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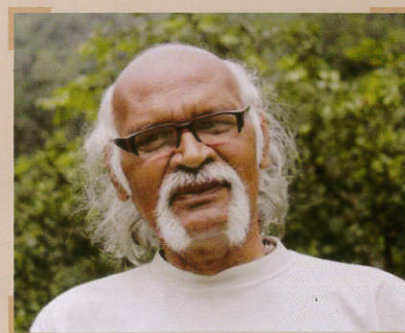
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## From the Editor's Desk....

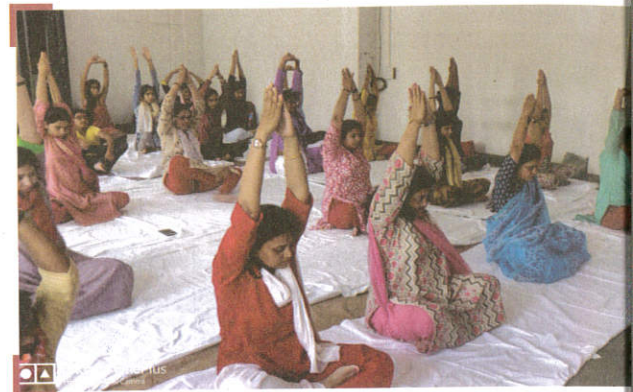

# Advancing Knowledge, Transforming Lives

## DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTANCY & BUSINESS STATISTICS

The department organised various interactive sessions and extension lectures round the year in order to enhance the knowledge of the students in their subject. The session began with the career counselling session on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2019 for the new comers, organised by The Institute of Cost Accountants of India, Jaipur Chapter. The session was taken by Mr. P.D. Agarwal Head, ICAI Jaipur Chapter, who discussed about various career options with the students like CA, CS and CMA and answered the queries of the students regarding future aspects.

On 10<sup>th</sup> August, a special lecture was conducted for PG students by Dr. Vandana Bangaron 'GST and its Practical Applications'. The lecture provided the knowledge in the latest tax regime introduced by the government i.e. GST. On 24<sup>th</sup> September, a special lecture on 'How to use NET Banking' was organised for UG as well as PG students by in house faculty Dr. Bharti Godhwani, Assistant Professor of Department of EAFM. The main focus of this lecture was to familiarise students about quick access and convenient use of mobile phone or internet for NET banking.

On 28<sup>th</sup> September, a guest lecture was organised on Technical Analysis for PG students by Mr. Konark Kala, a registered stock market broker and research analyst. He enlightened the different analytical techniques for security price forecasting and online trading. On 14<sup>th</sup> October, a workshop was organised on 'Career Option After Graduation from Commerce Stream' for both UG as well as PG students by the renowned faculty of IMS.

On 6<sup>th</sup> November, an extension lecture was organised by the department on 'Funding Schemes Provided by MSME' delivered by Mr. Tarun Bhatnagar. He discussed different funding schemes provided by MSME to encourage business plans and promote entrepreneurs. With the intension to promote research among the post-graduate students, a lecture on 'Questionnaire Designing' was delivered on 27<sup>th</sup> November by Mr. Abhineet Saxena. In this interactive session, importance of questionnaire framing in any type of research work was enlightened.

Overall this academic session was a great experience which helped students in overcoming hurdles of academics as well as future aspects.

## DEPARTMENT OF BIOTECHNOLOGY

The department organised various activities for students to provide a practical perspective to their theoretical subjects. On 7<sup>th</sup> September 2019, the department organised a one-day Industrial visit to Jaipur Dairy. The prime objective of it was to acquaint the students about the processing and manufacturing of milk and milk products in the plant. The students learnt the key techniques like different fermenter types, SNF content, checking milk grades and quality control.

Internal assessment tests were conducted for B.Sc. Part I, II and III students from 23<sup>rd</sup> -25<sup>th</sup> September to evaluate their learning skill and subject knowledge. A guest lecture on "The Applications of Molecular Markers in Plant Biotechnology" by Dr. Rohit Jain, Assistant professor in Department of Biosciences, Manipal University, Jaipur was organised on 28<sup>th</sup> September. He explained the application of molecular markers in plant breeding, crop improvement and bio diversity, gene mapping, transcript profiling, QTL mapping and analysis of germplasm collection.

On 11<sup>th</sup> October 2019, Activity day (Biorhythm) was organised in which various fun learning activities based on biotechnology like rangoli making, face painting, quiz, dumb charades, antakshari and extempore etc. were performed by the students. The





certificates were awarded to all the winners. It was an event which gave opportunity to students to showcase their hidden talents, to develop coordination skills and team integrity. It was a great way to facilitate bonding amongst students and gave them chance to get to know each other better.

