This year's annual report reflects the endeavours initiated in the session 2023-24. During this session, the college strived hard to achieve several milestones in academics and extra-curricular activities. The highlights are as follows-

For the academic session 2023-24, total 5798 students were enrolled for 12 undergraduate and 15 postgraduate courses running in the college. This year College got increase intake in BCA and BBA both. The College offers 22 Skill enhancement certificate courses also to enhance students' employability and to contribute to their personal and professional development. From this session onwards the college implemented the NEP -2020 adopted by the University of Rajasthan, Jaipur. All the students of the college have their Academic Bank of Credit – a unique 12-digit code to digitally store, manage and access all their academic credits.

Our college has attracted good students and they have performed very well in university examinations 2023. The average passing percentage is **90.49%** in undergraduate courses. This year, our college has 100% result in all the semesters of PG courses. I would like to mention with pride that Ms. Manisha Swami of B.Sc. Home Science was awarded **Gold Medal** for securing 1st Position in the University Examinations-2022.

College has received 2 more Fully **funded units from the session 2023-24**, **Now the total units are 4.**

State's 1st Basic Life Support (BLS) Training Center was established in the college on 12 December 2023 in collaboration with WHO CCET, AIMS, New Delhi and Department of Transport & Road Safety, Rajasthan, more then 60 teachers ,500 students and people from the Basti adopted by the college were trained to help the accident victims .
