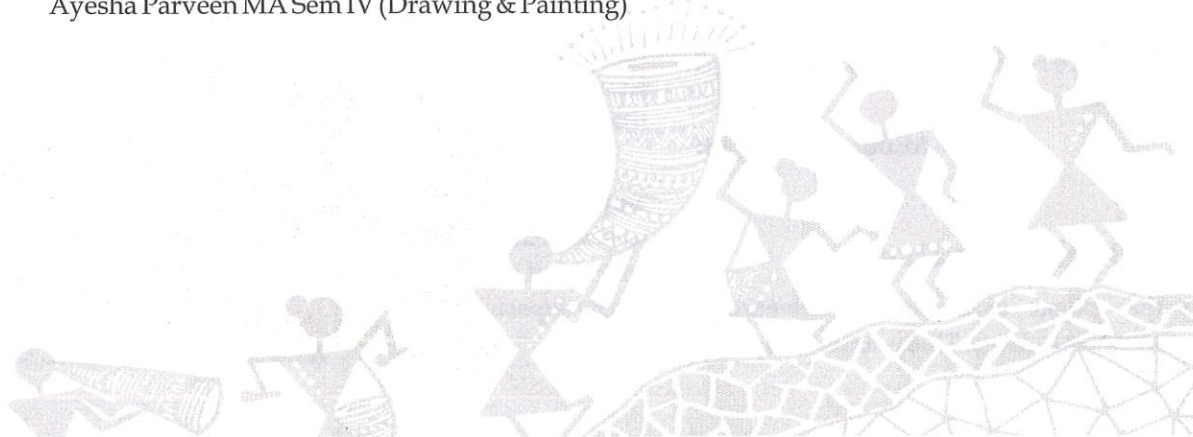

Art Department

The year 2016, in retrospect, could be aptly described as a year utilised to its fullest. It forayed into hitherto unexplored territories.

The students of the Art Department participated in one-day workshop on "Arch Design Dhara Design & Craft Fair" on 30th August. They learnt designing and marketing of various crafts from a wide range of materials-clay, wood, stone, metal to facric. Learning to make metal jewellery, toys and pots on the traditional potter's wheel was a unique experience.

In September, the students participated in a painting competition organised by the Reserve Bank of India and a poster making competition organised by Spandan. The students of Semester III attended Art workshop titled "Vinayaka" organised by Archaeological Department of India at Hawa Mahal which provided them with considerable exposure.

In the same month, one day Art workshop on 28th September on 'How to Use Texture in a Design' was held.

In October a demonstration on the latest techniques of making "Floating Rangoli & Decorative Thali through Hobby Ideas" was conducted. These rangolis and thalis served a dual purpose as they could be used not only for beautifying homes but also could be put up for sale by the students. Also, the students sent their paintings for the 'All India Camlin Painting Competition'.

On 25th November, the department organised a Painting/Poster-making competition under the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan of Government of India. The competition was organised with a purpose to sensitize, create awareness and inculcate a sense of responsibility amongst the students



towards Clean India. Ayesha Parveen of M.A (Drawing & Painting) III Semester won I Prize, Neetu Chanderwariya of M.A (Drawing & Painting) I Semester won II Prize, Sayeed Eram Naaza Ahmed won III prize, Sunny Kumari Choudhary of M.A (Drawing & Painting) I Semester , Aishwarya Rathore of B.A. Part I, Anubha Upadhyaya of B.Com and Akshita Meena of B.A. Part III received consolation prizes.

In December, the students participated in a five day 'Art camp' organised in the memory of Late Shri Mohan Lal Gupta by Ram Gopal Vijayvargiya Trust from 6th to 10th of December. Four paintings of Ayesha Parveen, Tara Kanwar and Sayeed Eram Naza Ahmed were sold in the first ever auction conducted by the aforementioned trust on 10th December. In the same month, under the CSR programme, Dr. Sarika Kaul and the Semester I & III students of the Art Department conducted a two day workshop on "Articles prepared through Paper Mache", from 15th-16th of December at the 'Raghukul Takeaway Heritage Craft' organised by Raghukul Trust at Edify World School, Jaipur. It was attended by approximately 1500 enthusiastic school students who were made aware of the techniques that went into the making of objects from paper mache.

The advent of 2017 brought with it an opportunity for students to display their creativity and learnings through Art Exhibition that was organised during 'Kasturi'; from the 10th to 13th January.