From 4<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> November B.Sc. Biotechnology part II and part III students presented seminars on their summer training and dissertations, respectively. This activity motivated the students to enhance their research aptitude and develop their interactive skills. These presentations were judged by the faculty and feedback was given to students by the teachers for their improvement. On 25<sup>th</sup> November, a one-day Industrial visit to Central Sheep and Wool Research Institute (CSWRI), Avikanagar, Malpura, Rajasthan was organised by the department for the students of B.Sc. Biotechnology. The prime objective of the center is to develop new scientific methods and technologies to enhance the productivity of sheep and rabbits. The major learnings were usage of various techniques like DNA isolation, Amplification, Gel electrophoresis, UV illuminators, Millipore water distillation etc. The students also learnt that Himalayan breed of sheep give best quality of fine wool with diameter of 12 to 30 microns. The Scientist of CSRI developed a new breed of sheep by inserting "Fec B" (Fecundity Booroola Gene) gene and named it as "Avishaan". It increases the ovulation rate and production by 2-3 times by giving birth to triplets. The visit was very informative for the students and helped in building their orientation towards research.

On 10<sup>th</sup> December, an extension lecture on 'Voltage gated potassium channels as therapeutic targets for autoimmune diseases' was conducted by Dr. Saumya Bajaj and scientist – Lee Kong Chian School of Medicine, Nanyang Technological University, Singapore. She delivered a talk on utilizing the plant venom and signaling its peptides towards the ion channels on immune system cells for treating autoimmune diseases. She also discussed the key techniques involved in the subject. A science poster / model exhibition was organised on 11<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> December in which students of B.Sc. Biotechnology part I participated actively. The students made posters and working models on various topics related to their subjects. Posters on Central Dogma, Erythroblastosis Fetalis, Life cycle of Plasmodium and Kidney structure and models on Rain water harvesting, Biogas plant and Waste water treatment plant got the prizes. Overall, the departmental activities enhanced the vision of the students towards the subject and helped them to perceive Biotechnology beyond the routine syllabus.

## DEPARTMENT OF BOTANY

The department organised various academic and co-curricular activities during the session 2019-20. M.Sc. Botany students along with faculty members attended a workshop on 'Assessment of Biodiversity and Field Botanization' organised by Rajasthan Forestry and Wildlife Training Institute, at Smriti Van, Jaipur on 30-31 July, 2019. The objective of workshop was identification of local flora and enrichment of botanical knowledge of local species. Botany experts guided the students in plant identification. Dr. N.C. Jain, Director, RFWTI, Jaipur gave presentation on scientific information for tree planting technique for greening urban spaces. He laid emphasis on greening of city, appropriate planting technique and water management system. A test on plant identification was also conducted for the students.



Power point presentation by students of B.Sc. Part-II and M.Sc. Semester-I was conducted in September and October. Students prepared power point slides on various topics of syllabus like Recombinant DNA Technology, DNA Replication and structure, plant growth hormones, stelar system, carbohydrates, proteins, enzymes, photosynthesis, plant water relations, DNA fingerprinting, taxonomic keys, families, plant diseases etc. Best presentations were awarded prizes.

An extension lecture was organised on 'Calculating Biodiversity Index (Singapore Index): Effective Strategies' by Dr. Soumana Datta, Head, Department of Botany, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur on 24<sup>th</sup> September. She told that urban developmental processes are often responsible for biodiversity loss. Mainstreaming biodiversity for integrating it into all policies, plans, programs, budgetary processes is important to achieve sustainable biodiversity and development outcomes. CBI is an index for cities to benchmark conservation efforts and evaluate progress in reducing the rate of biodiversity loss. She explained the parts and indicators of CBI with calculation of scores for indicators. She laid emphasis on the role of students in calculating CBI. The lecture was very informative and fruitful for the students.

On 1<sup>st</sup> October, a one-day botanical excursion to Jamwa Ramgarh Wildlife Sanctuary was organised for PG students. The students observed various phytogeographical regions like hilly, wetland plain and cropland areas. They explored native, endangered, rare and invasive plants during trekking. More



than 100 plant species belonging to around 40 families were studied. Certain species endemic to Aravalli hills like *Monsonia*, *Wrightia tinctoria*, *Sterculia*, *Anogeissus pendula*, rare species *Gloriosa superba*, *Pteridophytes -Actinopteris radiata* and *Adiantum*, *Bryophytes -Riccia* and *Marchantia* were observed. *Butea monosperma* was abundantly present in the region. This trip was beneficial for the students in enhancing their knowledge of plant taxonomy.

