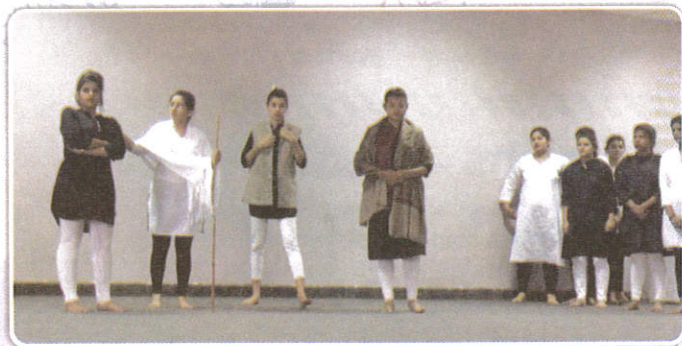
गाँधी-शास्त्री जयन्ती

Educating for Enlightenment

DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTANCY & BUSINESS STATISTICS

The session began with a special lecture on 'How to Crack NET Exam' for the M. Com students on 8th September, 2018. The main focus of this lecture was to familiarize students about the tactics to crack the new online pattern of UGC NET Exam and to know about the core areas of the curriculum which should be focused. On 12th September, an interactive session on 'How to Use Technology in Business' was organized for UG and PG students by Mr. Suraj Vyas, Faculty, Institute of Financial Studies, Jaipur. He discussed the digitalization mode of doing business these days. On 15th September, an interactive session on 'Women Advantage Savings Account' was conducted by HDFC Bank, which highlighted the benefits of the same as compared to other banks' savings accounts. The session enhanced banking knowledge and focused on the extraordinary benefits provided to the women account holders.



The department organized an Oral Paper Presentation session on 'Purview of GST' for PG students on 20th September and Group Discussion on 6th October on the topic 'Increasing NPA in Banks'. Ritika Agarwal, Urvasi Kanstiya and Saloni Gupta presented papers on problems and issues associated with the topic. To enhance financial literacy among students, a session on 'Investor Awareness and Financial Literacy' was organized for B.Com and M.Com students by SEBI. The session enhanced the importance of Investments in today's world. The students learnt how the investor should be aware of various investment avenues available in the market and the risks & returns associated with them. A lecture on 'Accounting Re-search' was organized on 8th October, 2018. The lecture was given by Dr. Mohar Singh, Professor, Department of ABST, University of Rajasthan, he discussed the relevance of research in today's scenario. On 24th October, a lecture on Time Management was organized for the students to learn about the most important aspect of life i.e. Time.

To enrich the practical knowledge of M. Com students, they were taken for an Industrial visit to 'Triveni Pump Cast', Kaladera. The visit helped them learn the process of manufacturing spare parts for pumps and the functioning of the industry as a whole. Besides this, from time to time various sessions are conducted by in-house faculty on Recent Trends in Commerce. On 20th December, a guest lecture on Tax Planning was conducted by Retd. Prof. C. K. Shah, University of Rajasthan, for both UG and PG students. Prof. Shah discussed various Tax Planning issues and also, how the assessee can save tax by planning his investments well in advance.

The programs organized in the department all the year round were quite interesting and fruitful for the students. Students appreciated the lectures, which helped them to enhance their perspectives towards core aspects of ABST.

DEPARTMENT OF BIOTECHNOLOGY

Biotechnology uses biological systems for unprecedented advances in human and animal health, agriculture and food production. With this in mind, the department organized various activities for students to provide a practical perspective to the theoretical subjects.

On 23rd September 2018, the department organized a one-day industrial visit to Jaipur Dairy. The prime objective of the visit was to acquaint the students about the processing and manufacturing of milk and milk products in the plant. The students learnt about various key techniques like different fermenter types, SNF content checking, milk grades and quality control.

On 29th October 2018, students of the department attended the National Workshop on 'Spirulina- The Edible Algae: Nutritive and Therapeutic Approach towards Entrepreneurship', organized by the college. Prof. Kailash Agrawal was the keynote speaker who enlightened the students about the various aspects of algal biotechnology. Dr. Parul Gupta Coordinator, DST updated the students with various financial support schemes for student projects by DST. A talk on 'Spirulina- Biological Entity with Enormous Potentials' was delivered by Dr. Randhir S Gajraj highlighting the hidden abilities of protein production by the algae and its use as food supplement. Later Ms. Preeti Neema demonstrated the use of spirulina as a facial mask. Prof. Rashmi Sisodia was the chief guest of the valedictory session.