The department conducted a three-day workshop titled Folk Arts of India for the faculty members and students from 25th to 28th January, sponsored by Fevicryl India Ltd. with the focus to promote folk arts such as Madhubani, Kalamkari and Warli paintings.



On 30th January, an extension lecture was delivered by Dr. I.U. Khan, Head of Department, Drawing & Painting, University of Rajasthan and the topic for the same was "Art During the Renaissance Period with Special Reference to the Paintings of Prophets". The lecture facilitated the learning of the students in their quest for knowledge and acquainted them with artists foreign to their own culture, emphasising a cross-cultural approach.

The session with its events and activities broadened the creative horizons of the students. The fact that art has the ability to translate incorporeal abstractions into tangible expressions manifested itself into the awareness of the students throughout the course of the year.

Biotechnology

On 5th July, a one-day workshop under the Faculty Development Program (FDP) was organized wherein, various faculty members visited Seminal Applied Sciences Pvt Ltd, and observed Spirulina Culture Maintenance, Humidifier, BOD incubator, RAPD, Centrifuge, Furnace, Vacuum, Oven, Dry Bath, Spectrophotometer, Western Blot, Electric Sterilizer, Protein Analyzer, Protein gel staining/de-staining and electrophoresis. Faculty members received detailed information on HPLC (High Performance Liquid Chromatography).

On 12th and 13th July, training on instrumentation was conducted under the FDP. Several teachers from the department of Zoology, Chemistry and Botany attended it. Dr. Ranjana Agrawal, HOD, demonstrated the working requisites and applications of various instruments like



colorimeter, cyclometer, spectrophotometer, laminar air flow hood available with the department. The faculties were also made aware of various sterilization techniques and basic lab practices. Overall, the program had an informative

approach with detailed discussions acquainting other departments with basic biotechnology tools, which can be reciprocated by them in academics and research done in their respective departments.

The aim behind the Faculty Development Program (FDP) was to orient the new staff members with the academic culture of the institute as well as current research scenario.

Chemistry

Geography

September. The group was escorted by the team of Camp India, Head Director, Mr. Gaurav Sharma, Everest winner and his team experts and Dr. Neelam Bageshwari. The activity was organized to make students learn and perform flying-fox, river crossing, obstacles, commando net and archery as part of curriculum-disaster perception and management.

On 25th September, the students participated in Cycle Marathon and rally - Jaipur Cycle Marathon organized by Sunrise - an initiative taken by Nupur Sansthan on the occasion of World Heart Day. The objective of the rally was to create awareness and dangers amongst the masses about Lead Toxicity especially for children.

Zoology

Photochemical analysis of the sample was conducted, western blotting and electrophoresis techniques were also studied. The aim was to equip the faculty with latest technologies and help them become competitive in global diagnostics and research environment. In the workshop a lecture on wetlands and their importance by Shri Sajal Jugran and Dr. Soumana Datta followed by a field visit to Chandlai Lake was organized in which 100 students and faculty members participated. The workshop proved to be very informative and helped the students in understanding the importance of wetlands.

The activities round the year not only proved to be informative but also enhanced the skills of students.

Social Sciences Association

With the idea of promoting community awareness and welfare among the students, Social Science Association launched the Community Connect Program for the session 2016-17. The purpose of the program was to provide

students with a platform wherein they could implement what they've learnt in the classroom. The programme helped students to understand their own competence level, leading to more self-confidence and a can-do attitude that would add to their work and academic pursuits.

On 13th August, a lecture on "Emotional Intelligence" was delivered by Mr. Urukram Sharma. He emphasized on the significance of self-awareness in realizing one's own potential and the role emotional intelligence can play in its development and enhancement.

A three-day workshop on "Conflict Resolution" was organized from 14th to 17th October in collaboration with Department of Lifelong Learning, University of Rajasthan. The purpose of the workshop was to transform one's perception from negative to a positive one.

Research has shown that individuals who participate in volunteering have better physical and mental health than those who do not; with a similar purpose in mind the Association also initiated Celebration of Diwali with slum and street children on 22nd October 2016. The teachers along with a team of 15 students took part in various activities such as drawing and painting, craft and games with the slum



children. The students also donated several gifts, clothes and sweets to the underprivileged children.