On 2<sup>nd</sup> October, a group discussion was held among B.Sc. Part-III students on 'Medicinal Importance of Ingredients of Indian Food'. They discussed the medicinal importance of tulsi, amla, cumin, ginger, asafoetida, turmeric, coriander, fenugreek, etc.

Science exhibition was organised on 11<sup>th</sup> December in which B.Sc. students prepared charts and models covering various topics of their syllabus like incomplete dominance, life cycle of algae, fungi and bryophytes, stellar system, plant cell, global warming, etc. Best three charts and models were awarded.

## DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

The department organised numerous activities during the session 2019-20 to enhance the skill amongst the students.

Our students, Sharddha Paniya, Shweta Pareek and Shailza Sharma attended and secured first position in the poster presentation competition, organised by Vigyan Bharati Rajasthan, Jaipur on 9<sup>th</sup> February, 2019.

The department organised National Workshop on 'Stereochemistry and Spectroscopy Applications' on 22<sup>nd</sup> – 24<sup>th</sup> April. The resource person was Eminent Scientist Prof. P.S. Kalsi.

Students attended short term course on 'Current Advancements and Future Opportunities in Material Sciences and Technologies' on 26<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> August and a five-day workshop on "Skill Development Course on Material Characterization Techniques" from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> September at MNIT, Jaipur. A Seminar on "Nanotechnology" was conducted on 5<sup>th</sup> September by Dr. M.R.R. Prasad, Scientist, ISRO. He explained how eucalyptol could replace diethyl ether, DMF, THF by Nanosciences. Students participated in National Workshop on "Instrumentation Techniques for Research in Chemical Sciences" (ITRCS-2019) on 6<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> September organised at Sophia Girls College, Ajmer. Department in collaboration with IISU organised Chemistry Quiz Olympiad on 21<sup>st</sup> September for students celebrating the International Year of Periodic Table. A total of 166 students keenly participated and Amita Choudhary, Amrit Sharma and Rupali Soni stood I, II and III respectively.



A Power Point Presentation competition was organised on 1<sup>st</sup> October on the topics of Chandrayaan- II, Nano Technology and solar energy. Diksha Soni, Priya Tiwari, Ritanshi Vyas, Divyansh Saini won the prizes. A guest lecture was organised on 3<sup>rd</sup> October by renowned scientist Prof. D. Basavaiah, DNA, IASC on the topic "Philosophy of Ultimate Success in Scientific Life". Students delivered oral presentations of their research work in short term course on "Current Trends in Graphene Synthesis and its Applications" under the guidance of Prof. Maheshwar Sheron, Prof. Madhuri Sheron, TEQUIP III from 15<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> October, organised at MNIT, Jaipur.



To enhance their presentation skills, students gave seminar on different topics from 14<sup>th</sup> -19<sup>th</sup> November and to encourage them, 10 best presentations were awarded. The department added another feather to its cap by organizing a two-day National Conference on International year of Periodic Table (IYPT – 2019) 'Know Your Elements' on 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> November. Around 453 students across Jaipur participated in the event. The chief guest, Ms. Mugdha Sinha (IAS, DST Rajasthan) proclaimed that Science and Innovation have been reinvented as we look for smaller, faster, newer and cheaper ways of completing our tasks.

## DEPARTMENT OF DRAWING AND PAINTING

The department screened the world's first fully painted feature film on 11<sup>th</sup> September showcasing the life & works of legendary artists: Vincent Van Gogh titled 'Loving Vincent'. 42 students of the department and faculty members witnessed the screening of this acclaimed film. The most remarkable feature of the film was that each scene had been hand painted and that too in Van Gogh's signature style. The documentary underlined Gogh's contributions to the modern art movement, bringing into focus the mystery behind his tragic death and his masterly style which bought him fame posthumously.

The month of September witnessed the inception of an art workshop on the 'Power of Texture in a Design' on 13<sup>th</sup> September. A demonstration of various textures was given by the faculty members of the department: Dr. Sarika Kaul, Ms. Preeti Kaushal and Ms. Ritika Kumari. Through this workshop, 60 students were made aware of varied textures that could be created and incorporated in a design, highlighting the versatility and impact of textures in a design.

