On 10th September, the Humanities Association joined the Social Sciences Students' Discussion Group which organized the screening of the movie 'Peepli Live' under the title 'How to read a film as text?'. Dr. Shivam, Department of Sociology, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur was the moderator on this occasion and explained how to interpret a film as a text. After the movie, the session was open for discussion. Dr. Deepa Pandey exemplified the caste discrimination prevalent in society since prehistoric times through reading of beautiful Sanskrit compositions. Ms. Simantini R. Raghava emphasized the need to change the mindset of people to overcome these issues. Dr. Rekha Gupta pointed out the condition of educated Dalits who are still victims of the system due to poor governance and administration policies.

On 10th December, the students and faculty members of the Humanities Association joined the one day seminar organized in the college on 'Partition Narratives: Trauma, Memory and Representation' where both faculty and students presented papers on related issues.

Life Sciences Association

The association provides opportunity of learning beyond the classroom to the students of Botany, Zoology and Biotechnology. First meeting of the association was held on 30th August 2017 on "Recycling of Waste Paper" by Dr. Sunita Chauhan from Kumarappa National Handmade Paper Institute, Sanganer, Jaipur. She explained the steps of waste paper recycling like shredding, bioenzymatic pulping, bleaching etc. by power point presentation. She emphasized the need for eco-friendly technology which will eventually reduce the felling of trees and consequently help in the forest conservation.

As the use of laboratories is mandatory for all the science students, the second meeting was held on "Good laboratory practices and biosafety rules" on 28th September. by the resource person Dr. Nidhi Gupta, senior scientist from IIS university Jaipur. She explained that "Good laboratory practices" is an organisational process by which study is planned and performed in the laboratory. This originated in USA where the World Health Organisation has laid down some rules which have to be implemented so that the researchers do not become victims of bioterrorism, that is exposure to infections by pathogens and chemicals, and biohazards, which includes exposure to virus infected tissues.

On 1st November, Dr. Joy Gardener from "Hope and beyond", a non-government organisation delivered an interesting and informative lecture on "Snakes of Rajasthan", which is dedicated to the conservation of wildlife. With the aid of beautiful pictures he explained about snakes and snake-bite management and myths about snakes. He informed the students that there are 3000 species of snakes and only 15% are venomous. Eryx, Sand

Boa, Hydrophis and Cobra are some of the important snakes found in Rajasthan.

As its last meeting, a two-day National seminar was organised by the association on "**Innovative approaches in biosciences**", in collaboration with NABARD and Indian Science Congress Association, Jaipur chapter, on 15th and 16th December.