The Association with the purpose of promoting the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, a Government of India initiative, and to popularize the concept of cleanliness and sanitation organized a lecture on 7th December 2016. The lecture was delivered by Sh. S.N Singh (Retd. I.A.S officer) and Director of Swachh Nagar Sansthan, Jaipur. Sh. Singh in his lecture

emphasized on the relevance of hygiene and encouraged the students not only to concentrate on individual aspect but also social aspect of "being clean".

On 15th December, the association in collaboration with the First India News Channel organized a televised debate on the topic "Women Safety and Security after Nirbhaya: Changes and Effects". The 'For' side was led by Ms. Suman Sharma, Chairperson of State Women's Commission while the 'Against' side was led by Ms Archana Sharma, prominent female leader from State Congress Party. The need was felt to break the culture of silence in the families, treating both sons and daughters on an equal footing. Proper and timely implementation of rules, spreading awareness among men and bringing the offenders to book in time will help a long way in eradication of such crimes. It was concluded that the change is definitely on the threshold of making an entry. It can only be brought about successfully by the cooperation and contribution by all of us.

The Community Connect Program prominently pointed out that community service opens students to a wealth of networking opportunities, allowing them to build new relationships within their community. The Association also organized the SAMVIDHAAN -LIVE, project in collaboration with Pravah, Jaipur. This activity based project helped students to develop a constitutional report card and recommendations or changes in the national constitution would be shared nationwide with the President, Governor and various civil society representatives. The project will be followed by an Urban Volunteering Program with various NGOs of Jaipur to build the student's understanding of self and society.

The discussion program created much interest among students and it also helped them to think about a subject in a comprehensive way.

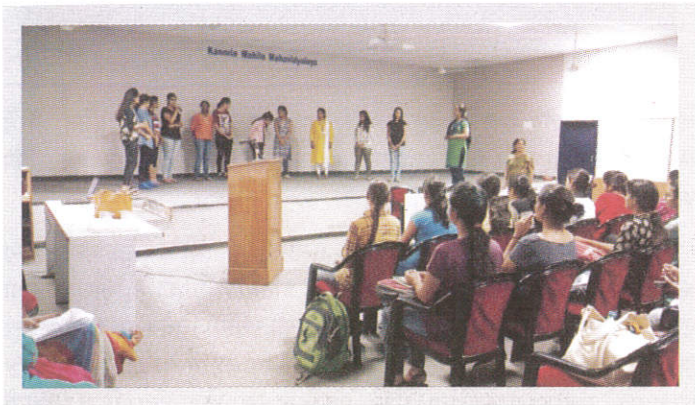

Career and Placement Cell

Career and Placement Cell at Kanoria offers various opportunities to the students to enhance their communication skills, enrich their personalities and find openings through our diverse range of placements for their career development conducted by the cell. Session 2016-17, no less witnessed the same.

Digitalk Advertising Pvt. Ltd., Jaipur, visited the campus for telecallers and marketing services; Teleperformance and Aayat Softech Pvt. Ltd. for business analyst, Android developers and Genpact for customer service, banking and financial roles.

Under Career Cell, interactive sessions were organized on 'Grooming and Etiquette' by Ms. Shruti (Grace Academy), 'How to Crack Interviews' by Shri Vipin Garg (IAS) and a Talk by the Youth Wing of CII. A three-week workshop on 'Employability Skills Enhancement' was

Seminar on Partition Narrative : Trauma, Memory and Representation

Kanoria PG Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Jaipur organized a one-day seminar on 'The Partition Narrative : Trauma, Memory and Representation' on 10th of December, 2016. The inaugural session started with a welcome address by Ms. Meenakshi Tyagi, Vice-Principal of the college. Dr. Deeptima Shukla, the organizing secretary of the seminar introduced the theme of the seminar. 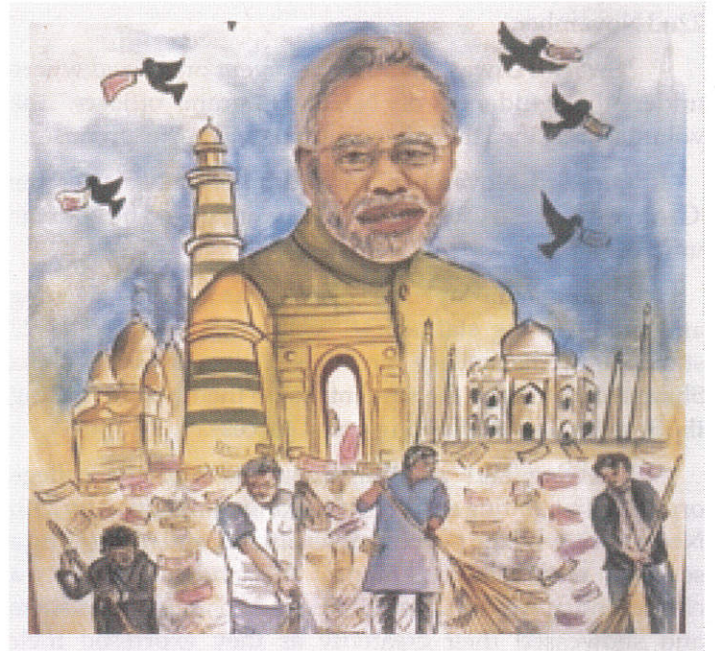