The advent of October saw the students revelling themselves in a world of creative expression by participating in a variety of activities such as making posters on the life and teachings of Mahatma Gandhi, on 1<sup>st</sup> October. ## हिन्दी विभाग

शैक्षणिक एवं सह-शैक्षणिक गतिविधियों के माध्यम से अपनी राष्ट्रभाषा का गौरव बढ़ाने हेतु हिन्दी विभाग वर्षभर व्याख्यान व विभिन्न गतिविधियों का आयोजन करवाता है। इसी क्रम में 20 सितम्बर 2019 को मणिपाल विश्वविद्यालय की सेवानिवृत्त व्याख्याता डॉ. कुसुम शर्मा का व्याख्यान रखा गया, जिसका विषय 'सौन्दर्यात्मक अनुभूति का आधार: रस योजना' था।

वर्तमान समय में भावनात्मक संतुलन बिगड़ने से हम न केवल भौतिक सुख की तरफ बढ़ रहे हैं, बल्कि संवेदनात्मक दृष्टि से रसविहीन भी होते जा रहे हैं। भाव-विहीन जीवन की शुष्कता एवं नीरसता से बचने के लिए ही साहित्य और कलाओं की सृष्टि हुई है, जो हमारे सौंदर्य बोध को विकसित कर हमें आनंद की ओर अग्रसर करती हैं। इसी दृष्टि से हमारे देश के काव्य में 'रस' को काव्य की आत्मा मानकर उसके महत्व को स्थापित किया गया है।



डॉ. कुसुम शर्मा ने 'रस' की परिभाषा, उसके अंग एवं साहित्य में उसके महत्व पर विस्तार से प्रकाश डालते हुए बताया कि जीवन में भावों से ही सौन्दर्य उत्पन्न होता है और उन्हीं भावों की मनोरम प्रस्तुति साहित्य को रसमय बनाती है। अनेक उदाहरणों के माध्यम से उन्होंने अपनी बात की पुष्टि की। हिन्दी एवं अंग्रेजी साहित्य की लगभग 50-60 छात्राओं ने इस व्याख्यान का लाभ उठाया और अंत में प्रश्न पूछकर अपनी शंकाओं का समाधान किया।

20 नवम्बर को जगद्गुरु रामानंद संस्कृत विश्वविद्यालय के अनुसंधान केन्द्र के निदेशक डॉ. राजधर मिश्र ने 'भाषा का शुद्ध स्वरूप एवं व्याकरण' विषय पर व्याख्यान देते हुए बताया कि 'भाषणात्भाषा' अर्थात् भाषा बोलने से आती है और इसके शुद्ध स्वरूप को जानना निम्नकारणों से आवश्यक है-

1. भाषा के निश्चयात्मक ज्ञान प्राप्ति के लिए।
2. भाषा की रक्षा के लिए।
3. तर्क की क्षमता विकसित करने के लिए।
4. व्याकरण प्राचीन ज्ञान है, अतः उसे जानने के लिए।
5. कम शब्दों में अधिक अर्थ को जानने की क्षमता विकसित करने के लिए।

आपने बताया कि जिस अर्थ को हम कहना चाहते हैं, वह यदि पूरी तरह अभिव्यक्त न हो, तो वह वाक्य शुद्ध नहीं है। संरचना अथवा अर्थ की दृष्टि से भाषा में अशुद्धियाँ हो सकती हैं और इन्हीं पर ध्यान देकर हम भाषा के शुद्ध स्वरूप को जान सकते हैं तथा अपने संभाषण को प्रभावी बना सकते हैं। भाषा को परंपरा और व्याकरण (नियम) के द्वारा जाना जा सकता है, लेकिन बोलचाल एवं साहित्यिक भाषा में अंतर होता है।

"साँप तू तो नगर में रहा नहीं,  
फिर डसना कहाँ से सीखा..."

यहाँ काव्यात्मक भाषा में एक बहुत बड़ा व्यंग्य है, जो अनेक अर्थ उद्घाटित करता है। शब्द की सामर्थ्य को समझे बिना उसका सम्पूर्ण अर्थ ग्रहण करना संभव नहीं, अतः भाषा के सही स्वरूप को जानना प्रभावी संप्रेषण के लिए बहुत आवश्यक है। छात्राओं द्वारा भाषा के शुद्धीकरण से संबंधित जिज्ञासाओं का समाधान डॉ. मिश्र ने व्याकरण के अनेक उदाहरणों के माध्यम से किया। हिन्दी दिवस के उपलक्ष्य में आयोजित प्रतियोगिताओं में भी विभाग की छात्राओं ने उत्साहपूर्वक भाग लिया।