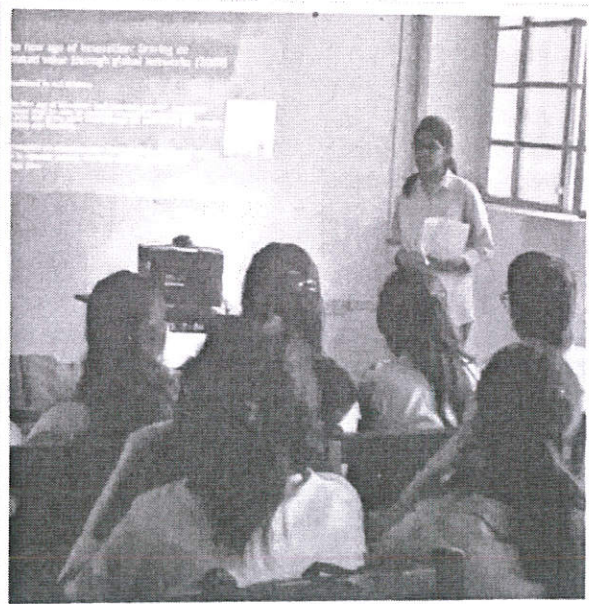

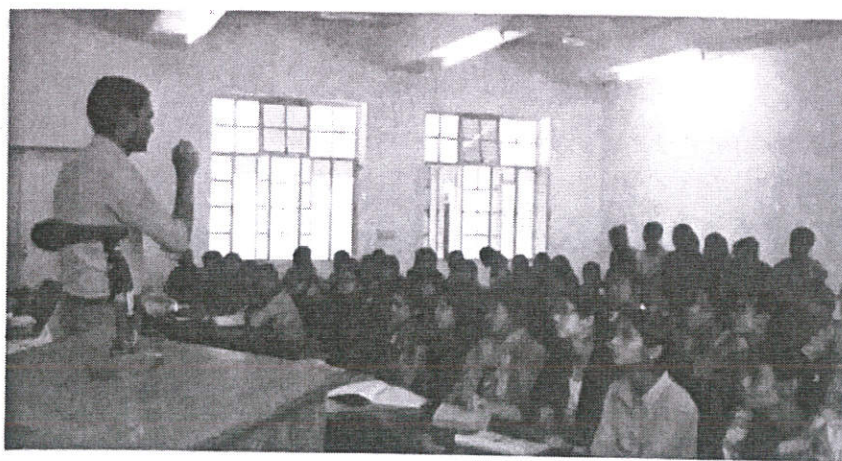

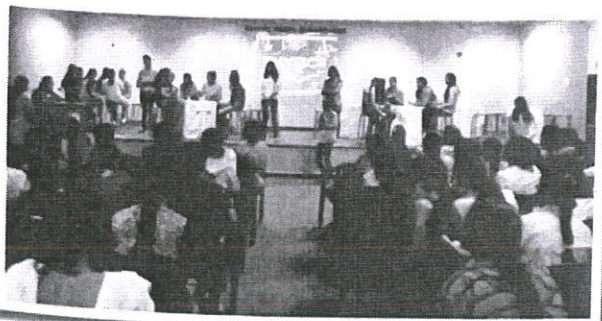

A quiz was also conducted during this workshop.

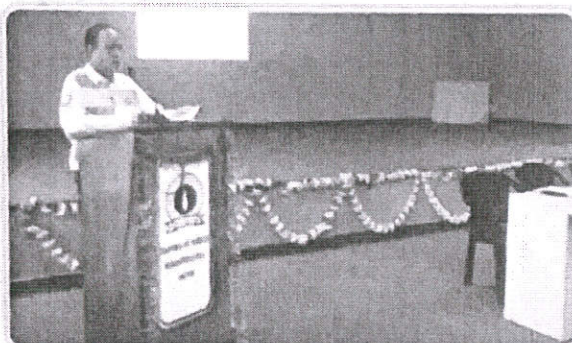

An industrial visit to 'Triveni Pumps, Kaladera' was organized on 2nd November 2018 in order to give the practical exposure & know-how of industries to the students.