विधिक जागरूकता शिविर

राजस्थान महिला आयोग तथा कानोडिया पीजी महिला महाविद्यालय, जयपुर के संयुक्त तत्वावधान में 12 सितम्बर को विधिक जागरूकता शिविर का आयोजन किया गया।

इसके अन्तर्गत राज्य महिला आयोग की अध्यक्ष, श्रीमती सुमन शर्मा, सदस्य, श्रीमती रीटा भार्गव तथा अभिवक्ता नम्रता श्रेया भी उपस्थित थीं।



श्रीमती रीटा भार्गव ने कहा कि विधिक जागरूकता मंच के माध्यम से राज्य महिला आयोग द्वारा महिलाओं को उनके अधिकारों के प्रति सजग करने में सफलता मिली है।

श्रीमती सुमन शर्मा ने बताया कि कानून एक ऐसा विषय है जिसे पढ़ने में जज व वकीलों को तो मजा आता है, लेकिन आम जनता कानून से दूरी बनाए रखती है। यद्यपि कानून हमारी ताकत है तथापि 80 प्रतिशत लोग कानून की पूरी जानकारी नहीं रखते। बड़े-बड़े आईपीएस, आईएएस अधिकारी भी कानून की कई जानकारीयों से अनभिज्ञ हैं। आयोग से जुड़ने के बाद ही उन्हें भी कई नये कानूनों की जानकारी मिली।

महिला सुरक्षा के लिए बने कानून, धारा 354 की भी उन्होंने विस्तृत जानकारी दी। धारा 354 महिला के लिए एक आत्मरक्षा शस्त्र है जिसका उपयोग कर पीड़ित महिला स्वयं को शोषण से बचा सकती है। साथ ही महिलाओं को यदि कानून का ज्ञान हो तो समाज में होने वाली विभिन्न कुरीतियों जैसे बाल-विवाह, कन्या भ्रूण हत्या आदि का डटकर सामना किया जा सकता है। सहारा मांगना बन्द कर महिलाओं को अपने सम्मान की रक्षा स्वयं करनी चाहिए तभी बढ़ते हुए अपराधों को रोका जा सकता है।

उन्होंने जानकारी साझा की कि महिला आयोग द्वारा जल्द ही एक 'एप' भी शुरू किया जायेगा, जिसकी मदद से हम किसी भी विपरीत परिस्थिति में आत्म रक्षा कर सकेंगे। इस एप में 3 नम्बर दर्ज होंगे : 1. पुलिस स्टेशन 2. माता-पिता का 3. मित्र का। मोबाईल को तीन बार थपथपाते ही यह एप एक्टिवेट हो जाएगा तथा इसकी सहायता से परिजन एवं मित्र हमें खोज सकेंगे। छात्राओं व शिक्षिकाओं की इस अभियान में सक्रिय सहभागिता को उन्होंने सराहा।

अभिवक्ता नम्रता श्रेया ने मूल एवं प्रक्रियात्मक कानून के बारे में जानकारी दी और बताया कि संविधान सभी कानूनों की जननी है। महिलाओं को प्रतिदिन अखबार पढ़ना चाहिये ताकि वे स्वयं से सम्बन्धित अत्याचार व अन्य गतिविधियों का आंकलन कर सकें। हम महिलाएँ सर्वप्रथम इंसान हैं और हमें इस समझ को विकसित करना होगा। महिला कानूनों को गहराई से समझकर, स्वयं के उत्थान के लिए महिलाओं को ही आगे आना होगा चाहे वे मुस्लिम या हिन्दू या दलित हो। रोकथाम एवं निषेध कानून के बीच के अन्तर को भी उन्होंने गूढ़ता से स्पष्ट किया। हम जन्म से मृत्यु पर्यन्त एक कानून से जुड़े हुए हैं। अतः हमें कानून के प्रति सजग व प्रतिबद्ध होना चाहिए।

