Dear Kanorians,

Its a pleasure to be sharing some of my memories with you of the long and varied association I have had with this institution. It was born soon after I came to Jaipur and a couple of fresh graduates joined its faculty. I knew some of the teachers and both Miss Prabhu and Miss Terway were frequent visitors at the Sunderams. And thus we met pretty often, learning to share and discuss our ideas.

It was later when the college had shifted to its present building that I was invited to give Extension Lectures. I remember a three-day series I gave on George Eliot. The tea in the canteen thereafter was a pleasant experience. Then there was a two-day workshop on American Literature and I made a presentation on Steinbeck. Professor R K Kaul teased me on being able to fit in different areas but the learning, the exposure, the confidence I gained out of them was what really motivated me. Believe me, those who come to you are as much beneficiaries as you. Learning is a two-way process and scholarship, learning, professional integrity do not grow in closed worlds.

Kanoria College has given us many brilliant students, Devika Menon, one of them made some beautiful sketches for us, one of them was on the world of Paradise Lost. Those were the days my friend ...

Soon after we joined the University of Rajasthan in 1961/62 Ms. Krishna Kumari Terway and Ms. Hemalata Prabhu of the Maharani's College befriended us. Ms. Terway taught Hindi, was a sober, steadfast person. Ms. Prabhu taught English and was involved in many extra-curricular activities and a very creative person. You could not find two women who were more each other's opposites. What bound them together then and through the rest of their lives was their deep commitment to women's education and their abilities to run an institution well.

When the Kanoria Trust decided to open a private college in Jaipur, both these ladies were the obvious choice to head this new venture. It was a great challenge for them to admit students with very low performance in their school examinations. It must have been May 1964 that the Poddar School for the Deaf and Dumb on the corner of what is now called Police Memorial provided them rooms to get ready for the 1964-65 session with arts subjects. On a lovely morning in July we were present under a shamiana to inaugurate the college. On the annual day next year "hope" had been transformed into "determination". The students performed 'The Crucible' in English, the examination results were good and the future looked bright.

Kanoria College remained close to us, only because it was just opposite the University, but our daughter Maya studied there, I was associated with certain programmes of student counseling and career development and had the privilege to be a board member once. For several years I worked closely with Ms. Terway at Campus Nursery School and with Ms. Prabhu in the women's movement.

In later years the college has grown phenomenally under equally capable leadership and with committed staff. Many alumnae are in very good positions and the present students are continuously adding to its very strong foundations.

Congratulations to all for this Golden Jubilee.


















कानोड़िया महिला महाविद्यालय के स्वर्ण जयन्ती वर्ष में प्रकाशित होने वाली स्मारिका के लिए अपने अनुभवों को बाँटने का महाविद्यालय का अनुरोध मुझे खुशी तो प्रदान कर रहा है किन्तु असमंजस में हूँ कहाँ से शुरू करूँ ? क्या लिखूँ ? स्मृतियों और अनुभवों की पोटली इतनी ठसाठस भरी है कि खोलते ही बिखर गई है, उसे तारतम्य में समेटना जैसे वश से बाहर लग रहा है।

महाविद्यालय में खुलने के प्रथम दिन से नियुक्त होना मेरे लिए बहुत ही सुखद और दायित्व भरा था। राजस्थान विश्वविद्यालय से सम्बद्ध महारानी कॉलेज में उप प्राचार्या मिस कृष्णा तर्वे की सामाजिक सरोकारिता ने इस महाविद्यालय के विचार को जन्म दिया और स्वर्गीय श्री भागीरथ जी कानोड़िया ने इसे मूर्तरूप प्रदान किया।

एक वर्ष बीता भी नहीं कि महाविद्यालय में शैक्षणिक के साथ खेल-कूद, वाद-विवाद, निबन्ध, कहानी लेखन जैसी शैक्षणिक गतिविधियाँ भी आरम्भ हो गई।

प्राचार्या जी हमारे महाविद्यालय के कार्यों को ही नहीं देखती थी बल्कि सभी शैक्षणिक, अशैक्षणिक कर्मचारियों की व्यक्तिगत और पारिवारिक समस्याओं का भी उन्हें पूरा ध्यान रहता था। मेरा घर कुछ वर्ष बाद बना। निर्माण के दौरान देखभाल के लिए धूप में अधिक रहने से मरी त्वचा पर जो प्रभाव पड़ा उसे देखकर उन्होंने एक दिन कह ही दिया – ऐसा लगता है तुमने सारे मजदूर हटा कर स्वयं ही काम करना शुरू कर दिया है। उसी वर्ष मेरी संस्कृत की शिष्या ने विश्वविद्यालय में सर्वोच्च अंक प्राप्त किये, प्रोत्साहन की सीमा यह थी कि मिस तर्वे मेरे घर आई, बधाई देकर उन्होंने कहा तुम तो भूत की तरह काम करती हो। उनका यह अपनत्व मेरे लिये बहुत बड़ा पुरस्कार था। कभी–कभी कार्य के दौरान मतभेद होने से थोड़ा सा तनाव भी महसूस होता था पर वह सब क्षणिक था। कुल मिलाकर तो आनन्द की अनुभूति ही रहती थी। प्राध्यापिकाओं का आपसी वार्तालाप, कॉलेज में लॉन में बैठकर स्टेज की सीढ़ियों पर बैठकर पी जाने वाली चाय और हँसी के ठहाके अब भी कानों में गूँजते हैं।

नाटकों के मंचन में उप प्राचार्या मिस प्रभु का कोई सानी नहीं था। उनकी प्रेरणा और अथक परिश्रम सभी को कड़ी मेहनत के लिये प्रेरित करता, यहाँ तक कि नाटकों के रिहर्सल और मंचन की तैयारी में देर हो जाने पर वे प्राध्यापिकाओं के लिए भी अपने घर से खाना बना कर लातीं।

