

- **भाषा-प्रयोगशाला (लैंग्वेज-लैब)** – भाषा-प्रयोगशाला मूल भाषा कौशल की पद्धति को विकसित करती है। शिक्षण के पारम्परिक तरीके से अलग भाषा-कौशल प्रदान करने का यह तकनीकी-स्रोत है। भाषा-प्रयोगशाला द्वारा छात्राओं की लेखन व मौखिक क्षमताओं को परिष्कृत कर विकसित किया जाता है।

The library has a rich collection of more than 70,000 books with an excellent reading ambience and scalable infrastructure. The library offers 13 daily newspapers in Hindi and English and 114 National and International Journals/Magazines along with 17 SAGE journals which can be accessed online.

- **User Orientation Programme:** A User Orientation Programme is conducted every year for First year students in the month of August to create an awareness of the facilities provided by the library.
- **Library Timings:** 9 am – 5 pm (throughout the academic year)
- **True Value System:** Library management software is executed via a barcode system which is helpful in creating and maintaining student database, book inventory and cataloging.
- **User friendly software:** OPAC (user software) facilitate direct access to library catalogue making makes it convenient for the faculty and students to search for the desired texts.
- **E-Resource:** Library is member of E-Shodh Sindhu (N-List) program from UGC INFLIBNIT. Faculty members and students can access more than 6000+ e-journals and 31,35,000 + e-books from eminent publishers like Oxford, Cambridge, Springer, Taylor and Francis and many more. Sage also provides digital access to its resources to the college. The Library, it has an institutional membership for National Digital Library (NDL), through which thousands of e-resources can be accessed.
- **Book Bank:** The college, in its effort to support under privileged students provides for books on yearly basis through the book bank constituting of 9500 books, managed by the college library. Forms are available within the library itself for students who would like to avail this facility. Apart from this, the library also maintains a catalogue of 3105 gifted books as well.
- **Book Lending System:** Books can be borrowed for 15 days. A penalty system exists for those students who do not abide by the rules of book lending. Students should check the book for any torn or missing pages and seek an endorsement on the book prior to its issue.

- उपयोगकर्ता अभिविन्यास कार्यक्रम (यूज़र ओरिएंटेशन प्रोग्राम)— इस कार्यक्रम के अन्तर्गत प्रतिवर्ष नवागन्तुक छात्राओं के लिए पुस्तकालय द्वारा दी जाने वाली सुविधाओं की जानकारी दी जाती है। पुस्तकालय की कार्य-प्रणाली से अवगत करवाते हुए, छात्राओं को पुस्तकालय के प्रति उनके दायित्वों के संबंध में जागरूक किया जाता है एवं पुस्तकालय की नियमावली तथा आवश्यक निर्देश भी इस कार्यक्रम के माध्यम से दिये जाते हैं।