On 15th November, an interactive session on 'Career Prospects in Biotechnology' was organized. The invited speaker was Prof. Brij Verma, University of Saskatchewan, Saskatoon, Canada.

On 30th November, the department visited Forestry Training Institute (FTI) Jaipur for a Workshop on 'Biodiversity Awareness'. A lecture by Mr. Rohit Gangwal, the president of NGO Raksha covered the theme by explaining bird and snake rescue techniques. A film on global warming opened the eyes by presenting the horrifying current scenario of world climate change. The day was concluded by a visit to the Institute's nursery where students saw many annual and seasonal plants and got motivated for active participation in afforestation.

A Science poster / model exhibition was organized on 5th December in which students of B.Sc Biotechnology part I participated actively. The students made posters and working models on various topics related to their subjects. Posters on Biogas plant, HIV virus, Cell membrane, Organogenesis of kidney and models on Sewage treatment plant, Circulatory system got the I and II prize respectively in their categories.

A lecture on Forensic sciences was delivered by Dr. V. Venkatesh, Additional Director of Forensic Science Laboratory, Govt. of Rajasthan on 15th December. He explained about various techniques to extract the forensic knowledge from evidences like body fluids, bones, hairs found at different crime scenes. He also spoke about different types of cases witnessed by the forensic experts and actions taken in them like drug trafficking, forestry act cases etc. techniques like superimposition, DNA fingerprinting were a major part of his talk.

From 17th to 21st December, B.Sc. Biotechnology Part II and Part III students presented seminars on their summer training and dissertations, respectively. This activity motivated the students to enhance their research aptitude and develop their interactive skills. These presentations were judged by the faculty and feedback was given to students for their improvement.

On 22nd December, an industrial visit to Sun Pesticides Pvt. Ltd was organized. Senior scientists at the plant explained about the production of various insecticides like contact, systemic etc., being produced by the factory and their potential applications on plants. The students were also made aware of the working principles of Phorat machine used for insecticide packaging. A live Biogas plant was the key feature of the trip, its complete functioning was explained to the students right from rearing farm animals, dung collection and final biogas collection. Later, the department visited Brother's Laboratory (NABL accredited) where the students saw Microbiology and Biochemistry labs and instruments like HPLC, Biosafety cabinet etc. which are used for drug and other food product testing.

On 12th January 2019, the Department attended Prof. L.S. Ramaswami Memorial Oration cum Public lecture by Padma Bhushan Dr. Manju Sharma at University of Rajasthan. She highlighted the key subjects of biotechnology and familiarized the students about various scholarship schemes at NASI. The lecture covered the subject in a constructive manner and guided the students to ponder on the possibilities which the subject has to offer for building their future careers.

On 21st January, a guest lecture by Ms. Ankit Goyal on the topic 'Nanotechnology- A Promising Revolution' was conducted by the department. He gave an insight to the developing field and discussed key techniques covering the subject.

Overall the departmental activities enhanced the vision of the students towards the subject and helped them to perceive Biotechnology beyond the routine syllabus.

DEPARTMENT OF BOTANY

The department of Botany organized a Power point presentation for the students of B.Sc. Part-II on 3rd October. Several students prepared PPTs on various topics of syllabus like Pinus, Nucleosome model, Enzymes, Carbohydrates, Stellar system, Paleobotany etc. A guest lecture was organized on the topic "P.C.R and Reverse Transcription P.C.R." which was delivered by Dr. C. P. Singh, Assistant Professor, Department of Botany, UOR, Jaipur on 5th October for M.Sc. students. Dr. C. P. Singh discussed various types of RNA (Mi RNA, Si RNA, Pi RNA), process and application of P.C.R. and RT P.C.R.



A one day botanical excursion to Keoladev Ghana Bird Sanctuary and Fatehpur Sikri was organized for M.Sc and B.Sc. Part III students on 22nd November. A group of 44 students were accompanied by 4 faculty members and 3 lab staff. The flora of Keoladev Ghana Bird Sanctuary basically comprises of dry thorny shrubs like Acacia sp., Prosopis sps., Salvadora, Zizyphus, Clerodendron, Savannah grass etc. and the flora of Fatehpur Sikri was rich in plants like Sida, Vernonia, Capparis, Abutilon, Indigofera, Parthenium, Ipomea etc. The excursion was a good experience for the students with respect to the flora of Keoladev Ghana Bird Sanctuary and historic knowledge of Fatehpur Sikri.