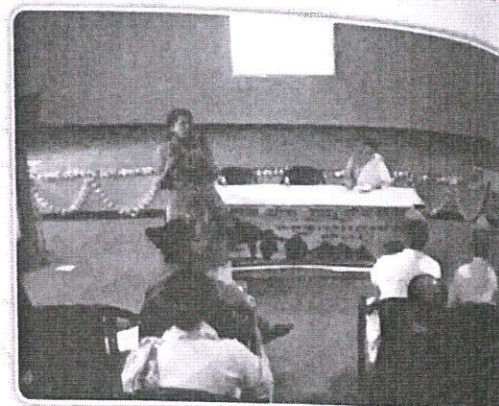

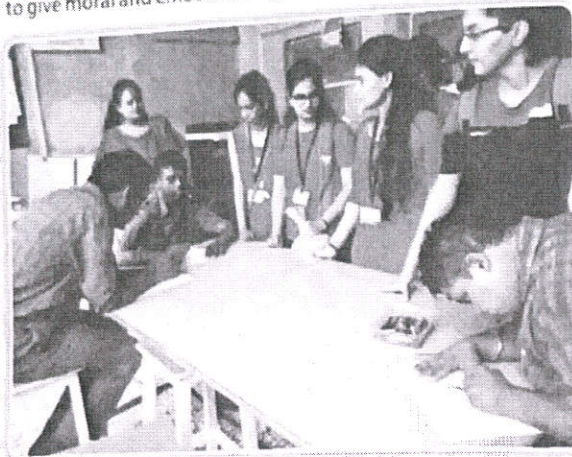

DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICS

The session 2018-19 was welcomed by the department with great enthusiasm and excitement because a feather was added in the hat of the department with the opening of Post-Graduation course in Physics. With the aim of enlightening the students and to widen their scope of knowledge, various activities were organized by the department in this academic year. The very first activity of the department was the orientation session to familiarize M.Sc. Students with the department and the colleges curricular and co-curricular activities. In order to build up the understanding of instruments and components used in the lab, a one day workshop on 'Role of Instrumentation in Physics' was organized on 9th August. Prof. Y. K. Vijay from VGU, Jaipur emphasized on the effect of radiations and fundamentals of semiconductors and their properties. He also demonstrated the working and application of transformer, rectifier in various electrical devices along with hands on training on the measurement of AC and DC voltages, uses of CRO and diode. Prof. Y. C. Sharma explained the basics of CRO, its working and various applications. A PPT presentation



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on laboratory experiments was organized on September 26-28 for students providing a platform to enhance their communication skills and for a better understanding of the subject. An interactive session on 'First Aid and Basic Life Support' was organized on October 15, 2018 for all PG students from Science stream and the laboratory staff. It was conducted by Ms. Bindu Rathore and Ms. Dimplepreet Kaur from Fortis hospital, Jaipur. Students participated very enthusiastically and volunteered to work on the dummy to learn the techniques. Dr. Usha Bhatia, HoD, Physics emphasized upon the importance of learning such life saving techniques.



The working models were related to various devices we use in our daily life like water alarm, security alarm, cell phone detector, metal detector, battery charger, hydropower plant, types of motion etc. Topic of poster presentation was "Is there Physics outside your classroom and lab too?". An extension lecture on "Quantum Mechanics: The Weird Science" was also held on December 5. Further, to provide a platform to students, working model and poster presentation competitions were organized on December 5. The eminent speaker Dr. Anupama Upadhyay from Government Ram Chandra Khaitan Polytechnic College, Jaipur delivered very enlightening lecture, which clarified why do we need Quantum Mechanics. She explained the eloquently weirdness in the nature of Quantum Mechanics. Students were benefitted by the lecture. The department also organized the National Graduate Physics Examination (IAPT) on January 20, 2019 for the UG students.

DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH

The department has always been a front-runner in organizing enriching educational activities for students. The first activity of academic session 2018-19 was a visit to Jawahar Kala Kendra (JKK) on 30th July to attend the exhibition that traced the evolution of aesthetics in Indian textiles through the years. Curated by Mayank Mansingh Kaul and designed by Reha Sodhi, this exhibition presented textiles under broader themes of The National Movement, Khadi, the Impact of European-Colonial Encounter in the early to mid 20th century; the engagement with International Modernism from the 1950s till today; an intense revival period in village-based crafts and textiles beginning with the 1970s which has informed the present ecology of urban design; the negotiation of roles between artisans- craftspeople, designers and artists; a return to historical vocabularies from the 1980s onwards which moulds contemporary fashion and mass consumerism; textiles as a means and metaphor for sculpture; as well as Indian minimalism.



In the month of September, the students and teachers went to watch the film 'Manto' directed by Nandita Das and starring Nawazuddin Sidique. The film is a poignant portrayal of the illustrious writer Sadat Hasan Manto and the impact of the 1947 Partition on his life. The film gave the students an insight into one of the most traumatic periods of Indian history: The Partition.

In October, two Extension Lectures were organized by the department. The first lecture was on 'Indian Women's Writing'. The resource person for the lecture was Dr. Mini Nanda, Former Head and Associate Professor, Department of English, UOR. The lecture illuminated various concerns of Indian Women Writers with special focus on Amar Jiban by Rassundari Devi. Prof. Basant Jaitley delivered the second lecture on 'Natyashastra and Theory of Rasa.' It was a two lecture series aimed at familiarizing the students with aesthetics of Indian Drama.

The department added another feather in its cap by inaugurating the Language Lab on 16th October to promote the learning of languages. Dr. Rajul Bhargava, Former Head, Department of English, UOR and a linguist of repute was the chief guest for the occasion.

The students were taken to another educational visit to the JKK in November 2018. They visited the first edition of the India Ceramics Triennale which celebrated the variety and possibilities of ceramics. Students became acquainted with the manner in which contemporary social reality was depicted using ceramic art. The department also conducted a PTM for PG students which offered a platform for healthy interaction between teachers and faculty.