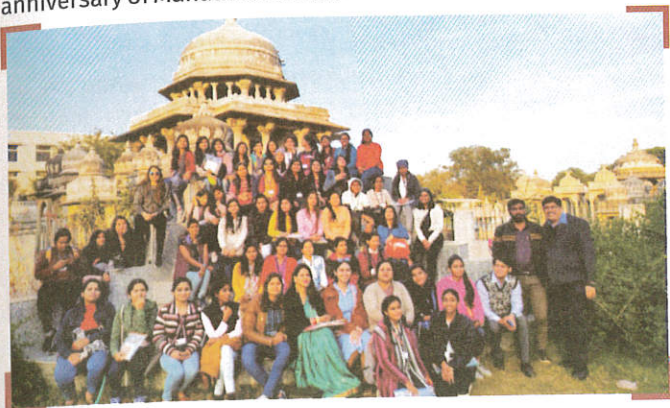
## DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY

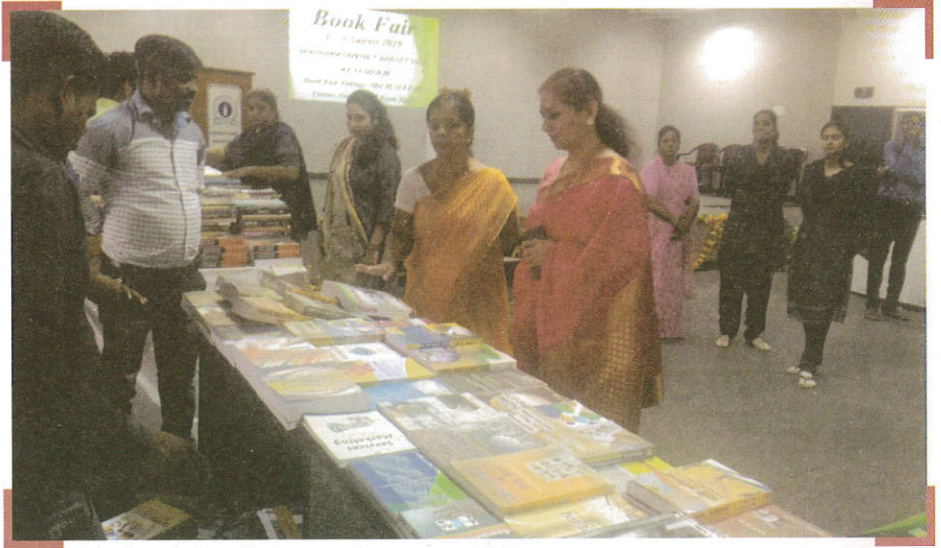
## पुस्तकालय

## WORKSHOP ON CAPACITY BUILDING FOR ASSESSING JAIPUR CITY BIODIVERSITY INDEX 2019

Generating awareness to build Jaipur City Biodiversity Index was the core issue discussed in a one-day workshop on 'Capacity Building for Assessing Jaipur City Biodiversity Index 2019' organised by the college in collaboration with Rajasthan State Biodiversity Board, Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur on 16<sup>th</sup> November, 2019.

A total of 190 participants from various sections of the society i.e. college faculty, school teachers, research scholars, post-graduate students and officials from Forest Department, Jaipur Development Authority, Nagar Nigam and Smart City Mission, Jaipur participated. We were fortunate to have amongst us Shri Pradeep Kumar Borad, Commissioner, College Education Rajasthan, addressed the gathering by emphasizing on the importance of biodiversity by quoting example of butterfly and the role of Indian mythology in biodiversity conservation. Dr. G. V. Reddy, Chairman, Rajasthan State Biodiversity Board, Jaipur addressed the gathering by a brief introduction about 'City Biodiversity Index' along with the need to develop and monitor it. Ms. Shruti Sharma (IFS), Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forest, NTPF, Jaipur, briefly highlighted the role of students in sustainability study and importance of forest bathing. She spoke on 'Jaipur City Biodiversity'. Shri N. C Jain Principal Chief Conservator of Forest and Director, (Rajasthan Forest and Wildlife Training Institute), Jaipur talked about developing zero waste areas. Shri Sunil Chidri (IFS), Conservator of Forest in JDA who in his lecture on City Biodiversity Index (CBI) explained the Singapore Index (SI) in city biodiversity comprising of city profile and 23 indicators to measure native biodiversity. Shri Manoj Kulshretha, Plant Breeder, Genetics and Ornithologist in his topic 'Birds of Jaipur and its Environs' discussed about the important wetlands and forest locations for birds in and near Jaipur and their biodiversity indexing.

