Policy Document for the Award of Scholarships and Freeships to Students

Preamble

Kanoria Mahila Mahavidyalaya set up with a vision to extend the outreach of women's education has been incessantly trying to translate it to reality by facilitating the marginalized and underprivileged young aspirant since its inception. To break the barriers perpetuated by the social and economic milieu and to increase the access and engagement in learning by students, policy of inclusion has been adopted by the institution by offering them financial help and emotional support.

Context

In compliance of the circular received from the Government of Rajasthan, Education (Cell-VI) Department, advising the institutions to create a Student Aid Fund to provide financial aid to the meritorious and under privileged students. Student Aid Fund was created from the session 1970-71 taking in a part of the fee received from students and donations.

Objectives

- To grant financial assistant to the needy students
- To support students to continue their education
- To facilitate and encourage all round development of students
- To increase opportunities for student to meet their goals
- To include all deserving but deprived students

Policy

The documented policy is as under-

A. Merit cum Need-Based Aid

Eligibility

- 50% & above in Commerce and Arts
- 55% & above in Science
- The total income of the family should be Rs. 25,000/- p.a. or less.
- All those who are not getting aid from any other source

Fee concession for Ex. Servicemen/ Sports/ NCC/ NSS/ Scout/ College Employees will be as follows-

- Daughters of Ex. Servicemen - 50% of the total fee
- Sports - 50% of the total fee
- (For exceptional records) - 75% of the total fee
- NCC/NSS/Scout - 50% and above of the total fee
- (For exceptional performance) - No Fee
- Daughters of College Employee - No Fee
- Fee exemption to the merit holders of any board of Secondary Education

Renewal of Aid-

Eligibility for renewal of aid in UG Part-II and III or in PG Semester- III/IV

- Minimum 75% attendance in the preceding session
- Minimum 50% marks obtained in the last examination

B. Scholarship

- For Merit Holders-** 95% and above in class 12th
 - For Sports-** Student who have exemplary performance in the previous academic session
 - To the wards of Freedom Fighters**
- Every year, a Committee will be constituted comprising of one faculty member from each stream headed by the Vice-Principal for the disbursement of the funds.
 - This is an agile policy subject to amendments to accommodate change in fee structure, government admission policy or society requirement.
 - Quantum of student fund and disbursement will be amended accordingly.