Science Chart and Model Exhibition was organized on 5th December in which B.Sc. students prepared various charts and models covering various topics of their syllabus like life cycle of various algae, fungi and bryophytes, mitosis, bacteriophage, water cycle, DNA, floral diagrams etc. The students were awarded prizes. I prize went to Shannon Theodore, Sarika Sharma, Saroj Choudhary for Floral diagram of Plant Families and Pooja Singh for Life cycle of Polysiphonia; II prize was awarded to Pooja Sharma (S.D.) for Water cycle and Tanu Gupta, Sakshi Sharma and Shivani Tyagi for Incomplete and Co-dominance; and III prize was awarded to Nisha Yadav, Nidhi Dwara and Nikita Sharma for Life cycle of Puccinia and Nikita Yadav for Life cycle of Volvox.

Department organized two day workshop on Genetic modification of desired genes using CRISPR technology (Gene

editing tools and salient features) in association with E- cell fest, IIT Karagpur. The main emphasis was given on the use of cas-9 by CRISPR technology. The workshop also included the use of Aptamer technology specially in the field of gene editing. Hands on sessions were conducted on bioinformatics tools and gene transformation. The students also participated in national level competition in which 5 students were selected for the finale round at IIT Kharagpur.

DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

Students of M.Sc. attended a two-day workshop on 'NMR Spectroscopy - Concepts and Applications' at University of Rajasthan on 26th and 27th October 2018. Prof. D. I. Brahmabhatt was invited as the notable speaker who explained the technique and its applications to the students effortlessly and cleared their queries regarding the subject.

The department organized a seminar via PowerPoint presentation on 28th November 2018 on the topic 'Green Chemistry and Medicinal Chemistry'. The students of B.Sc. presented their views and opinions on the upcoming fields of chemistry through PowerPoint presentation.

A movie screening was organized in the department on 15th December 2018. The title of the movie was - 'Unlocking Power: Tarapur Nuclear Power Plant'. It is a motivational movie shot by National Geographic on the journey of the nuclear fuel from a reactor to electricity in our homes.

On 19th December 2018, around 40 students of B.Sc. went for a field visit to 'Bhamashah Techno Hub', which is claimed to be India's biggest incubation and acceleration centre.

The best 10 presentations were awarded with certificates.

Meritorious students of B.Sc. and M.Sc. submitted project under DSTm Inspire Scholarship and were awarded with Rs. 20,000/- scholarship under the supervisor Dr. Kumud Tanwar.

The first in the series of extension lectures organized by the department was on 'Metal Nitrosyls and their Applications' on 24th September 2018. This lecture was delivered by Prof. Meena Nagar of University of Rajasthan.

The second extension lecture was organized on the topic of

'Proton NMR Spectroscopy' on 17th November 2018 delivered by Prof. Pahup Singh, (Retd.) Professor, University of Rajasthan. The third extension lecture was organized on the topic 'Molecular Spectroscopy' on 22nd November 2018 by Dr. Jitendra Kumar Sharma. DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS

In the series to provide practical knowledge to the students, a field visit to 'Bhamashah Data Centre' near Jhalana Doongri, Jaipur was organized for B.A. (Hons.) students on November 26th 2018. Data Centre has two buildings, one is Techno-hub and another is Techno-



park. Techno-hub provides storage of data while Techno-park is a centre to understand latest technology and their practical exposure. This place also provides world class facilities to start-ups entrepreneurs.

An extension lecture was organized on 20th December 2018 on the topic "Public Finance and Fiscal Policy". The Speaker Dr. Anshu Bhardwaj explained the basic instruments of public finance and fiscal policy. Apart from all these activities, students also participated in different competitions throughout the year. DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH

The department has always been a front-runner in organizing enriching educational activities for students. The first activity of academic session 2018-19 was a visit to Jawahar Kala Kendra (JKK) on 30th July to attend the exhibition that traced the evolution of aesthetics in Indian textiles through the years. Curated by Mayank Mansingh Kaul and designed by Reha Sodhi, this exhibition presented textiles under broader themes of The National Movement, Khadi, the Impact of European-Colonial Encounter in the early to mid 20th century; the engagement with International Modernism from the 1950s till today; an intense revival period in village-based crafts and textiles beginning with the 1970s which has informed the present ecology of urban design; the negotiation of roles between artisans- craftspeople, designers and artists; a return to historical vocabularies from the 1980s onwards which moulds contemporary fashion and mass consumerism; textiles as a means and metaphor for sculpture; as well as Indian minimalism.