इस सबके बावजूद कभी छोटी-मोटी नोक-झोंक और मतभेद भी होते थे कुछ उखाड़-पछाड़ भी अपने कार्यकाल की समाप्ति से पूर्व मैंने देखी, यह मुझे संसार को दार्शनिक दृष्टि से देखने की प्रेरणा देता है। यह संसार त्रिगुणात्मक है। समय और परिस्थिति एक गुण को जब उभार देती है, दूसरे दब जाते है पर अन्तत: विवेक सब को जगा ही देता है तभी तो आज महाविद्यालय अपनी स्वर्ण जयन्ती की इबारत स्वर्ण अक्षरों में लिख रहा है। विश्वास है इसकी हीरक जयन्ती भी बेमिसाल होगी। पुन: सबको बधाई एवं शुभाकामनायें।

क्या भूलूँ क्या याद कर्ने!

60 के दशक में जब मैंने महाविद्यालय में पढ़ाना शुरू किया तब, कॉलेज में पढ़ाना अत्यधिक सम्मान का विषय होता था। उच्च शिक्षा संस्थान सीमित थे तथा शिक्षा संबंधित कार्य, विशेषत: स्त्री शिक्षा संबन्धी कार्यो को

सम्मानित माना जाता था। मन में विचित्र उत्साह होता था कि हम युवा लड़िकयों में शिक्षा द्वारा सामाजिक चेतना लाएंगे। उल्लेखनीय है, तब अधिकांश छात्राएं कॉलेज में आने वाली प्रथम पीढ़ी थी। जिनकी माताओं के लिए लड़िकयों की उच्च शिक्षा नवीन अनुभव था।

वर्तमान भवन कॉलेज की स्थापना के दो वर्ष पश्चात् बना था तब तक जे.एल.एन. मार्ग स्थित मूक बिधर संस्थान में कार्यरत था। राजस्थान विश्वविद्यालय के पास बना होने के बावजूद अपनी अलग पहचान बनाना विशेष चुनौती थी। हमारी संस्थापक प्रिंसीपल माननीया मिस तर्वे तथा मिस प्रभु इसे स्त्री शिक्षा का विशिष्ट संस्थान बनाना चाहती थीं, जो राजस्थान में साठ के दशक के हिसाब से सराहनीय था। अतः कार्यशैली तथा कार्यक्रम के सन्दर्भ में अद्वितीय बनाने के सतत् प्रयास रहे। अनुशासन, शालीनता तथा अध्यापन के क्षेत्र में बेमिसाल रहने की प्रतिस्पर्धा बनी रहती थी।

प्रारम्भिक वर्षों में राष्ट्र, राजनीति, उद्योग व संचार के साधनों के समान शिक्षा में अंग्रेजी माध्यम वाली छात्राओं का वर्चस्व उल्लेखनीय था। कभी-कभी तो विषय का ज्ञान भी आंग्लभाषायी लच्छों में गुम हो जाता था। विशेषकर सामाजिक विज्ञान के क्षेत्र में दुविधा रहती थी। बाद के वर्षों में महाविद्यालय का भाषायी स्वरूप बदलने लगा। अब सामान्य वर्ग की छात्राएँ भी उच्च शिक्षा के लिए लालायित थीं। किन्तु उनमें से अधिकांश के पब्लिक तथा कान्वेट स्कूलों की शिक्षा का लाभ नहीं मिला था। अन्य शैक्षणिक गतिविधियाँ कतिपय छात्राओं का ध्यान आकर्षित कर पाती थीं। सामाजिक वैज्ञानिक होने के नाते इस सामाजिक परिवर्तन को अत्यन्त करीब से देखा है।

दूसरा विशेष परिवर्तन सांस्कृतिक कार्यक्रमों की लोकप्रियता के सन्दर्भ में था। प्रारम्भ में मनोरंजक कार्यक्रमों में शास्त्रीय संगीत, शास्त्रीय नृत्य तथा नाटकों का विशेष स्थान था। उच्च शिक्षा का केन्द्र होने के नाते, अध्यापक वर्ग छात्राओं की रूचि को परिष्कृत तथा पारिभाषित करने का निरन्तर प्रयास करता था।

शिक्षा के प्रसार ने सामान्य अधिकार के प्रति चेतना बढ़ाई साथ ही आत्म सम्मान तथा आत्म निर्भरता के लिए कठोर परिश्रम की भावना को भी महाविद्यालय में बल मिला।

सामाजिक विज्ञान के क्षेत्र में जो छात्राएँ गंभीर थी उनके साथ अध्यापन करना जीवन को सफल बनाना था और अधिक सर्न्दर्भ पुस्तकें पढ़कर उनके ज्ञान की जिज्ञासा को शान्त करने का अनुभव अविस्मरणीय था। मुझे विश्वास है कि जीवन में जिस क्षेत्र में भी होगी अपने परिश्रम तथा लगन से सफलता प्राप्त कर रही होंगी।

With apprehension about my geographical lineage I was a little unsure about getting selected. I however went to meet the management to check on the status of my interview. Tell them you will tell them tomorrow".

Sound advice, which I followed earnestly and which was instrumental in shaping me as a lecturer — who enjoyed high repute and great respect!!! Miss Terway and Miss Prabhu led from the front and I revere and cherish their guidance. I became who I am; thanks to them.

Being new the college attracted B grade students who were weak in studies. We all worked with the single-minded determination to improve their academic standards and build the standing of the college.

The reputation of the college grew and then we started getting academically serious students and Kanoria became the first preferred institution for the girls.

My students respected me and I was known as a strict teacher. Most statistics students scored cent percent marks. The number of them who still keep in touch with me substantiates their love. It was very humbling that most University professors sent their children to me for guidance.

As we grew; so did the activities. It was a delight and an honour to strategize and implement the Planning forum; Organize Inter collegiate debates and elections. Study tours were especially endearing since we got a unique opportunity to bond with the students.

