
I am grateful to the present management of the college for selecting me as a torch bearer for headway of the institution.

In its long and dynamic journey of extending the outreach of education for girls, the college has remained an interface between knowledge and societal expectations.

For the academic session 2018-19, total 5829 students were enrolled for 9 undergraduate courses run in the college. BA Economics Hons. is the UG Course re-introduced in this session only. 582 students were admitted in 15 post graduate courses out of which M.Sc. Maths, M.Sc. Physics and MJMC are the newly introduced PG Courses.

Our college is one of the approved study centres of Indira Gandhi National Open University. Our centre offers more than 20 certificates/ diploma/PG diploma/UG and PG courses of IGNOU.

I am trying to highlight in brief the activities conducted for the development of the students and achievements of the students. The extensive report is in your hands in form of the Chronicles of Kanoria 2018-19.

Keeping pace with evolving needs of our times, we have ventured to collaborate with some of the best names in academics and industry to introduce skill enhancement and value added courses to enable the students to be self-reliant. The college has signed MOU with Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai to run industry relevant course. MOU with Institute of Cost Accounting of India for the Certified Accounting Technician Course, MOU with iECEN, Milan, Italy for Fashion Designing Course. The Certificate Course in Organic Farming in collaboration with Morarka Foundation. The college runs certificate courses of Functional English, Hindi Bhasha Kaushal, French and German Language and Diploma in Art & Craft, Office Management, Nutrition and Dietetics, Music and dance, etc. These skill enhancement courses along with their regular degree courses prepare the students to become sustainable in their life.

Kanoria College also has affiliation from Government Agencies for Research in Science and Social Science. In this context, I want to mention the MOU signed with Government of Rajasthan regarding Soil Health Card Project. A Soil Testing Lab has been established in the campus in which our students with the help of faculties and Government Officials testing soil samples to make Soil Health Card for the farmers. MOU is with the college under which students are trained to cultivate the Spirulina Algae.

In our efforts towards academic excellence and growth, the college initiated actions to bridge the gap between the theory of text books and its applications. Formation of Subject Associations is one of the remarkable efforts. Commerce and Management Association every year organize CAMFEST to enhance student learning through various activities. Science Associations organize exhibitions in which chart, project and working models prepared by students were displayed.

As I share the yearly updates of our activities, I take the humility to say that we did our best to do as we have planned and I am proud of my beloved students and staff members who strive hard to achieve beyond expectations.

Excellence in academics is the hall-mark of a good institution and the results of our students in the university examinations have made us proud.

It is a moment of delight for us that all the PG departments of our college have 100% result in all the semesters. In UG courses, the average pass percentage is 94% and 100% results in B.Sc. Biotech Part-II and III and BA Hons. Part-II and III.

To nurture the creativity, imagination, communication and entrepreneurship skills, to explore the hidden talents of students, various clubs like, Nature Club, Entrepreneurship Club, Sukriti Art & Craft Club, Natyam Club, Abhivyakti Club, Swaranchal Club, Creative Writing Club and Media Club exist in the college. These clubs conduct various

activities like workshop on theatre, anchoring, creative writing, entrepreneurship skills, business plan, singing, environmental awareness, best out of waste, face painting, etc. the list goes on.

And as result of these activities, I feel proud in informing that we have a vast pool of talents in various literary and cultural events. Dandiya Utsav is celebrated in the campus to enjoy the festival of Navratra with rhythm. Every year Youth Week- Kasturi is the most awaited event for the students of the college and other colleges in which various Intra and Inter college competitions are organized. Other marked annual events of the college are English Play and Dance Drama. In this sequence, this year, Shakespeare's Play "As You Like It" was staged on 30th January 2019 at Jawahar Kala Kendra.

To keep the connect of the students with the culture and tradition of India, college has been a devout associate of Spic Macay. This year Pandit Deepak Maharaj performed Kathak and Assamese Dancer Dr. Meernanda Barthakur performed Satariya Classical Dance in our college.

Like every year, this year also our students actively participated in various activities and competitions of Inter-college events. The college witnessed election of student council on 31st September 2018. Again proud announcement that ours is the only college in the city, conducting election by the indirect method recommended by Lingdoh Committee Ms. Sakshi Tanwar of B. Com Part-III was elected as President and the student union was inaugurated on 11th October 2018 by Shri B.L. Soni, ADG, Police CID CB Jaipur.

Another feature of the Kanoria College is to organize Parent-Teacher Meet which is always overwhelmed by the parents.

We have a strong Alumni Association. Many of our alumni are doing great work in their respective domains and raise the bar of excellence.

Centre for Career Guidance, Training and Placement is committed to provide a successful future and better placement opportunities for the students. The centre organized various interactive session and recruitment drives during the session 2018-19 and around 50 students were selected in campus placement.

To boost up the sight of exploration, the students are offered with excursion, tours and pleasure trips every year.

The college library is rich and technologically uplifted with a collection of about 58000 books, 112 journals and magazines, 14 daily newspapers and Inlibnet, N-List E-Journal where 31,35,000 e-books and 6000 e-journals are accessible, E-Shodh Sindhu. College library is also having membership of National Digital Library. College library is fully computerized. Students can search the location of book in the library on computer by its title/ author publisher. Organising Book-Fair in the college campus is a regular feature of the library. This year, Book-Fair was organized on 28th and 29th August 2018. 10 publishers from the country exhibited their books. Kanoria College has 21

well-equipped laboratories and this year English Language Lab has been inaugurated to build a structured environment for interactive learning.

The campus is actually a green campus with rain water harvesting structures, compost pit, eco-friendly building, solar lights and geysers and this year a solar panel of 75 KW capacity has been installed to generate 80 % of electricity requirement of the campus.

To house 300 students, there are two hostel buildings, well equipped with modern amenities. In campus we are having crèche facility for our staff members.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has been set up as per UGC guidelines to implement, review and update the quality policy of the college and to bring about continuous improvement in teaching learning process and related administrative mechanisms.

Visits by eminent personalities in diverse fields inspire the students, faculty and staff at the institute. Conferences, workshops, etc. on contemporary issues are important activities to stimulate discussions of different areas.

- Ms. Himanshi Rastogi has completed a project with UNISEF Rajasthan on working with Anganbadi with Ministry of Women and Child.

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