In the month of September, the students and teachers went to watch the film 'Manto' directed by Nandita Das and starring Nawazuddin Sidique. The film is a poignant portrayal of the illustrious writer Sadat Hasan Manto and the impact of the 1947 Partition on his life. The film gave the students an insight into one of the most traumatic periods of Indian history: The Partition.

In October, two Extension Lectures were organized by the department. The first lecture was on 'Indian Women's Writing'. The resource person for the lecture was Dr. Mini Nanda, Former Head and Associate Professor, Department of English, UOR. The lecture illuminated various concerns of Indian Women Writers with special focus on Amar Jiban by Rassundari Devi. Prof. Basant Jaitley delivered the second lecture on 'Natyashastra and Theory of Rasa.' It was a two lecture series aimed at familiarizing the students with aesthetics of Indian Drama.

The department added another feather in its cap by inaugurating the Language Lab on 16th October to promote the learning of languages. Dr. Rajul Bhargava, Former Head, Department of English, UOR and a linguist of repute was the chief guest for the occasion.

The students were taken to another educational visit to the JKK in November 2018. They visited the first edition of the India Ceramics Triennale which celebrated the variety and possibilities of ceramics. Students became acquainted with the manner in which contemporary social reality was depicted using ceramic art. The department also conducted a PTM for PG students which offered a platform for healthy interaction between teachers and faculty.

In the month of December, the film 'Animal Farm' based on George Orwell's allegorical novel of the same was screened for the students in the college auditorium. The objective of the film was to enhance the comprehension of the novel and to show how a text translates from script to screen.

Sankhya Darshan is theoretical part and Yoga Darshan is practical part. In Vedant Darshan according to Sankaracharya only one Reality called Brahman exists. He explained the Mimamsa Philosophy as the ritualistic aspect of Indian thought. He also explained ideas of Modern Indian thinkers.

Dr. Rajkumar inspired the students to understand philosophy in a practical manner rather than learning it just as a subject or part of curriculum. Students of Sanskrit and History department also participated. The students asked significant questions in the end. All their queries were duly answered.

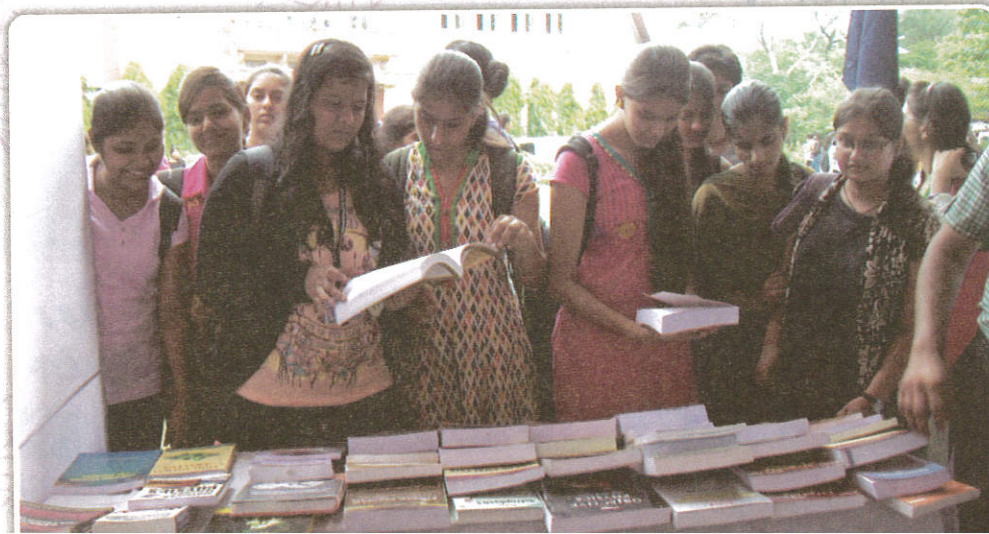

FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME



A year long series of Faculty Development Programme was organized in the current academic session 2018-19. It included six sessions conducted on various days throughout the academic calendar.

