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Feedback Analysis Report on Virtual Parent Teacher Meet Session 2020-21

In spite of COVID-19 pandemic situation, Kanoria PG Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Jaipur is conducting online classes for all UG and PG students. In previous years, college has conducted face to face Parents-Teacher meeting to interact with parents/guardian to know feedback and suggestions about their wards and college as well. For this academic session college prepared a feedback form (Google form) and instructed students to get it filled by their parents/guardian. Questionnaire was framed for parents to know their view about the online classes and other extracurricular activities conducted for their ward. College received a total of 1004 feedbacks out of which 912 and 92 were received from the parents of undergraduate and post-graduate students respectively.

Kanoria PG Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Jaipur asked the parents to fill the parents' feedback form online during the period 5th December to 15th December 2020. We shared the feedback form link in the respective Google classrooms and informed all the students through WhatsApp group and Google classroom.


The main aim of this feedback form was to create an interaction between the administration, teachers, parents, and students. In the feedback form, a variety of issues were addressed regarding the students' educational experiences and their all-round development.

The agenda of the Parents feedback was as follows:

- ✓ To Obtain feedback from the parents/guardians
- \checkmark To know the experiences of students and their satisfaction level of online classes


The objectives of the Parents feedback shall be -

- \checkmark To encourage and promote a good relationship among the teacher, students and parents/guardians.
- ✓ To create an enthusiastic interest in the progress and smooth working of college, and in the maintenance of good discipline and high academic standards.
- \checkmark To improve the learning methods by knowing the strength and weaknesses of the students.
- \checkmark To provide more amenities to the students at the College.



Statistical analysis of feedback (Virtual Parent Teacher Meet 2020-21)

As mentioned above college received 912 responses for undergraduate classes, out of which 379 were from Science (B.Sc.) ward of different subjects i.e. 199, 42 and 138 from Biology, Mathematics and Biotechnology respectively.



College received 93 responses, out of which 52 were from different postgraduate subjects of Science, number of feedbacks received were 18, 3, 4, 6 and 21 from Botany, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics and Zoology respectively.

Student's relationship wise feedback received:





Figure of undergraduate classes illustrates that feedback form were mainly filled by father (70.71%) and mother (23.48%), the number of guardians is very less in comparison to parents which shows that most of the students are staying with their parents during COVID time.

Also, maximum feedback for postgraduate classes were filled by father (78.85%), 15.38% feedback were received from mother and 5.77% were filled by the guardians of the students.



When we compared the number of feedbacks received from the parents for their wards studying in different classes, result depicted that a large number of feedback were received for Part I students i.e. 47.23% (179/379). From the parents of Part II students we received 36.41% (138/379) while participation from Part III was only 16.36% (62/379).


Feedback Q. 1: Is your Child enrolled in the Virtual Classroom (Google Classroom)?



Parents/guardians are well aware about the online learning of their wards. 97.63% feedback responses were positive while 2.38% were unaware about it.


Result of the postgraduate virtual classroom analysis suggested that 100% students are enrolled in the virtual classes which is a great achievement for the college.

Feedback Q. 2: From when your ward is attending online classes ?




The above graph depicts the month wise enrolled students in online classes. Analysis showed that more than 70% students got till the month of themselves enrolled September, and it was confirmed by their parents by which month their ward are attending online classes conducted by college. Till November all parents were aware about the engagement of their child with college via virtual classes which also nullified the unawareness of 2.38% parents about their ward enrolment in online classes (as responded in previous question).

Postgraduate Classes



The result revealed that majority of students got enrolled themselves in the month of August and all (100%) till September as given in feedback by their parents.


Feedback Q. 3: Is your Ward able to understand the topics via Online mode?



Most of the parents (78.89%) agreed that their ward well understood topics taught in online mode, however, 16.36% parents totally disagreed with this fact. While 4.75% parents have doubt regarding the effectiveness of online classes for their ward.