We spent happy times in the college; and had our share of fun, even as we worked. Friendships nurtured then still offer companionship and unrestrained moments of joy now.

Wishing the best to all associated with Kanoria - in the past; present and times to come.

My first day in college, 19th July 1971, began with the opening of science faculty. Miss Terway led Mrs. Singhi, Miss Madhu Tandon and myself towards the lecture rooms situated side by side in the north wing of college. She said, "इन कमरों को अपनी—अपनी लेबॉरेटरीज में कनवर्ट कर लो". As student, after having done practical

in well-furnished and well-equipped labs, converting classroom into such a good laboratory deemed an uphill task. I remember rushing to Maharaja and Maharani college to collect details. It turned out to be a very good learning experience "inspite of being very apprehension about not making mistakes as a lot of money was involved".

In 1971, starting with only 25 students with low percentage, the number of students with better percentage went on increasing in Bio group. Gradually, B.Sc. (Maths) group as other option also started by the year 2001, and need for to post graduate level in Environmental Science was felt. Being Science faculty incharge and coordinator for Environmental Science, initially it became a little different to gather all the faculty members as a team. But hurrah! soon the team got together and finally helped in the establishment of very good Biotechnology and Environmental Science labs. What a wonderful experience it had been with moments full of pangs, chaos, confusion, anxiety and excitement.

An incident I still remember was the day when Kalyan Singh, an office bearer, to my embarrassment, touched my feet when I was dressed as "Ram" for the farewell programme which was being staged by us (the teaching faculty) for outgoing final year students.

I feel so proud to meet my old students who are now famous doctors, lecturers, teachers, bankers, administrative officers, engineers and women activists.

It is my earnest and sincere wish that our college continues to achieve its goals and reaches the top most rung of success—ladder and makes a name as one of the top colleges globally.

Reminiscences

The college was very young when I joined in 1968. Few students, a young staff and a cordial atmosphere in the staff room characterized it. Our principal Miss Terway had a commanding and dignified personality. The Vice-Principal Miss Prabhu was equally impressive and graceful. They expected the staff also to be smartly dressed and create a good impression on the students. They were great administrators, strict, but humane.

Many eminent scholars and activists were invited in our annual seminars and workshops. Among the many I remember the impressive presentations of Dr. Veena Mazumdar on the status of women and Dr. Yashpal on innovative methods in teaching. I also remember an impressive seminar on education in the 1990s. The college was reputed for staging English plays in which both students and teachers of the college participated. I specifically remember liking "Waiting for Godot" (Beckett) and 'Trojan Women' in which Simantini Raghav gave a stunning performance. The college sponsored a troupe from Shri Ram Kala Kendra sometime in February 1972. Their beautiful dance and drama presentation of 'Ramayana' on Ravindra Manch, being very different from the traditional, was very refreshing.

The children of the Deaf and Dumb school under the able guidance of the late Dr. Shirley Consul of the Department of Sociology had also made an excellent presentation of Ram Leela. Their performance was highly appreciated. Equally memorable were Dr. Leela Samson's dance performance and Dr. Vani Jairam's rendering of semi-classical songs.

Our science department had once put up a grand science exhibition cum workshop in the new hall where the library stands now. Dr. Shivraj Patil who later became the Lok Sabha speaker had presided over the function.

The sports competition between teachers and students used to be a hilarious affair. We had regular excursions and survey trips. An interesting experience was the trip of students of sociology and political science to Udaipur in which both teachers and students had to spend a night in the bar hall of the tourist hotel because of confusion regarding reservations: the manager allowed us to stay after much persuasion and on the condition that we don't touch the bottles. We were highly amused.

Kanodians actively participated in activities organized by RUWA concerning women's empowerment.

The college remained as actively engaged in multifarious activities as ever through the 1990s.

What had once been a small undergraduate college had turned into a multi-faculty postgraduate institution by the time I retired in 2002.

Fond memories of long association with my colleagues and college will always remain with me.

My Memoirs

I was a bit nervous when I joined Kanoria College in 1970. Miss Terway the then Principal and Miss Prabhu second to her were known for being strict disciplinarians. As I settled in college I found them very caring and affectionate.

Punctuality, discipline, good rapport with students, respecting our culture and yet marching forward with modern ideas and methods of teaching, maintaining ones dignity as a teacher were certain ground rules with which there was never a compromise. Seminars, tutorials, Saturday class tests, excursions, annual exhibitions of all departments, shramdaan on 15th August and 26th January to clean up and level the campus and planting of trees was a part of Kanoria culture.

Dramas and dance dramas were planned meticulously and practice always started well in advance. Miss Terway and Miss Prabhu painstakingly worked on minor details of dresses, stage, selection of right students and went through encyclopaedias and art books, selecting the right prop for stage, be it a Greek, Sanskrit or a Shakespearean play.

I remember one day we had finished all the decoration work by evening and at night there was a heavy downpour. Miss Terway and Miss Prabhu came to college at night, got everything removed from the stage and shifted the venue next day to Ravindra Manch as if nothing had happened! In one of the dramas, we needed a realistic portrait of a General from European Renaissance period, I painted the portrait in oil, which was displayed on the stage. Such was their eye for perfection.

Miss Terway was known for her "giddha drishti." Cleanliness and aesthetics were very important as she believed it was imperative to impart the same to the students. One day after decorating the whole campus I returned home at 6 pm, barely had an hour gone when Miss Terway sent the car to fetch me. When I reached college, she pointed out that while doing alpana on stage, I had left one step untouched which I then duly finished!

Mrs. Deepali Chandra, another Principal being Bengali,loved to visit our Art studios and sat for hours watching us doing alpana on the porch. As faculty we were always encouraged to take students out for sketching, art excursions, visit to art galleries, slide shows, screening of films by French Embassy.