The first session of the FDP was organized on 18 August 2018, Saturday on the topic: 'Teaching and Research: Exploring Undiscussed Parameters'. The keynote speaker was Prof. Amita Singh, Head, Centre for Law and Governance, JNU, Delhi, while the other resource person was Dr. Om Mahla from the Department of Public Administration, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur. The session was chaired by Prof. Amita Sharma, Principal, University Rajasthan College, Jaipur. Prof. Amita Singh underlined the inseparable connection between teaching and research, and elaborated on the various stages of a good research with the help of suitable examples. Similarly, Dr. Om Mahla established a close link between education, teaching and research and their roles in higher education. In her concluding remarks, Prof. Amita Sharma second the thoughts expressed by both the speakers.

The second FDP in the annual series was held on 22nd September 2018 on the topic 'State, Sovereignty and Globalization'. This interactive session was conducted by Dr. Sudhir Singh from Department of Political Science, University of Delhi. Dr. Sudhir Singh delivered an extensive discourse on Globalization, covering all its aspects like its historical evolution, its present form and its effect on the world as well as on India. Dr. Singh opined that it is not only the ultimate aim but also a great challenge for the modern States to protect their sovereignty from the onslaughts of globalization. However, there is no uniform strategy for it, and every State formulates its own strategy for this purpose. The programme concluded with a brief Q & A session between the faculty members and the expert.

The third and fourth instalments of FDPs were conducted consecutively on two days, 15th and 16th October 2018. On 15th of October, a Peer Learning Session was conducted wherein the following faculty members shared their expert knowledge with their colleagues: Ms. Himanshi Rastogi, Department of Psychology (her participation and learning experience as an ECE expert on a Government of Rajasthan Project with Anganwadis); Dr. Reema Srivastava, Botany (Medicinal Plants from Kanoria College); Dr. Ritu Jain, Botany (Soil Health Card Project); Dr. Sheetabh Sharma, Hindi (How to write Research Paper); Ms. Vijaylaxmi Gupta, Economics (Role of Tourism in Economic Development of Rajasthan); Ms. Swati Sharma, Computer Science (Uses of 'Module') and Dr. Kshipra Goyal, Zoology (My Peer Learning Experience as a Member of ISSFR).

On 16th October, Prof. Anil Mehta conducted an interactive session on 'Simple Ways to Reduce Your Stress'. Prof. Mehta dealt with the topic in detail by enumerating the meaning, causes, types and consequences of stress. He came up with easy and effective methods for stress reduction. At the end of the session, Prof. Mehta and Dr. Sheetabh Sharma demonstrated few simple exercises and Pranayam which are extremely helpful in the current reference.

On 24th November 2018, the FDP was organized on the topic, 'Convergence of Social Structures into Electoral Politics'. The expert speaker was Prof. J.C. Johri, an eminent scholar of Political Science. Prof. Johri delved deep in the topic and explained various aspects of the electoral politics like electoral behaviour, office of profit and the role of seven important variables in Indian Elections: Money Power, Man Power, Religion, Caste, Region, Personality and Wave. Prof. Johri opined that while money and man powers are universal factors, but it was only the last two, i.e., personality and wave which are the decisive ones, in any election in India. He also urged the teaching faculty members to be aware and receptive to various sources of knowledge like seminars and conferences.



Finally, Prof. A. D. Sawant conducted an informative session on 'Solid Waste Management in India' on 22nd December 2018. Prof. Sawant who is a renowned scholar in Chemistry from the University of Mumbai, highlighted the problem of solid waste management in cities and the resultant environmental hazards. With the help of a power point presentation Prof. Sawant also suggested various measures that can be adopted at the individual, community and governmental level for waste management. At the end of an elaborate scholarly presentation, Prof. Sawant also satisfied the various queries of the staff members.

International Conference on Frontiers at the Chemistry- Allied Sciences Interface (FCASI- 2018)

A two-day International Conference on Frontiers at the Chemistry- Allied Sciences Interface (FCASI- 2018) was jointly organized by the college and Department of Chemistry, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur, Rajasthan Chapter- ISCB and CRSI. Technical Session VI for day-1 was organized in the college. The session was graced by presence of dignitaries, distinguished guests and delegates across the country and abroad, honourable Director, Principal, revered teachers and the students of the college.