## WORKSHOP ON EXCAVATIONS OF ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITES

Two days' workshop on Excavation of Archaeological Sites was conducted on 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> December 2019 at Udaipur. It was organised by our History department of the college in joint collaboration with Department of Archaeology and Museums, Government of Rajasthan. 50 students and three faculty members of History department participated in this. Dr. Godhal explained about Stone Age -Palaeolithic, Mesolithic and Neolithic ages, their tools and culture, Chalcolithic Centers in Rajasthan belonging to Harappan tradition- (Kalibanga, Tarkhanwala Dera), Ahar tradition -(Gilund, Balathal, Ojiyana) and Ganeshwar- Jodhpur tradition-(Ganeshwar, Jodhpura, Sonari, Noh).

Mr. Lalit Pandey, Former Director, Institute of Rajasthan Studies, Janardan Rai Nagar Vidyapeeth, Deemed University, Udaipur and Former Dean and Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities, Bhupal Nobles University, Udaipur. He discussed about various tools and techniques involved in excavating Ahar site. He provided a clear account of preparations for full excavations, recordings of photographic, spatial, stratigraphic and physical evidences related to it. He emphasised that archaeology reveals the unknown facts about the history of Rajasthan which are beyond the reach of traditional tools of research. Students also visited the site of Ahar and the Ahar museum. It was great pleasure for our students to visually see the archaeological remains and actual process of excavation. Students also enjoyed visiting various tourist spots at Udaipur on the concluding day of the workshop which maximised their learning and exhilaration.

## **IPR MANAGEMENT IN BIODIVERSITY CONSERVATION: IMPLICATIONS OF ACCESS BENEFIT SHARING, TRIP/CBD AND BIODIVERSITY ACTS**

A two-day National Seminar on 'IPR Management in Biodiversity Conservation: Implications of Access Benefit Sharing, TRIP/CBD and Biodiversity Acts' was organised by department of Zoology and Botany, of the college on 17-18 January, 2020 in collaboration with Rajasthan State Biodiversity Board, Government of Rajasthan with Technical Partner Department of Science and Technology, Government of Rajasthan. The objective of the seminar was to spread wide awareness about protecting indigenous knowledge (traditional and modern) from being 'pirated' and used in IPR claims by industrial/commercial interests. Honorable Minister Technical Education, Government of Rajasthan. Dr. Subhash Garg graced the occasion as the chief guest. Dr. N C Jain, Principal Chief Conservator of Forest delivered the keynote address and emphasized on conserving natural resources and moving towards greener environment. The first Technical Session 'Introduction to IPR' was chaired by Shri Govind Sharma, Ex. Chief National Research Development Corporation, New Delhi. He spoke about various aspects of Intellectual Rights by citing real life examples.



The other speakers Shri N C Jain and Pankaj Kumar, IPR Facilitator, IIS University, Jaipur highlighted the impact of modernization of Intellectual Property Rights. The second and third Technical Session 'IPR and Protection to traditional Knowledge and its Biological Interface' was chaired by Prof Ashwani Kumar, Former Head, Department of Botany, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur. He talked about the traditional medicines and biodiversity conservation. Mr. Pankaj Gupta, Rajasthan High Court explained the importance and classification of IPR and also talked about start-up India and various action plans. Dr. Gunjan Sharma from DST, Jaipur gave an explanatory talk on Innovation cycle and things which are patentable. Dr. G V Reddy, RSBB, Jaipur shared his views on Access Benefit Sharing, Nagoya Protocol and Biodiversity Act, 2002.

Technical Session IV 'Biopiracy, Bioprospecting and ABS Mechanism' was chaired by Dr. Vartika Arora, Principal, Rajasthan School of Law for Women, Jaipur. Dr. Abhishek Tiwari, Deputy Director, University Five Year Law College, Jaipur expressed his views on the Acts framed by National and International Agencies to combat biopiracy and to protect the Intellectual Property Rights. Dr. Meenakshi Punia, Sardar Patel University of Police Security and Criminal Justice, Jodhpur spoke on biopiracy and struggle for protecting traditional knowledge. Fifth Technical Session 'Laws and Policy Framework for CBD, Nagoya Protocol, Biological Diversity Act of India, State Biodiversity Rule of Rajasthan' was chaired by Dr. J V Sharma, Director, Forestry and Biodiversity, TERI, New Delhi. The legal framework and laws related to biodiversity along with its application was the part of his speech. Dr. Har Lal Singh from MNIT, Jaipur spoke on role of biodiversity related laws. Dr. Komal Audichya, Jaipur National University, Jaipur shared her research work on Khani tribe. The Chief Guest for Valedictory Session was Dr. Raja Babu Panwar, Vice Chancellor, RUHS, Jaipur congratulated the college for drawing attention on such an important theme of the Seminar. Justice P C Jain, Chairman, Kanoria Girls College Trust and Dr. G V Reddy, Chairman, RSBB talked about the implication of IPR in the field of biodiversity conservation. The seminar provided an opportunity to the delegates and intellectuals to exchange views and need to come to a concrete action plan towards biodiversity conservation along preserving our traditional knowledge.