It is a milestone for college that 86.54% parents of postgraduate students agreed that their wards are able to understand the topics taught in online classes, 13.46% feedback received were in dilemma situation but no one totally disagreed.


Feedback Q. 4: Does the teacher Post all required information in the virtual Classroom?




Results showed that most of the parents (85.75%) were in touch with their ward regarding the information/materials posted in virtual classes. 3.96% parents were not satisfied with the posted information while 10.29% lacked awareness.

96.15% parents of postgraduate students consented to the fact that their ward were receiving all the required information in virtual classes while 3.85% were unsure about this aspect, however, none of the parents showed their dissatisfaction.

Feedback Q. 5: College motivates your ward to work hard and achieve her best ? Undergraduate Classes




The above figure showed the responses received to know the status of parents about their ward motivational level being pumped by the college to achieve her goals. 15.56% feedbacks strongly agreed on this fact, also 64.64% parents too agreed. While 18.20% remained neutral to the question posed whereas 1.57% parents disagreed.




The above figure showed that 23.07% parents strongly agreed to the fact that college motivates their ward for hardworking to achieve the set goals. 11.53% parents were neutral while no one showed disagreement about this question.

Feedback Q. 6: College is conducting Virtual Extra-Curricular Activities for the students?



Along with the online classes, college is also conducting extra-curricular activities for students but it was important for college to know that parents are aware about it or not. The results showed that 84.16% parents have knowledge about it while 3.69% parents were ignorant that during this pandemic situation extracurricular activities are being carried out in virtual mode for their ward.





The above graph shows that 96.15% parents are aware that even during pandemic when their wards are at home, college is conducting extra-curricular activities in virtual mode, only 3.84% parents were unaware about the activities of the college.


Feedback Q. 7: Are the instructions given to your ward during online class easy enough to understand?

In the present situation when all academic activities are held virtually, the information is also dissipated through it. It is of utmost importance to know whether the instruction given to the students during online classes were sufficient enough to understand. 77.57% parents gave their consent while 16.89% parents responded negatively.


More than 85% parents of postgraduate students of science stream consented on the fact that their ward were receiving all instructions in a proper way while others were not satisfied with the given instructions.

Feedback Q. 8: College deals effectively with grievances.





Besides other activities it is also necessary to timely address the grievances of the students which creates a healthier and stress free environment for them. 77.82% feedback showed that college is dealing effectively with grievance of students while 18.73% and 3.42% feedbacks were neutral and disagreed respectively.

Postgraduate Classes



Results showed that 82.68% parents of postgraduate students agreed that college is dealing effectively with grievances of the students while 13.46% were neutral and 3.84% showed their disagreement.






70.71% parents show their consent that they are satisfied with the time table being followed for online classes while 8.97% showed their disagreement. 20.32% parents remained neutral on this question.

From the point of view of following proper time table of online teaching for postgraduate classes, 88.46% parents responded positively while 5.77% parents were neutral and 5.77% were dissatisfied with the implementation of time table.

Feedback Q. 10: Does your Ward regularly attends the classes as per your observation?



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
Result of the analysis suggested that more than 90% parents are very concerned about the study of their ward during the pandemic and they also confirmed that their wards regularly attends the online classes while according to 2.90% parents responded negatively. Rest 6.86% parents were unsure about their attendance.

Analysis of the feedback received from the parents of postgraduate students showed that 88.46% parents were aware regarding regular attendance of their ward in online classes. 1.92% parents of students observed that they attend classes irregularly while 9.62% were unaware about the attendance of their wards.

Feedback Q. 11: Teachers are easily approachable and open to Parental input Undergraduate Classes




More than 50% parents gave their consent and that they can contact teachers of the college about the concern of their ward, 33.50% parents were neutral on this question while 10.01% showed their disagreement with this fact.




Among all the feedbacks received from the parents of postgraduate students of science

subjects 9.61% parents showed their strong agreement and 75% agreed to the fact that teachers of the college are easily approachable and open to parental input. 9.61% parents were neutral while 5.76% parents disagreed.