Annual lunch cooked by teachers in cookery lab was always great fun. Geet Chandani on Sharad Poornima at six in evening on the college roof was a unique experience.

As college grew bigger, life also got busier and time flew quickly. With many ups and downs in college, working in various committees, really helped me evolve as a teacher. To represent the staff in the college Governing body was a challenge. I am thankful to Kanoria college for what I am today. I thoroughly enjoyed my 37 years of service.

In this time of globalisation there are so many challenges, I hope the college maintains the same high ideals, keeps improving and becomes a model college of India.

All my best wishes for its golden future.

My thirty six years in Kanoria College as the guy who managed the canteen taught me that that best things in life are not things but relationships. I was twenty seven when I joined the canteen as a "helper." A year later Miss Terway the then college Principal handed over the canteen to me on a rent of 20 rupees per day. In 2005 when I left I was paying 2,20000 per annum to the college

Not only the colour of money changed by then even its meaning! It was a rare occasion when we would get a glimpse of a hundred rupee note in spite of the fact that the canteen was the most go-to destination for girls. Tea then was twenty five paisa, coffee 35 and a crate of Coke comprising of 24 glass bottles or Coco Cola as it was then known was eight rupees. The college would buy a Kachori from me for 22paisa and sell it to the students for 25 paisa. The operating margins were low but we were high on quality.

The synergy between the students and the staff was palpable and the canteen a venue for many an animated discussion. Moments make memories and as I get transported to the gracious times I recall great minds, thinkers coming in to enjoy a cup that seemed always to cheer them!

On special occasions like the hostel birthday which was always celebrated on Ganesh Chaturthi or NSS camps I would make a special spread but Gulab Jamuns and Samosa the two items that earned me my place in the sun amongst the palatably evolved foodies were a must.

Those were simple times. Some students that kept "an account in the canteen" simply put, made a down payment at the end of each month and not on a daily basis may have faltered but never failed! Spice of life was not so much in variety as it was in healthy wholesome canteen food—cooked happiness if there ever was! The first fridge in the canteen came with 150 free crates of Coco Cola!

If today I am a go- to chef for jaipurites it is hugely because of Miss Terway who during holidays when I was idle, encouraged me to cook in parties thrown by friends and family. Now I cook at weddings and other mega events.

My best wishes will always be with Kanoria family.

How does one look back at College, and summarise the rich experience, the friendships made, knowledge gained, the 'growing-up', the drama performances and debates and discussions, the time spent in the college canteen, the interaction with the teaching faculty and the unforgettable combination of Ms. Terway and Ms. Prabhu, and so many other things in a few words on a piece of paper? After all, those were crucial, vital, important years of my life, and undoubtedly influenced and helped shape me.

I view those years almost as if seen through a kaleidoscope now – some very vivid memories and some hazy ones that come into focussed attention only when I make a rare trip back to Kanoria College, or something occurs to jog my memory. However, for the three years that I was at Kanoria I know that each day was so very real, so intense – and so much a stage towards what I am today.

Thinking back, it seems as if College was a perpetual whirl of activities and formal and informal opportunities to learn (interspersed with routine classes of course, and punctuated at regular intervals by sitting in the college canteen sustained by Shobhram-ji's kachoris, samosas, tea and coffee). We held debates and elocution contests, and inter-college discussions on Kanoria college campus, as well as off-campus. And there was one visit to St. Stephens College Delhi's Winter Fest, which we students enjoyed very much but which our accompanying faculty (Dr. Nirja Misra) averse to this day gave her nightmares! The Fine Arts department created backdrops and stage-settings for the college plays, dance-dramas and functions, while the Music department innovated and put-together scores for the same. Ms Prabhu, assited by various faculty members, usually directed the plays, with Ms Terway coming into her own just before performance time, with advice on costumes and ways to relax. How many college Principals and Vice-Principals can people think off who advised students to go relax prior to an exam by sitting on the college lawn or nipping off to the canteen? Our Principal, Vice Principals and teachers were always accessible for talking and planning with their students, and encouraging us to do socially useful activities like reading to visually challenged M.Phil and Ph.D students, and visiting students of deaf and dumb school especially to tie rakhis on Raksha-Bandhan day.

And then there were activity clubs and subject clubs. Of the former, some I recall with a sense of near-ownership included the 'Navamallika' club, the Inter-Disciplinary Association; and the Dramatics Society, besides the College Students Union. There was so much happening at College, that once I start putting memories down on paper it seems like I will never be able to call a halt! But halt I must – for now. And to think I haven't even started on memories from my two years of serving as an Assistant Professor of History at Kanoria College after completing my Masters degree! Nor have I started to say thank you to my teachers and the then college staff and helpers – But then, maybe I don't have to say it in words. In my heart, I know what the whole phase of my time at Kanoria means to me – and to so many of us. And I cherish it.


crossing my mind! Or was it just one thought with two sides? Will Miss Terway give me admission or will she refuse? The last date of admission was over!

I can recollect one of the incidents when I came after 7 or 10 days tour---- I was little late for my Public administration class, I just peeped in and wanted to go in from the last gate of the room, I didn't notice that Mrs Goswami [my Public ads lecturer] was noticing and as soon as I wanted to sit she announced "array bhai taaliyaan bajaaiye aaj to prerana ji class main aayi hain"...... I remember that embarrassment and a lesson till today.

Miss Terway and Miss Prabhu were the back bone of the college, totally devoted, nurtured us and the whole environment as their own, I can not think Kanoria without them it was like two sides of a coin. Whenever I used to come back to Jaipur from Delhi I would meet them. In one of the meetings Miss Terway asked me to give a lecture or talk to the young girls and tell them that after BA and MA they don't have to sit on the terrace and wait for the Prince charming to come and fetch them, there are other ways also to lead the life, life has so much to offer and they should contribute to the society.