## IT ASSOCIATION

In this series IT Association organised an interactive session in the month of August on Cyber Security Awareness by Mr. Milind Agarwal from Cyber Crime Awareness Society. He explained about various Ethical Hacking techniques to students so that they become aware of cybercrimes and intruders. He discussed about Bit-coin, Birthday attack, IDN homographic attack, Phishing and various kind of attacks with live examples. He gave live demo of how hackers can hack your mobile application like WhatsApp, Facebook etc. and send message on your



behalf thus making students aware about online frauds. At the end he discussed some Dos and Don'ts to keep us safe from cyber criminals. All the students of computer science department participated in this informative session with great enthusiasm.



A workshop on Web Designing was organised by Eounus Solutions Pvt. Ltd. in the month of September. Mr. Arun sharma and Team led the workshop with an introduction on web page designing, web page development, hosting and multimedia training. They highlighted the concepts of HTML, CSS, Java script, JQuery and Bootstrap including the concepts of coding, editing (notepad, Dreamweaver, sublime). He also explained how graphic designing could be done with the help of Coral draw and Adobe. The workshop was highly beneficial for the students as it provides them practical knowledge. On 16<sup>th</sup> October the association organised an industrial visit to Bhamashah Techno Hub situated near Jhalana Doongi, Jaipur. Around 50 students of BCA along with two faculty members visited the hub and they got to know about various latest technologies like robotic movements, neuro Sensor, VR technology, Augmented Reality, Artificial intelligence, Visual reality etc. The Visit was an amazing experience and made students aware about augmented and virtual reality concept. This visit was really a treat to satisfy the technical thirst of the students.

An interactive session on IoT (Internet of Things) which is a very popular concept in today's era was organised on 21<sup>st</sup> November by The Beginners Institute, Jaipur. This session not only covered theoretical information about IoT but also provided practical knowledge on the same. To the student's surprise, firstly they were asked to fill a questionnaire form related with IoT to check the knowledge of the students then they began with a presentation covering all terms related to IoT and its architecture. It dealt with various stages like Sensors/ Actuators, Data Acquisition System, Edge Analysis, and the Core Analysis. They also cleared the basic term 'smart device' and provided numerous example of its application in day-to-day life. In the practical session, Mr Gautam gave a live example of linking our own voice command to a device and turning it into smart device. He also taught the students to create a program using Arduino software and configured an LED bulb to it. He connected Alexa and by using his voice command, instructed to turn on and off the bulb. That fabulous illustration brought an end to the seminar.

To unveil the talent of the students a power point presentation competition was organised on 18<sup>th</sup> December for the BCA first year students. They presented their presentations on various interesting topics like Humanoid Robots, Devops, Smart TV, Networking Era, 3-D Printing, and Virtual Reality etc. It was overall a great learning experience for students. Winners of the competition were Riya Mathew and Divya Punjabi (First prize), Suditi Joshi and Dakshita (Second prize), Aditi and Shubhali (Third prize). The activities around the year helps in developing the various technical skills along with theoretical knowledge. ## LIFE SCIENCES ASSOCIATION

He pictographically introduced many varieties of birds like wagtails, herons, cormorants, ducks, mynas, sparrows, babblers, dove, robin etc. He also explained various techniques for bird identification and nomenclature based on their body, head and plumage pattern. His lecture concluded with his noble vision towards eco-restoration and biodiversity conservation.

The most awaited event 'The Science Exhibition' was organised on 11<sup>th</sup> December for the B.Sc. students in which they prepared and presented various charts and models of scientific temper and were awarded I, II and III prizes.

At the end of the documentary, the curious students asked various questions to faculties. It was an interactive session and a successful event from the Material Science Association.