A workshop on Web Designing was organised by Eonius Solutions Pvt. Ltd. in the month of September. Around 50 students of BCA along with two faculty members visited the hub and they got to know about various latest technologies like robotic movements, neuro Sensor, VR technology, Augmented Reality, Artificial intelligence, Visual reality etc. The Visit was an amazing experience and made students aware about augmented and virtual reality concept. This session not only covered theoretical information about IoT but also provided practical knowledge on the same. To the student's surprise, firstly they were asked to fill a questionnaire form related with IoT to check the knowledge of the students then they began with a presentation covering all terms related to IoT and its architecture. It dealt with various stages like Sensors/ Actuators, Data Acquisition System, Edge Analysis, and the Core Analysis. They also cleared the basic term 'smart device' and provided numerous example of its application in day-to-day life. In the practical session, Mr. Gautam gave a live example of linking our own voice command to a device and turning it into smart device. He also taught the students to create a program using Arduino software and configured an LED bulb to it. He connected Alexa and by using his voice command, instructed to turn on and off the bulb. That fabulous illustration brought an end to the seminar.

To unveil the talent of the students a power point presentation competition was organised on 18th December for the BCA first year students. They presented their presentations on various interesting topics like Humanoid Robots, Devops, Smart TV, Networking Era, 3-D Printing, and Virtual Reality etc. It was overall a great learning experience for students. 20 नवम्बर को आगवतुल रामानंद सरस्वती विश्वविद्यालय के अनुसंधान केंद्र के निदेशक डॉ. राजेश मिश्र ने भाषा का शुद्ध स्वरूप एवं व्याकरण विषय पर व्याख्यान देते हुए बताया कि भाषाभाषाभाषा अर्थात् भाषा बोलने से आती है जो इसके शुद्ध स्वरूप को जानना निम्नकारणों से आवश्यक है—

आपने बताया कि जिस अर्थ को हम कहना चाहते हैं, वह यदि पूरी भाषा अभिव्यक्त न हो, तो वह वाक्य शुद्ध नहीं है। संरचना अर्थात् अर्थ की दृष्टि से भाषा में अशुद्धियाँ हो सकती हैं और इसी पर ध्यान देकर हम भाषा को शुद्ध स्वरूप को जान सकते हैं तथा अपने समावेश को प्रभावी बना सकते हैं। भाषा को संरचना और व्याकरण (नियमों) के द्वारा जाना जा सकता है, लेकिन बोलचाल एवं साहित्यिक भाषा में अंतर होता है।

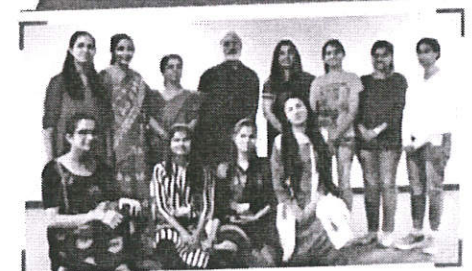

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DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH

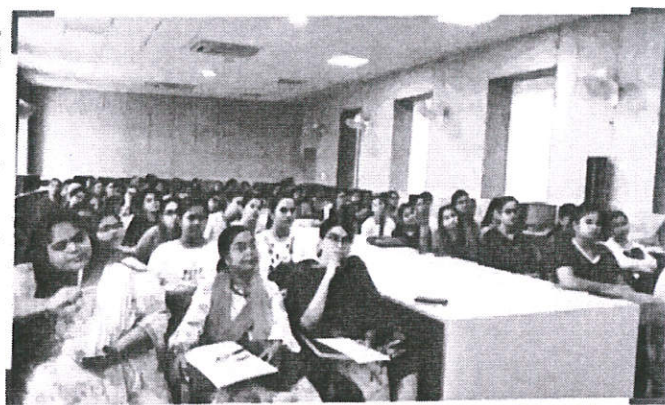
The department conducts various activities like guest lectures, visits, classroom discussions and activities for undergraduate and postgraduate students to make the subject interesting.