I have finished my graduation in the year 1978, I think my college was ahead of time. Thank God that I am a student of Kanoria

मिसिज कौर ने एक विषय को कई पुस्तकों से पढ़कर नोट्स बनाना सिखया तो रंजना मैडम ने लिखने की गति बढ़ाने के लिए आकाशवाणी पर आने वाले धीमी गति के समाचारों को साथ-साथ लिखने का नुस्खा दिया।

बहुत बढ़िया रिजल्ट आना चाहिये, यह चुनौती उनके लिये भी थी और हमारे लिये भी तथा हम सभी अपनी पूर्ण क्षमता के साथ जुटे हुये थे किन्तु लगता नहीं था कि अच्छे अंकों से ऑनर्स की डिग्री ले सकेंगे। बेचारा पूरा बैच पढ़-पढ़ कर थक जाता था, किन्तु दोनों ही टीचर्स की अपेक्षा का स्तर इतना ऊँचा था की इंटरनल असेसमेन्ट के मार्क्स आने के बाद लगभग पूरा बैच ही आंसू बहा रहा होता था।

हर दिन, हर क्लास अपने आप में एक अनुभव था, किन्तु कभी न भूला जा सकने वाला था कॉलेज के पहले दिन का पहला पीरियड। अनिवार्य हिन्दी की क्लास होनी थी और कक्षा में बैठे हम सब टीचर के आने की प्रतीक्षा कर रहे थे। सोच रहे थे कि कौन आयेगा, क्या पढ़ायेगा। मैं आश्वस्त थी कि मेरी हिन्दी तो बहुत अच्छी है, फिक्र किस बात की! तभी एक छोटे से कद की, भारी सी दिखने वाली महिला क्लास में आयी और अपना परिचय दिया मैं कृष्णा तर्वे। प्रिंसिपल! वो बेहद स्ट्रिक्ट हैं सब संभल कर बैठ गये। उन्होंने हमारा परिचय लिया और कुछ हल्की—फुल्की बातें की। सब रिलेक्स हो गये – मिस तर्वे तो बहुत सौम्य हैं, डरने की क्या बात है। तभी उन्होंने पूछा – यहाँ A,B,C,D किस–किस को आती है? सब लोग कुछ कन्यूज हो गये – ये कैसा सवाल है। A,B,C,D तो सभी को आती है। सबने हाथ खड़े कर लिये। मिस तर्वे ने कहा, शाबाश! एक दो लोगों को थोड़ा सुना भी। फिर पूछा – यहाँ क,ख,ग,घ कितने लोगों को आता है? और सबको सांप सूंघ गया। हममें से बहुतों ने प्रयास किया जिसमें मैं भी शामिल थी, किन्तु कोई भी पूरी हिन्दी वर्णमाला नहीं सुना पाया।

मिस तर्वे ने हमें हिन्दी वर्णमाला सिखायी और अहसास कराया कि अंग्रेजी के समान हिन्दी की 'एल्फाबेट' भी हमकों आनी चाहिए। मेरी कितनी सहपाठियों को उस दिन का यह वाकया याद होगा, पता नहीं; किन्तु मैं उस दिन के बाद हिन्दी वर्णमाला कभी नहीं भूली।

कॉलेज के अपने संस्मरणों में मैं यदि मिस प्रभु का जिक्र न करूं तो एक कमी रह जायेगी। उस समय वाइस प्रिंसिपल थी मिस प्रभु। मिस तर्वे की मित्र, कद-काठी में उनसे एकदम अलग दुबली-पतली थोडी लम्बी सी। मिस प्रभु ने मुझे क्लास के अलावा अलग से कई बार अंग्रेजी का अभ्यास करवाया तथा स्वयं पढ़ने के लिए गाइड किया।

कानोड़िया की अपनी सभी शिक्षिकाओं से मैंने बहुत कुछ सीखा, न केवल संबन्धित विषयों के बारे में, अपितु जीवन-मूल्यों के बारे में। उस उम्र में शायद हम पूरी तरह समझ न पाते हों कि हमें अपने शिक्षकों से क्या मिल रहा है और अपनी कृतज्ञता हम उन्हें बता भी नहीं पाते; अतः आज इस अवसर पर अपने सभी टीचर्स को शत् शत् नमन और हृदय से आभार। आपका आशीर्वाद सभी विद्यार्थियों पर सदा बना रहे।

कॉलेज में हर साल एक इंग्लिश और एक हिन्दी नाटक एवं एक नृत्य नाटिका होती थी। नृत्य नाटिका के लिए श्रेष्ठ गुरूजनों को आमंत्रित किया जाता था। संस्कृत भाषा में नृत्य नाटिका का सफल मंचन उन्हीं के द्वारा करवाया गया था। "नल दमयन्ती" नृत्य नाटिका में मुझे राजा नल का रोल दिया था। इसी प्रकार "पनिहारिन" राजस्थानी नृत्य नाटिका में, मैं और प्रेरणा श्रीमाली नायक-नायिका की भूमिका में थे। हर वर्ष कभी गीत गोविन्दम् कभी महिषासुर मर्दन, होली उत्सव, बसन्तोत्सव हुआ करते थे। हम सब घंटो अथक मेहनत करते। कॉलेज की संस्कृति सचिव रही थी मैं।

अनुशासन एवं नियम की पक्की थी मिस प्रभु। कॉलेज का फंक्शन 6.30 है तो पर्दा सही समय पर खुल जाता। मुख्य अतिथि आयें या नहीं। अभिभावक ही उनके मुख्य अतिथि होते थे।

आज भी यूथ फेस्टिवल में जज के रूप में जब कानोड़िया जाने का मौका मिलता है तो कभी मना नहीं करती। मेरा कॉलेज जो है वहाँ की स्टेज से मेरा गहरा नाता है। जीवन्त हो जाते है मेरे सुहाने दिन।