Dr. Deeptima Shukla, Dean Academics welcomed the guests and delegates through her welcome speech. Chairperson of the session Emeritus Prof. Lallan Mishra from BHU, Varanasi graced the dias and invited the first honored speaker Prof. Jacques Jupille from Pierre and Marie Curie University Paris, France.

Prof. Jupille showered light on 'Material Surfaces' and explained that surface study deals with single crystal, films and powder. The talk was based on three examples.

1. Deals with point defects that are populated Titanium surfaces.
2. Magnesium oxide is a model catalyst for oxidative coupling of methane.
3. He discussed about high resolution electron energy loss spectroscopy.

The next dignitary speaker was Prof. A. K. Srivastava from University of Mumbai. He addressed the gathering on the topic 'Metal Organic Framework Based Composite Materials'. 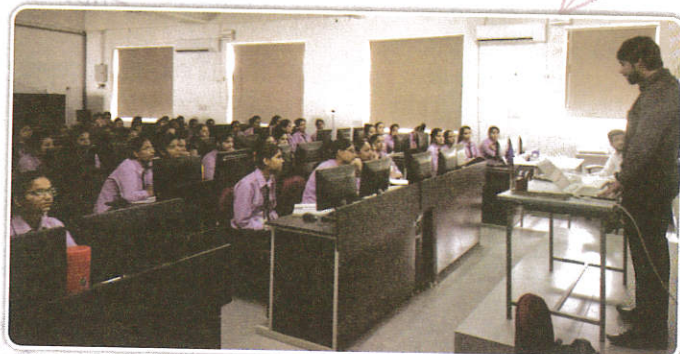

A seminar on 'Full-Stack Developers' was organized on 26th September. A Full Stack Developer is an engineer who can handle all the work of database servers, system engineering and

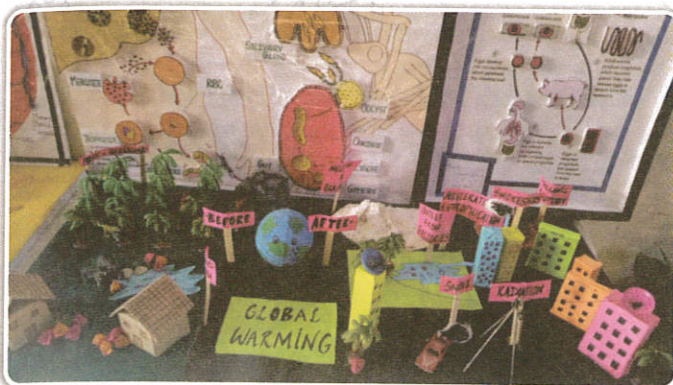
LIFE SCIENCES ASSOCIATION

इसके अन्तर्गत 24 अक्टूबर को मानविकी समिति के सहयोग से महाविद्यालय में गाँधीजी की 150वीं जयन्ती के उपलक्ष्य में संवाद-यात्रा : साबरमती से कश्मीर (21 से 31 अक्टूबर 2018) के अन्तर्गत दिल्ली, उड़ीसा, महाराष्ट्र, गुजरात, उत्तर-प्रदेश आदि विभिन्न राज्यों से 17 महिलाओं के समूह ने छात्राओं से संवाद किया। कार्यक्रम में सरस्वती कउला ने समाज की रूढ़िवादी सोच को बदलना आवश्यक बताया और छात्राओं से ऑनर-किलिंग, बाल-अधिकार आदि विषयों पर विचार-विमर्श किया। प्रेरणा देसाई ने छात्राओं को स्वहित व स्वाभिमान के लिए प्रेरित किया और गाँधी जी के कथन "तुम्हारी हिम्मत ही तुम्हारा हथियार है" जैसे विचारों से प्रेरणा प्रदान की। कार्यक्रम में "सोच की आज़ादी" एक लघु फिल्म भी दिखाई गई। छात्राओं ने अपने अधिकार, माता-पिता की सोच और समझ के साथ तालमेल बिठाने, प्रेम-विवाह इत्यादि विषयों पर 'संवाद यात्रा' के सदस्यों के साथ विचार-विमर्श किया। समिति संयोजक डॉ. रेखा गुप्ता ने इसे सार्थक एवं सशक्त संवाद बताया।

A group of 30 students under the charge of Dr. Neelam Bageshwari HOD Geography set out foot to explore the terrains of Garhwal Himalayas. The trip was planned to Joshimath-Auli-Rishikesh from 15-20 Oct, 2018.

