculty members of all the departments participated. The program proved to be a great opportunity for the faculty members, many of whom were trying to learn the technicalities behind blogging.

In the same series, under the aegis of Teaching Learning Centre, a one-day Faculty Development Program (FDP) on 'Softwares for Academic Endeavour' was organised on 5 January, 2021 with an aim to enrich the Faculty Members with the various subject specific tools to be used for teaching students at the virtual platform.

Conclusively, the primary focus of these faculty development programs was to acquaint faculty members with technological pedagogies and tools that would help them face the challenging times by evolving these techniques and keeping the process of learning in action.




Expanding Horizons


अभिव्यक्ति क्लब (हिन्दी)


ENTREPRENEURSHIP CLUB










NATURE CLUB


रचनात्मक लेखन क्लब

राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना





SAGA'20 received an overwhelming response. This second chapter established SAGA as a literary tradition which the department hopes to continue with equal zeal in the future years.


Kasturi 2021