मुझे गर्व है कि मैं इस कॉलेज की छात्रा रही, इस कॉलेज ने हमें 'ऑलराउण्डर' बनाया। यहाँ सीखी बातों ने मेरे जीवन को श्रेष्ठ बनाया। वर्तमान की छात्राओं को यही सन्देश देना चाहूँगी कि आप सौभाग्यशाली हो जो इस महान कॉलेज का हिस्सा हो। जितना सीख सकती हो सीखो। शिक्षक बहुत कुछ देते हैं, ये आप पर निर्भर करता है कि आप कितना ले सकते हो। अच्छी शिक्षा ताउम्र काम आयेगी।

बात 1976 जुलाई की है, जब मैंने महाविद्यालय में पहला कदम रखा। यह महाविद्यालय उच्च शिक्षा के क्षेत्र में ग्यारह वर्ष की अल्पायु में ही एक अग्रणी संस्था के रूप में ख्याति अर्जित कर चुका था, जिसका श्रेय जाता है आदरणीय मिस तर्वे, मिस प्रभु और उनकी टीम को तथा पूर्ण विश्वास के साथ उन्हें संस्था सौंपने वाले श्री भागीरथ जी कानोड़िया को। निःसंदेह महाविद्यालय में बिताये तीन वर्षों ने हमारे व्यक्तित्व को निखारा है और भविष्य को दिशा प्रदान की है। मदद के लिए सदैव तत्पर, योग्य, स्नेही शिक्षकगण हमारे गुरू, मित्र, मार्गदर्शक व रोल मॉडल सभी कुछ थे। इसका सुन्दर प्रांगण, नियमिति कक्षाओं के साथ विभिन्न विषयों पर विशेषज्ञों के व्याख्यान, सेमिनार, साहित्यकारों, पत्रकारों, सामाजिक कार्यकर्ताओं आदि के साथ होने वाली चर्चायें, नृत्य-नाटिका, खेल-कूद, मूक बिधर बच्चों के साथ मनाये गये बाल दिवस, छात्रसंघ चुनाव, बसन्त मेला सब कुछ ऐसा था जिसकी छवि अभी तक मन मित्रिष्क पर छाई हुई है। हिन्दी, अंग्रेजी के नाटक मात्र मनोरंजन के साधन नहीं थे बल्कि समाज में व्याप्त विसंगतियों की ओर इंगित करने का सशक्त माध्यम भी थे। ट्यूटोरियल कक्षायें और Counselling Period शिक्षिकाओं के साथ अनौपचारिक बातचीत के मौके थे और Remedial Classes छुट्टियों में भी कॉलेज आने के बहाने। पढ़ाई और पाठ्येत्तर गतिविधियों का ऐसा सुन्दर तालमेल कि कोई भी इनमें हर समय डूबा रह सके। उस जमाने में ऑनर्स कोर्स को विद्यार्थी वरीयता दिया करते थे और उनसे गंभीर अध्ययन की अपेक्षा की जाती थी। योजना मंच की गतिविधियों से अर्थशास्त्र के विद्यार्थियों को कभी फुर्सत नहीं मिलती थी और पुरस्कार उन्हें थकने नहीं देते थे। पुस्तकालय, Self Service Cafeteria और कॉमनरूम हमारे प्रिय स्थान थे।

एक ऐसा वातावरण कि किशोर मन इसे अपनी कार्यस्थली बनाना चाहे। हममें से कई साथियों के सपने साकार हुए और हम नई भूमिका में पुन: कॉलेज में लौट आये। रजत जयन्ती वर्ष (1989-90) में शुभारम्भ हुआ युवा महोत्सव 'कस्तूरी' का जिसका इन्तजार विद्यार्थी व शिक्षकगण सभी को वर्षभर रहता है।

2011 का वर्ष अनुदानित शिक्षण संस्थाओं के लिये बड़े परिवर्तन को लेकर आया। मेरे यायावरी मन ने राजकीय महाविद्यालय में जाने का निर्णय किया। कानोड़िया कॉलेज की पूर्व छात्राओं को बड़ी संख्या में यहाँ शिक्षिकाओं के रूप में उसी उत्साह से ग्रामीण क्षेत्र के विद्यार्थियों के जीवन को संवारते देखती हूँ तो मन सन्तोष से भर उठता है, कॉलेज के मोनोग्राम पर अंकित आदर्श वाक्य 'आत्म दीपो भव' सार्थक प्रतीत होता है। अपनी संस्था के प्रति आत्म गौरव के भाव से ओत-प्रोत, देश-विदेश में कार्यरत हम असंख्य विद्यार्थियों की पहचान, हमारा प्यारा कानोड़िया कॉलेज इस देश की महिलाओं को सार्थक जीवन जीने के लिए प्रेरित करता रहेगा, ऐसा विश्वास भी है और मंगलकामना भी।

My little note on how I owe my life to my years in Kanoria College

Kanoria College will always remain with me till my last breath. It was the first space in my life that taught me what freedom meant. Freedom to move around, bond, be creative, perform, sing, write, air views even if they were different and to be as yourself.

I owe this to the incredible leadership of Ms. Terway and Ms. Prabhu, a relationship which began in 1979, the year I joined college and lasted with them till the end of their lives. Ms. Prabhu brought humility and peace in my life. I was so proud to be friends with her. It was she who bridge the years between us. She was young at heart, even younger than us all. Never sceptical, always willing to try out new things with us. Infact what I am doing today is carrying forward their legacy in a very small way in the area of education, citizenship and human rights.

I can never forget those happy days of making new friends in college from all walks of life and collectively dreaming that we would make a difference. Ours was the gang of singers and theatre people and we still remain connected today, a bit of college in each of us has made us grow into a star in our fields.