The students gained the understanding of various experiments like Microwave diffraction, LCR Transmission circuit, Barton Pendulum on the first day of the visit. On the second day, Prof. Y. K. 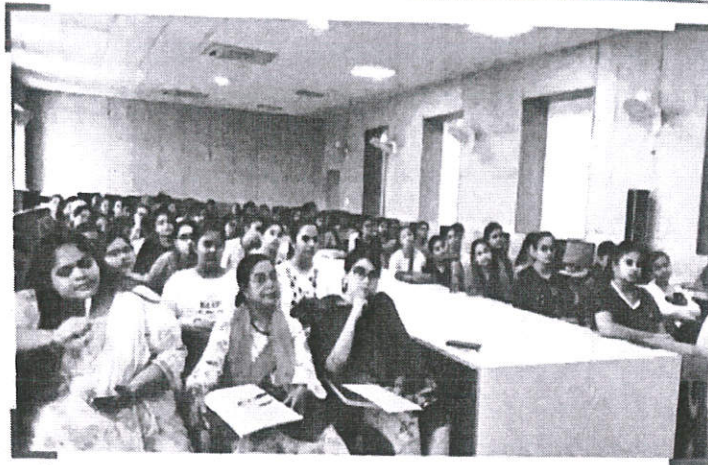
In this session also our students appeared for the National Graduated Physics Examination 2020 organised by Indian Association of Physics Teachers, for which our college is a registered center.

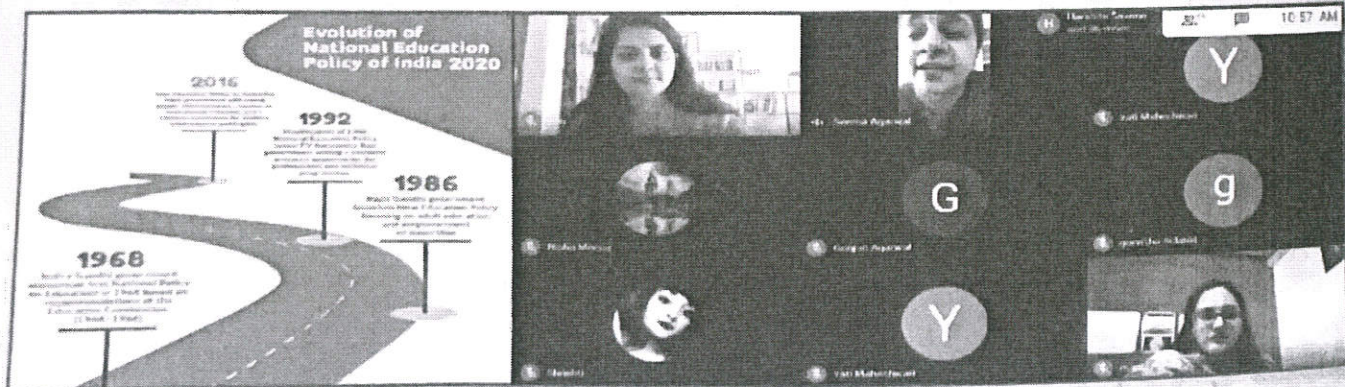

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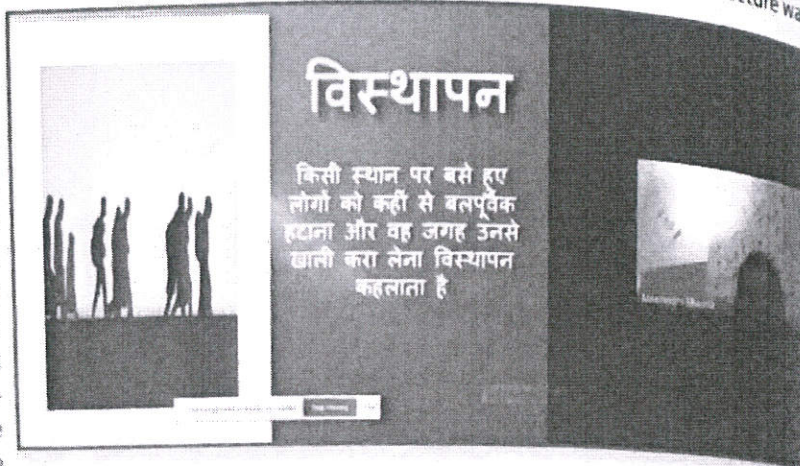
DEPARTMENT OF SOCIOLOGY

Participants were exposed to the recent theoretical studies and about the latest techniques in nuclear spectroscopy with live demonstrations and also through videos. A total of 176 participants from various educational institutes registered themselves in this workshop. The workshop highlighted the perception of nuclear spectroscopy from fundamental aspects to applications in wide ranging interdisciplinary areas, followed by imparting a rigorous insight on the proficient use of various spectroscopy techniques.