Feedback Q. 12: On the scale of 1 to 5, rate the Effectiveness of ICT tools used by the college for Online Classes




During pandemic when educational institutions are closed, ICT has become a boon. College created virtual classrooms for students for online classes. Feedback was taken by college from parents to measure the effectiveness of these online classes on 1 to 5 rating (least to best). 19.78% feedbacks rated highly with 5 while 45.11% for 4, 29.55% for 3, 2.90% for 2 and only 2.63% for 1 respectively.




Effectiveness of ICT tools were appreciated by parents of postgraduate students. 21.15% parents rated these online classes moderate ranking while 42.30% and 36.53% (total 78.83%) rated as good with 4 and 5 respectively.

Feedback Q. 13: College has maintained its high academic standards and

extracurricular activities during the COVID-19, through virtual learning Undergraduate Classes




Rating criteria from 1 to 5 was also adopted to evaluate the virtual learning effectiveness to maintain the high standards of academics as well as for extracurricular activities during lockdown period due to pandemic. 73.51% feedbacks rated it highly i.e. 4 while 20.58% parents gave moderate rating of 3. 4.48% and 1.31% gave 2 and 1 ratings respectively.



More than 90% (42.30% and 48.07% rated 4 and 5 respectively) parents of postgraduate students praised this aspect while rating 3 by 5.76% and rating 2 was given by 3.84% parents.

Feedback Q. 14: Are you satisfied with your child's overall Classroom experience?



More than 75% parents were satisfied with the overall experience of online classroom teaching for their ward. 15.30% were neutral on this question while 6.86% responded negatively.

For overall classroom experience for postgraduate students 86.54% parents are satisfied, 3.85% showed their dissatisfaction while 9.62% are in dilemma regarding the same

Feedback Q. 15: If College will conduct Online Parent-Teacher Meet, would you like to attend it?



Now a days many platforms are available to conduct online meeting to avoid social gathering and follow the COVID19 guidelines. Hence, in near future if college plans to organize an online parents-teacher meet, 84.17% parent gave their consent for the same, while 15.83% parents did not show their interest in such online PTMs.

82.69% parents of postgraduate students showed their interest to attend online parent-teacher meet if organized by the college while 17.31% parents responded negatively for such meeting.

Feedback Q. 16: Any Suggestions (Your suggestions are valuable for us): In spite of the framed question in feedback form, parents also gave few inputs which are as follows:

1. Open the offline classes if possible

2. Some videos are not clearly visible, resolve the issue

3. Class tests should be taken at least once in a month

4. Please conduct parent teacher meeting on a regular basis

5. Interact with students personally.

Conclusion:

Analysis of all the feedbacks received by the college revealed that more than 75% of the parents believe that while the college is closed due to COVID-19 pandemic, the studies being conducted by the online classes is a commendable effort.

Results also showed that majority of parents are aware about the extracurricular activities conducted in virtual mode and are satisfied with the efforts being made by the college at every level for the students.

Summarizing this report, it is understandable that the parents are worried about the education of their children during the pandemic when institutions are closed, but they believed that the academic and non-academic efforts made by the college in online mode are appreciable and all these efforts will be fruitful for the overall development of their child.






We have received total 58 responses. On the basis of those responses we are able to analyse on various points. Above graph showed that 100% students are enrolled in the virtual class room which is very good. As per the 81% parents opinion, students are able to understand the topics via Online mode which is also quite good. 91% parents are agreed that the teacher Post all required information in the virtual Classroom. Around 83% accepted that the

instructions given to their ward during online classes are easy enough to understand. Timetable being properly followed that is said by around 75% parents. As per the parent's observation almost 90% Ward regularly attends the classes. Around 80% parents accepted that they are satisfied with their ward overall Classroom experience. If College will conduct Online Parent-Teacher Meet, 81% would you like to attend it.