Even studies had a different meaning. The classes of Ms. Jaya Devi, Ms Bakre, Ms. Arya, Dr. Baghel, Ms Tyagi who made science so interesting. I donot remember bunking classes and if we did, the teachers would promptly connect with us. It was their trust in us, believing us, which made us "good" students and positive people.

It was in College that it crystalised that there was a life well beyond the individual pursuit of my career. Growing up years are the most turbulent years, constantly living under pressure to perform, to be affirmed in an intimate relationship, to be out of the tutelage of parents and family. But had it not been for the flight that I had already taken with others, the process of exploring what I wanted to be would never have begun.

Of course that journey is ongoing, with many significant milestones being crossed with several people, but three teachers from college who have a special place, who never taught me, but our interactions with them equipped us with tools that opened up the "real" world to us. The three, Dr. Sharada Jain, Dr. Nirja Mishra and Dr. Renuka Pamecha, were my mentors and colleagues at work and today they stand as important pillars in my journey towards building a just, equal and peaceful world.

यहाँ अध्ययनरत प्रत्येक छात्रा में कुछ ऐसे ही प्रेरक भाव भरने वाले और महिला शिक्षा में अपनी अलग पहचान बनाने वाले इस महाविद्यालय की छात्रा होने पर मुझे सदैव गर्व का अनुभव होता रहा है। यहाँ बिताए 3 वर्षों का अनुभव मेरे जीवन भर की पूँजी बन गया। यहाँ प्रवेश के समय मैं अपने तक सीमित व संकोची स्वभाव की छात्रा थी जिसे आगे बढ़कर काम करने में झिझक होती थी, लेकिन यहाँ अध्ययन के दौरान विभिन्न गतिविधियों में भाग लेने के अनेक अवसर मिले जिससे मेरे व्यक्तित्व को नए आयाम मिले। हिन्दी ऑनर्स में कम विद्यार्थी होने के कारण शिक्षिकाओं से व्यक्तिगत रूप से जुड़ने का अवसर मिला और उन्होंने विभिन्न प्रतियोगिताओं में भाग लेने के लिए प्रोत्साहित किया। वाद विवाद, काव्य – पाठ, निबन्ध लेखन आदि के साथ जिन दो गतिविधियों में भाग लेकर मेरा आत्मविश्वास सबसे अधिक बढ़ा, वे थीं एन.सी.सी. और नाटक में अभिनय। एन.सी.सी. में दो वर्ष की ट्रेनिंग और एक कैम्प (अजमेर में) का अलग ही प्रभाव पड़ा और नाटक में भाग लेकर तो मैं आत्म – विश्वास से भर उठी।

बर्टोल्ट ब्रेक्ट के नाटक 'खड़िया का घेरा' (हिन्दी अनुवाद) के रिहर्सल और मंचन की अनेक स्मृतियाँ आज भी मन को सुखद अनुभूतियों से भर देती हैं। रिहर्सल के समय मिस तर्वे का उपस्थित रहना और एक-एक चीज़ पर ध्यान देना, हमें बहुत सचेत रखता था। नाटकों में मिस प्रभु और मिस तर्वे द्वारा व्यक्तिगत रुचि लेने का इतना सकारात्मक प्रभाव पड़ता था कि उस समय महाविद्यालय में मंचित हुए नाटकों की चर्चा दूर-दूर तक और लम्बे समय तक हुआ करती थी।

नाटक में भाग लेने का मुझ पर तो इतना गहरा प्रभाव पड़ा कि मैं कॉलेज के बाद भी अनेक वर्षों तक रंगमंच से जुड़ी रही। न केवल अनेक नाटकों में अभिनय किया वरन् अपने शोध का विषय भी 'स्वातंत्र्योत्तर हिन्दी रंगमंच' चुना।

जीवन को दिशा देने वाले कारणों में प्रतिभा, प्रयास और प्रारब्ध के साथ प्रेरक का महत्व भी किसी से कम नहीं होता। यह महाविद्यालय अध्ययन काल से ही मेरे लिए प्रेरक की भूमिका में रहा है और आज भी है, जहाँ अध्यापन कार्य करते हुए निरन्तर नवीन कार्यों से जुड़ने की प्रेरणा मिलती रहती है। महिला शिक्षा की अलख जगाए इसे पचास वर्ष हो चुके हैं। स्वर्ण जयन्ती वर्ष के अवसर पर हार्दिक बधाई और स्वर्णिम गरिमा को निरन्तर बनाए रखने के लिए ढेरों शुभकामनाएँ।

My Foundation

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I am a banker – a development banker and the credit for being so goes entirely to my Alma Mater! I joined the B.A. Economics (Honours) course and my teachers were Ma'm Kaur, Ms. Neelima Diwan and Ms. Joshi amongst others. Though the syllabus was quite intricate, the presence of these guides helped me tackle the subjects very smoothly and engagingly – be it macro and micro economics, statistics or international trade etc. My favourite paper was of course, history of economic thought wherein with Ma'm Kaur we used to dive deep into Adam Smith's, David Ricardo's or Karl Marx's theories! And frequent class tests used to keep us absolutely up to date with our studies.

Well, but the star attraction of this college was and I think still is — its sparkling extra curricular activities which honed and polished our talents and skills. I greatly benefitted from it as I became an avid participant of various declamation, poetry reading and debate competitions. In addition, regular staging of plays and skits turned out to be quite thrilling as I thought I was in no way less than Naseeruddin or Shabana Azmi! I still remember our philosophy and English teachers respectively who helped us in emoting path breaking plays — both in English and Hindi. I still remember my role in Henrik Ibsen's play which we staged at Ravindra Manch and which turned out to be a huge success (Though I must mention that we use to watch Maharani College's plays as well, to compare which were better).

Out of the entire embroidery on the fabric of my memories, the sharpest stitch that stands out is my time spent in the glorious library of my college! I vividly recall the scene wherein one day I stood at the library's window peering out at the wet trees in the campus – thinking that "that" moment I shall always cherish and recall later in life with great fondness! The golden jubilee celebrations have indeed given me this opportunity to delve into these recollections.