A departmental Faculty Development Programme on Microwave Experiments was organised on 28 February 2020. Prof. R.K. Khanna, Retired Professor from Jhalawar College was invited as an eminent speaker to interact with faculty members. Prof. Khanna is a well known experimentalist in the field of Electronics and Communication. He explained the basics of microwave and X-Bench in a very lucid way. 10 faculty members of the department were benefited by this session.

Covid-19 pandemic has changed education dramatically, with the distinctive rise of e-learning, whereby teaching is undertaken remotely and on digital platforms. 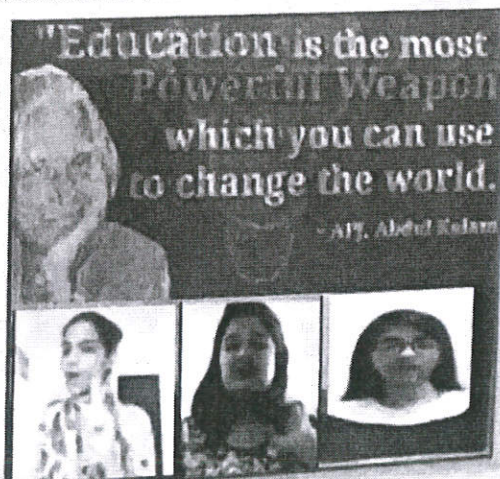

The enthusiasm of the students was revealed in the celebration of Dr. Kalam's birthday. They expressed their feelings through speeches and poems describing not only his life history but also his achievements in the betterment of the Nation.

As radiation is all around us- without it we would not exist. Moreover, radiation has become a part of our day to day life in the form of mobile handsets and microwave ovens. Yet the word has become synonymous with danger and disaster. So now the question arises how safe we are with the radiation. In view of this, Professor Deepak Bhatnagar in his deliberation very well explained about the risk factors and precautionary treatments to be employed in order to prevent the hazardous effects of microwave radiations.

The creativity and ideas to resolve the particular topic related to the present scenario of life were artistically presented through and captured in posters. There was an air of excitement and enthusiasm during the poster slideshow amongst 62 students as eager and committed participants from all over India toiled to create masterpieces. It was a splendid show of masterstrokes by our young and talented students. The aim of this competition was not merely to see the creative aspect but also to trigger the thought process of the



students and sensitize them towards these burning & serious issues. The final judgment was made by two honourable judges Prof. Deepak Bhatnagar and Dr. Charu Goyal, Head, Department of English. Three best entries were given a cash prize of Rupees 500/- as Shrashti Kumawat from Kanoria College, Shrishti Ravishankar from Vidyapeeth Institute of Technology, Surat and Bhawana Bisht from Banasthali Vidyapeeth.

Dr. Deepti Chauhan thanked the participants for sharing knowledge and innovative ideas and utilizing their valuable time during the pandemic Covid-19. She also thanked our esteemed chief guest and Principal Madam who graced the occasion by their presence all the time during the event.

Powerpoint presentations by PG students on 1 and 2 December 2020 were organised virtually with the objective as presentation is a channel for students not only to share with others what they have learned but also to learn how to express themselves. It provides them a chance to challenge and expand on their understanding of the topic by having others ask questions. With this object, different topics were allotted to the groups of total 38 PG SEM-III students. The presentations of students were highly appreciable and encouraging.



Every group was bombarded with questions after the presentations which were handled quite tactfully by the students. Prior to the announcement of winners, the HOD, Dr. Usha Bhatia gave her comments and words of wisdom to the students so as to further improve their presentations and take it to a higher level. It was very motivating to hear her. Overall it was a great learning experience for everyone. The best three group presentations and individual presentations were awarded. According to the students' feedback, they felt an incredible increment in their confidence.