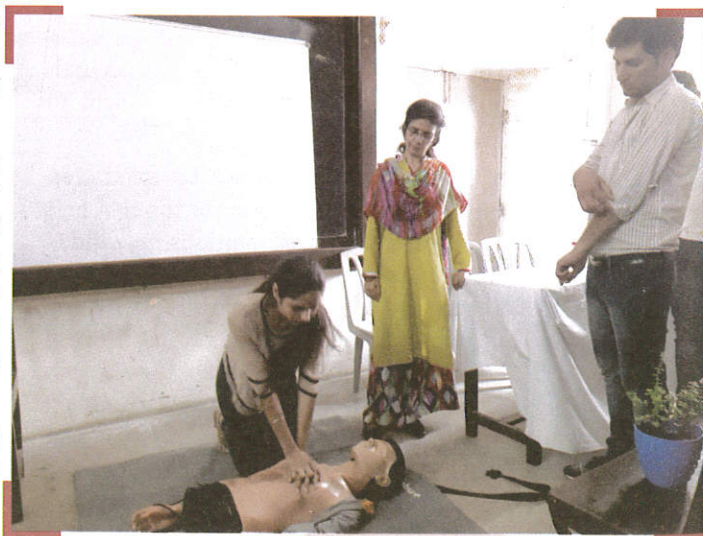

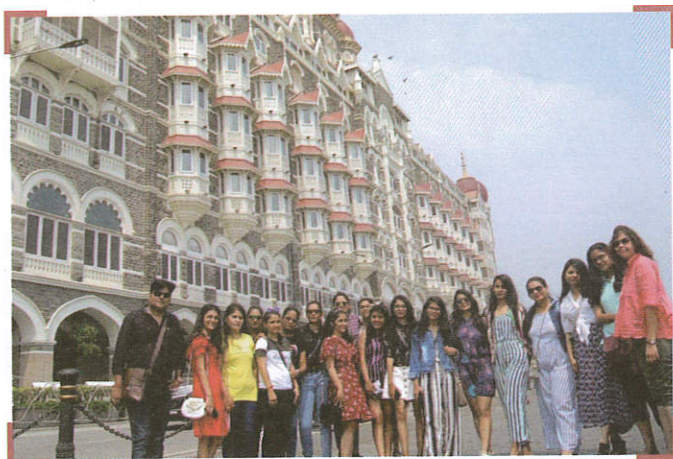


# Exploring the Unexplored

## GOA TRIP

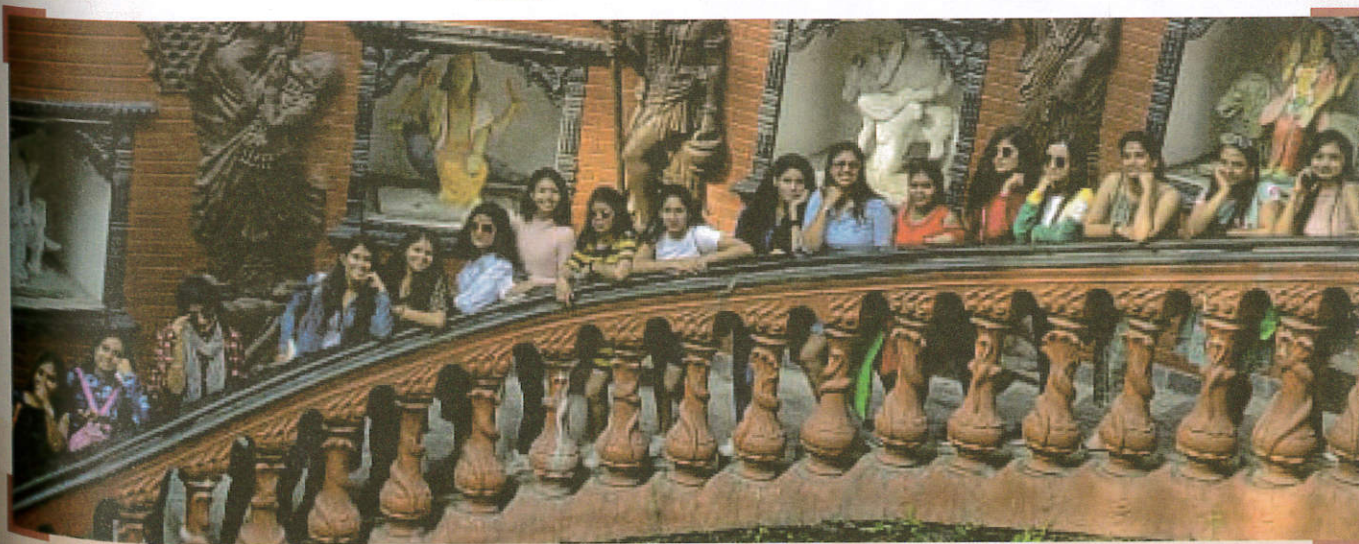