We have received total 58 responses. On the basis of those responses we are able to analyse on various points. Above graph showed that 60% parents are agreed and around 21% parents are strongly agreed that College motivates their ward to work hard and achieve her best. Around 88% parents are agreed or strongly agreed on the point that College is conducting Virtual Extra-

Curricular Activities for the students. Around 78% parents are agreed and strongly agreed that college deals effectively with grievances. 67% parents are agreed on the point that Teachers are easily approachable and open to Parental input although 7% are strongly disagreed on that point.



We have received total 58 responses. On the basis of those responses we are able to analyse on various points. Above graph showed that 81% parents agreed that effectiveness of ICT tools used by the college for Online Classes are very good and 21% said that it is satisfactory. 76% parents rated very good on the point that


Statistical Analysis of Feedback (Virtual Parent Teacher Meet 2020) Arts Stream (BA & BA Hons.)

A review of parents and caretakers was taken in reference to online classes to understand their involvement and level of satisfaction. There are approximately 2000 students enrolled in Bachelors programs in Arts stream out of which more than 300 responses were garnered representing low participation.


The aim was not only to understand student/parent satisfaction and grievances but also to make the parents aware of the college's and child's activity/performance.

• Approximately, all the students are enrolled for virtual classroom and parents are also well aware of it.





• The dispersion is seen in the enrolment of the students in virtual classroom.




- Most of the parents are well aware of the materials shared, online live classes and their ward's performance and attendance in the classroom

a mixed response in the understanding of the curriculum through online mode and are looking forward to live classes







• The parents are partially satisfied with the motivation and push given by teachers to involve students in studying and attending online classes




• Parents are satisfied with the timetable being followed for online classes.











Statistical Analysis of Feedback (Virtual Parent-Teacher Meet 2020) Commerce Stream (B.Com.)


During COVID-19 Pandemic, college conducted the Virtual Parent-Teacher Meeting for session 2020-21. College has received 111 responses in Commerce stream, out of which 47 % responses are from first year, 32 % are from second year and 21 % are from third year.




In the virtual classroom 96% students are enrolled, this shows their zeal. Despite being in adverse situation, students are keen towards their studies.



The data reveals that majority of students were enrolled in the virtual classroom in the month of July and August and about 3/4th of students' parents and guardians confirmed that their ward is understanding the topics very well through online mode and getting all the required information. Students and their parents strongly agreed and opines that college is motivating them for hard work and to achieve better results.




22% respondents strongly agree and double of it, 45% students had expressed their agreement with extra-curricular activities organized by the college on a periodical basis and majority of the students are in favor that instructions given in online classes are easy to understand and their problems are addressed patiently.



76% of total responses revealed that despite of this Pandemic, college has swiftly adopted online mode of time table and has implemented it in a well-versed manner. 

Virtual Parent Teacher Meet – Feedback Analysis


Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA)

To know the response of students and parents for online classes, virtual PTM was conducted in the month of December in 2020, for BBA Students. In this PTM parents of 53 students from BBA, PART 1, PART2 and PART 3 took part and gave their valuable time. From these students 51% students started taking their classes from July, 4% joined in August ,24% in september,17% in october,4% in November. Parents response regarding understandability of online classes to their ward can be seen from below chart (fig 1) where 64 % (34) parents said that, yes their ward is getting what is being taught in online classes. This is good percentage in itself.


Another noticeable point is that 87% parents said (fig.2) that their ward is getting all required information in virtual classes.


They have even appreciated the role of college in motivating students as 58% parents have agreed that college motivates students to work hard and give their best. Also 53% parents have agreed that college is conducting virtual extra curriculum activities for students.

After analyzing figures, it can be seen that 70% parents agree that college effectively deals with grievances. Discipline is always regarded as one of the best management practice and this is what college has been practicing which is revealed through the responses given by parents where 91 % parents agree that time table is being followed.