Our first destination was Haridwar junction where we deborbed the train to hit the road by bus. The scenic beauty, sharp turns, greenery all around and flowing streams greeted us on the way.

Joshimath is a city in Chamoli District of Uttarakhand located at the height of 6150 ft. Our visit to Rajaji National Park - Tiger Reserve that encompasses the Shivaliks was another thrilling experience. CERTIFICATE COURSE IN FOREIGN LANGUAGES

As quoted by Flora Lewis, "Learning another language is not only learning different words for the same things, but learning another way to think about things."

The college began certificate courses in French and German languages from the session 2017-18. These courses provide students with an opportunity to learn a global language and become a multilingual speaker. The courses are designed to offer skills of reading, writing, listening and speaking as well as learning grammar and building vocabulary.

This year the course started in August 2018. In the initial months, students were taught about the greetings, alphabets, numbers, sentence formation, sounds, adjectives and articles followed by verbs, conjugations and tenses. The students were taught more practical usage of the languages as making purchases, describing a place, filling forms, giving directions, etc. The courses also comprised of various activities like listening and singing French or German music, celebrating their respective cultural festivals like 'Joyeux Noel', and watching live clips and videos of France and Germany. The teachers also took students for interactive and learning sessions of language like 'German Days' (A national seminar for German teachers and learners) and a seminar for 'Opportunities in French Language'. A musical fest in which 'RAGGABUND' a German music performed was also attended by the students.

In due course of the session, faculties kept updating the students about the career opportunities with foreign languages as a language trainer, tour guide, translator for Government Organizations and MNCs, as well as a interpreter for corporate

and Government Organizations. Dr. Preeti Sharma and Ms. Hina Nahta with this perspective organized a visit of two French Universities 'Rennes Business School' and 'IESEG, Paris' on 15th January 2019. The representatives from both the Universities Ms. Maud Le Bars and Mr. Nithin Joseph accompanied by Mr. Romain Camus, French Institute Representative in India and Ms. Sanjana Sarkar, Manager, Campus France interacted with the students and guided them with academic prospects available in France. 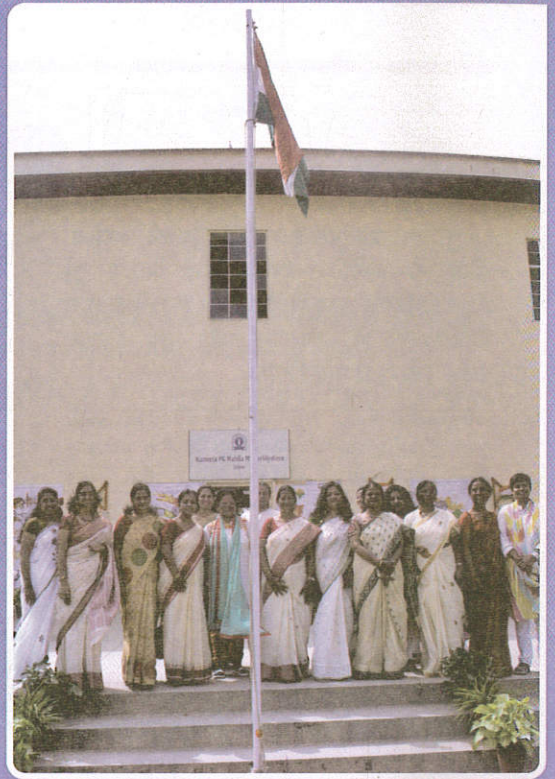


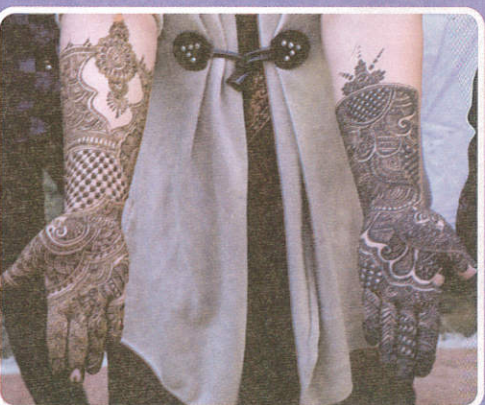
सात दिवसीय शिविर