Most important of all, I shall come back to my college one day and definitely interact with youngsters and share my thoughts with them. Having studied at Kanoria in the early 70s, for me the College experience was framed by the two wonderful women who started it.

No two women could be more different than Ms Terway and Ms Prabhu. Yet they came to share a room and open their hearth and home so that it eventually came to be the venue of meetings of the women's movement, the civil liberties and even the first meeting of what would become the Right to Information. I can still recall the discussion led by Aruna Roy in which several citizens participated including Mr Anil Bordia who represented a more active section of the bureaucracy.

Ms Prabhu was tall and beautiful as Coorgi women are wont to be, Ms Terway was short, stocky and "homely." One had a passion for English poetry and prose, the other for Hindi and Sanskrit literature. Both were part of the intellectual life of the then vibrant Rajasthan University and had close friendships with the families of many persons including VV John, PS Sundaram, MMK Bhalla, GC Pande, Daya Krishna and Raj Krishna, and S Lokanathan. They were particularly good friends of my mother, Francine Krishna. From age 10, which was when I first came to Jaipur, I remember the potluck dinners flowing with conversation and delicious food from different homes.

Kanoria was the life of the two women and they infused life into the College recruiting many smart lecturers. I assisted Sharada Jain's weekly lecture series, which culminated in an annual seminar, hosting rich scholarship. The fun of our lives came from the lively chats over Shobharam's tea and samosas and from the evening's theatre practice! Most of the plays were directed by Ms Prabhu. To begin with the girls played male roles - I got to play villainous Malvolia and the hero in As You Like It and later when young men joined the cast I was Helen of Troy! There were hysterical moments at the final performance as when a girl friend's moustache got blown off by a sudden gust of wind and she dived to rescue it! I was on stage at the time with a serious soliloquy coming up and barely managed to suppress the giggles!

The links with the college remained even after I graduated and I would return to take part in its intellectual and theatrical life. After my masters I returned to teach switching from salwar-kameez to sari to look a mature and dignified 20 year old lecturer in order to teach rambunctious young women who were virtually my own age! we had a lot of fun - students would laugh at my inventive vocabulary and sometimes even contributed a missing term.

There has been a debate on co-ed versus women's only institutions. My experience is that women get more leadership opportunities in the latter. I was a nondescript student at my co-ed school, but the college allowed an inestimable growth so that I got the best all-rounder prize for the year!

Some students start their hostel life quite early, i.e, from school days itself. Some even don't experience hostel life at all! But I think that's a big loss. You learn so many lessons while being on your own at a hostel.

Luckily I got the taste of hostel life after getting admission in Kanoria college. Bonding with roomies, no mom or dad around to pamper you, life in a college or hostel can be a life-changing experience. I had the time of my life. I am lucky to be studying in one of Jaipur's best college campuses with its lovely architecture, ambience and vibrancy. We all gang up to play pranks on each other, organise activities and events and store Maggi, chips, biscuits and other yum stuff in our rooms — in fact we don't remain confined to just one room, the entire hostel belongs to us."

I've had many funny, good and bad experiences throughout the 2 years of my course. Still remembered Sujata didi used to say after 10pm "Light out "means no lights after the deadline. We used to go to our seniors or toilet to study.

Only on Sundays we were allowed to see the TV serials in the morning hours from 11am to 1pm...could listen to the music during the dinner hours in the dinning hall....

One of my favourite moment was when i discovered that I had topped the Rajasthan university by getting 55th rank in Arts.

After spending two years of my life there I realised how important it is for a person to live in the hostel and how much one can gain living there. Its a learning experience b'coz you get an oppurtunity to face life, people and situations all on your own which prepares you to face life ahead in a more mature and better way. These are small small things but they help you a lot later in your life



मैं एन.एस.एस. में भी भाग लेती थी। वहाँ महिलाओं को सशक्त करने के कई कार्यक्रम होते थे। जहाँ मुझे बहुत अच्छा लगाता था। हम जे.सी. बोस काण्ड में धरने, प्रदर्शन में कई जगह गये। कॉलेज में कई नुक्कड नाटकों का भी आयोजन किया जाता था। जिसमें महिला हिंसा पर बात की जाती थी तब मुझे सबकुछ ऐसा लगता था कि ये सारी बातें मुझसे जुड़ी हुई हैं और मेरे मन में हमेशा ये बातें ही घूमती रहती थीं कि उस लड़की ने इतनी परेशानी झेली फिर भी मुकाबला किया और हिंसा से छुटकारा पाया।

मेरे विचार प्रारम्भ से ही हिंसा का विरोध करने वाले थे। कॉलेज में एक थियेटर वर्कशाप में हमें अपनी आवाज को आत्मविश्वास के साथ बुलन्द करने का अभ्यास करवाया गया था। इसकी मैं सदैव आभारी रहूंगी जहाँ से मुझे सबके सामने अपनी बात कहने की हिम्मत मिली। हिन्दी एलिक्यूशन में भी भाग लेकर मैंने अपने आप को हिम्मत के साथ खड़े होते देखा और इसी तरह मेरे तीन वर्ष कैसे बीत गये पता ही नहीं चला।

मेरी अपनी जिन्दगी में मैंने बहुत सारी हिंसा झेली लेकिन उसका आत्मविश्वास से सामना करना इसी कॉलेज ने सिखाया। मैं एक काउंसलर हूँ जो महिला थाने में महिला सुरक्षा एवं सलाह केन्द्र (उत्तर) में बैठकर आने वाली हर परेशान महिला को आत्मविश्वास के साथ अपना निर्णय स्वयं लेने के लिए प्रेरित करती हूँ।






Beginning of New Chase




Kanoria- Where learning never ends