अन्त में प्रश्नोत्तरी कार्यक्रम हुआ, जिसमें छात्राओं ने उत्साहपूर्वक भाग लिया तथा महिलाओं से जुड़े विभिन्न पहलुओं पर ज्ञानवर्धन किया।

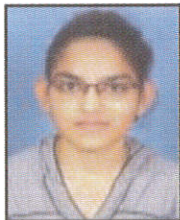

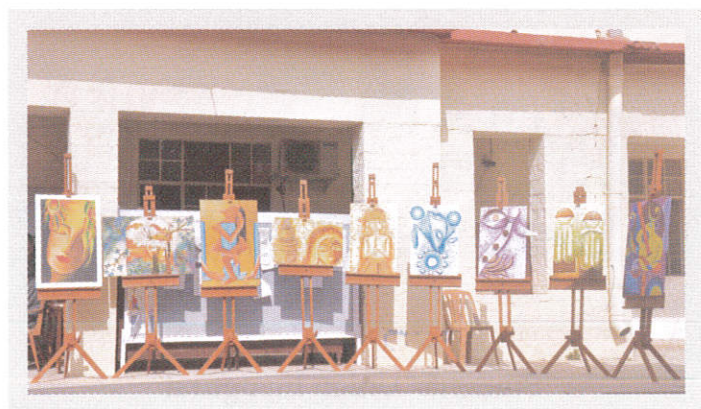

At Lonavala, the students spent some leisure time at



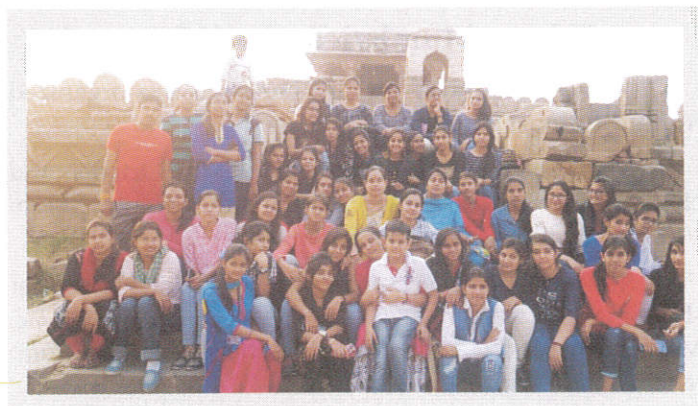

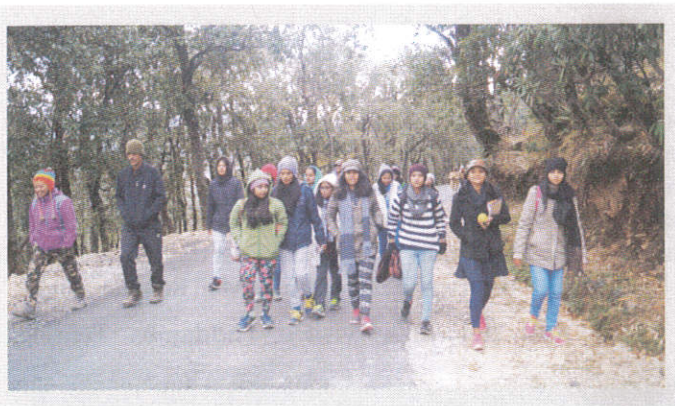

Certificate Course in Organic Farming

College is conducting a certificate course in organic farming in collaboration with Morarka Foundation since last four years wherein not only college students but also outside students enroll themselves.

The course is a fine blend of theory and practical work suitably designed to demonstrate theoretical concepts and compliment with hands on practice. The classes were held for one hour per week as an add-on course. The students learned about production of organic manure and pesticides, vermi-composting, tray cultivation, herbal sprays, certification of organic produce, marketing strategies and quarantine processes etc.

To demonstrate the full spectrum of the benefits, a field visit to the facility, owned and operated by Morarka Foundation at Sitapura, was also organised. They offered internship to the interested students.