Online Survey in the form of a quiz was organised for UG Part-I students through which some serious questions related to post Covid-19 life were framed in a very interesting manner in order to teach them lessons to live life to the fullest. Total 63 students explained their opinion with full confidence and integrity. A few videos depicting important laws of Physics were also shown to them and they were asked to co-relate the results with their life.

Two series of extension lectures were organised by the department of Physics for PG students during this session. First series of lectures was conducted on Hydrogen Energy from 6 to 9 January, 2021. Dr. Rini Singh from Graduate School of Advanced Science & Engineering, Hiroshima University, Japan, was presided over as a guest speaker. In introduction Dr. Rini briefly reflected on the basics of Hydrogen energy i.e. why we need hydrogen energy and what are the uses of it? Dr. Rini Singh delved deep into the topic of production of hydrogen energy, hydrogen as a fuel cell, use of hydrogen in automobile industries and safety issues with series and resolved the queries of the students. Overall the lecture series was very informative and 35 students benefited from it.

Second series of lectures was conducted on 'Introduction to Advanced Quantum Mechanics' from 21 to 23 December 2020 by Dr. Dinesh Kumar from University of Rajasthan. He is an eminent scholar with his doctorate degree in Theoretical High Energy Physics from Indian Institute of Technology, Bombay, India and has accredited more than 15 research papers in various national and international journals. Starting with a brief review on Quantum Mechanics, he covered almost the whole of Advanced Quantum Mechanics. Total 36 PG students attended this series of lectures.

Like every year, this year also the National Graduate Physics examination was conducted for UG students on 24 January, 2021. Total 5 UG students appeared in this examination. 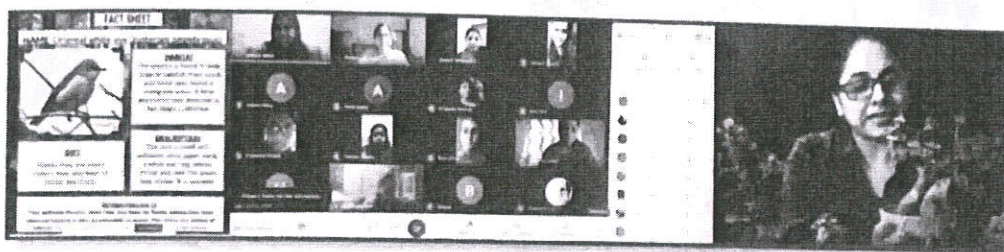
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LIFE SCIENCES ASSOCIATION

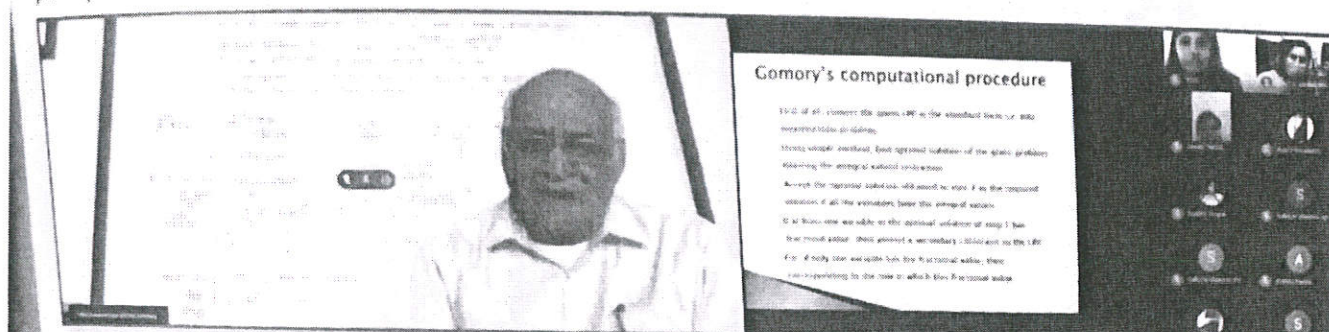
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DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICS AND STATISTICS
